OHS has begun initiating discussions with the Department of Social Services on having Medicaid reimbursement for Community health workers, Medicaid enrollees, and for others that have commercial plans. Uncertain if this will be done through innovative repayment models. OHS is committed to furthering along the profession of Community Health workers throughout CT.</p> <p>Laura Morris, Milagrosa Seguinot and, Amy Mirizzi of DPH met with Amy Griffin from the Consultation to discuss what the New England states are doing for funding their CHW Associations and CHW's salaries through more permanent funding, rather than grant cycling. Discussed having a forum with other states beyond New England.</p>

	<p>The chair position is vacant and OHS is looking at appointing someone soon. We also have a vacancy under the six CHW's, The co-chair position remains vacant.</p> <p>Melanie Alvarez was present at the meeting and has an interest in becoming a member of the body. Melanie Alvarez informed the body her interest in community health has been within the HIV realm. She is happy the model the HIV world developed to do Community health work has been adopted by the rest of the world.</p> <p>There were not enough members present for a quorum.
