the association, Health Equity Solutions, the CT Health Foundation and OHS. The event will be held from 10am to 11:30am.

- Fernando Morales announced their partnership with DPH on the Healthy Homes curriculum which will be open to CHWs and others. He will forward the details as they are scheduled.
- Fernando Morales also announced that Southwestern AHEC received from the Connecticut Health Foundation to address any barriers to CHWs becoming certified.
- Laura Morris announced a pilot project of the Universal Nurse Home Visiting with the
 inclusion of CHWs. This is a multi-agency initiative with the Office of Early Childhood, DPH,
 DSS, DCF and OHS. Bridgeport Hospital has been awarded this contract, with Southwestern
 AHEC acting as a subcontractor, providing the Community Health Worker piece.
- Maggie Goodwin inquired about state funding for CHWs. Laura Morris responded that there
 is a coalition, headed by Health Equity Solutions that is working on this issue. Karen Siegel, at
 HES is the contact person.
