## Examples of projects in jeopardy if the Republican "Prioritize Borrowing" plan were approved (Source: Connecticut OPM)

- 1. Puts the entire School Construction program in jeopardy approximately 500 existing projects that would be in jeopardy of payment and the towns would have to fend for themselves.
- 2. Municipal Aid \$66M Municipal Grants and Urban Act
- 3. Municipal Aid \$30 million for Town Aid Road municipal grants which towns are anticipating to receive
- 4. Clean water projects awaiting funding
  - a. The significant South Hartford Conveyance and Storage Tunnel
  - b. Improvements at the Hartford holding tank water pollution control facility
  - c. Phosphorus removal in Meriden, Danbury, Vernon, Wallingford, Plymouth, and Ridgefield
  - d. Pump station upgrades in Stratford, West Haven, Hebron
- 5. Economic development and brownfield remediation
- 6. Housing programs and projects awaiting funding
  - a. Eliminate funding for Low Income Tax Credits that leverages private investment in affordable housing programs
  - Plans for refurbishment or construction of low-income housing units in partnership with various housing authorities and other developments in communities statewide (New Haven, Waterbury, Bridgeport, Farmington, Kent, Norwalk, New London, Stamford and other communities statewide)
  - c. Senior and Disabled housing renovation/new construction awards will be halted in Glastonbury, Naugatuck, Norwich, East Hartford, West Hartford, Greenwich, Hartford, Enfield, Windham, Farmington, New Haven, Kent, Norwalk, Bridgeport, Waterbury and statewide
- 7. \$17 million for the CSCU system improvements
  - a. The annual system wide infrastructure and code repairs
  - b. Advanced manufacturing programs
- 8. \$120 million for IT Investment projects including but not limited to the projects below:
  - a. Enterprise Content Management Systems
  - b. Timekeeping and Scheduling Upgrades (Kronos)
  - c. Child Welfare Information System
  - d. DDS Home and Community Based Management System
  - e. Criminal Identification and History Repository Modernization
  - f. Unemployment Insurance Modernization
  - g. Integrated consumer Service and Reporting System
  - h. Medicaid Management Information System
  - i. IT and Tax System Modernization
  - j. Social Service Shared Services Initiative
  - k. Digital Government (Digital Front Door)
  - I. Technology Improvements for Paid Family Medical Leave
