### **Family Bridge Basics**

- > Community-based, public health-oriented intervention service for new moms and their infants
- Integrative Model
  - Registered Nurse & CHW collaboration
    - Care aligned to maximize coordination and effectiveness
  - Assess physical and psychological well-being of mom and infant
  - Evaluate environmental safety
  - Address socioeconomic barriers
  - Connect families to community resources and services to improve overall health outcomes
- Universal & Voluntary
- No Cost to the family

# Free and Universal Program

 Two qualifiers (birth hospital and town of residence)

# Program is offered to patients:

- In- Hospital
- Phone
- Provider or Nurse Referral
- Self Referral


#### First Visit Scheduled with Nurse

- 1-3 weeks after birth
- Mother and Baby assessment
- Compiles resource list for patient
- 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> visits scheduled as needed

## Follow Up Contact w/ CHW

- Caregiver is linked to resources by CHW
- Families contacted to ensure successful linkage to resources
- Satisfaction call/survey completed

### Our Reach (So Far!) Since Launching on Oct 23rd, 2023...



### **CHW Top 5 Referrals**

1) Diapers/Wipes/Formula

Provide from Internal stock of items to offer families as a bridge to long term resources

2) WIC/SNAP

 Assist families with application process for WIC/SNAP

3) Diaper Bank

Locate long term diaper bank resources

4) Referrals & Appts with PCP

Most referrals are to Southwest and Optimus Health Centers in Bridgeport

5) Lactation Consultation

Family Bridge employs 3 nurse's with CLC/IBCLC certifications
