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5.	 Milagrosa Seguinot reported that the Association is preparing for their event on April 6 in celebration of Community Health Worker Day. They have noticed 2 different groups that come through the training: existing CHWs and others new to the field. The training staff created the CHW Certification Learning and Support Group. They have been meeting on Tuesdays for almost one year. The CT Health Foundation invited them to apply for a grant to support the creation of the CHW Certification roadmap and toolkit. Eve provided an update on this effort and requested feedback from the group regarding the survey that they are planning to distribute among the CHWs that have gone through the core competencies program. She shared the questions planned for the survey. The presentation that was provided today, with the questions for the survey will be
	distributed to all for the purpose of soliciting feedback.
