#### CHW Approved Vendors - Training Vendor Application Section 10 Requirements

- I understand that before the training program makes any substantive change in the curriculum or persons delivering training, I have an affirmative responsibility to submit those changes to CHWAB for approval or CHWAB may consider those changes as not meeting the training program requirements. If I do not update CHWAB of these changes, I will risk loss or denial of my training program certification.
- I understand that I will notify the CHWAB if there are any changes and/or additions to the instructors providing the CHW Core Curriculum training and certify that they meet the requirements as set forth by the CHWAB.
