EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 4

WHEREAS, previous Governors and I have enacted a number of Executive Orders; and

WHEREAS, these Executive Orders were enacted to establish worthy and valuable implementation groups and processes; and

WHEREAS, many of these implementation groups and processes have served well and honorably; and

WHEREAS, the implementation groups and processes were enacted to administer a complex series of federal requests for, use of, and reporting of federal funding; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to more efficiently administer those programs, control costs, and monitor compliance with the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (hereinafter "the Act"), it is in the best interests of the State of Connecticut to transfer the responsibilities for ensuring Connecticut's compliance with the remaining implementation pieces and reporting requirements to the Office of Policy and Management.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DANNEL P. MALLOY, Governor of the State of Connecticut, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Statutes of the State do hereby **ORDER and DIRECT:**

- 1. That Governor M. Jodi Rell's Executive Order No. 25A, establishing procedural mechanisms within the Governor's Office to administer funding and reporting required under the Act, is repealed.
- 2. That this order shall take effect February 7, 2011.
