- Statewide Health IT Plan Feb. 2022
- Six focus areas with approximately 25 activities prioritized over a five-year period (2022-2026)
- HITAC members have been asked to respond to a survey to assist in setting priorities

Support behavioral health providers with adoption of EHR and HIE services (FA4)

- Listening sessions with behavioral health providers to better understand perspectives around maintaining patient confidentiality of behavioral health treatment
- Developed an educational campaign for behavioral health providers and patients on the benefits and risks of health information exchange.
- Ongoing engaged with large number of associations on challenges and opportunities with the statewide HIE

Sustain and increase use of Statewide HIE services

- Press conference with CGA, OHS, and Connie leadership to share information about the value of sharing data for improved clinical care and care coordination
- Planned and conducted town halls to share information about Statewide HIE services and onboarding requirements

2023 Health IT/HIE Progress HIE Regulations (FA1)

- Charter approved by the HITAC for the establishment of an HIE Regulations Advisory (RA) Subcommittee (June 2023)
- In preparation developing Regs:
 - Extensive comparative analysis of state mandates and regulations that are currently in place in four states with similar statutory requirements
 - Draft regulatory criteria for hospitals, clinical labs, and provider organizations (with certified EHR systems) capable of connecting to Connie
 - Acquiring consulting services for development of Regs
 - Feedback and engagement with provider organizations and associations
- RA Subcommittee expected to be begin meeting in Q2 2024

Implement systems to improve health equity and address health-related social needs (FA2)

- ➤ Presented an overview to the HITAC with background on CIE data exchange standards with goal of CIE and HIE interoperability to support whole person care (April 2023)
- Exploring development of roadmap for CIE and HIE interoperability in alignment with national standards including ONC, HL7 and Gravity Project
- ➤ Begun analysis for a **Health Equity Dashboard** with a public facing web interface to identify health disparities at the community level and monitor interventions.

Implement systems to improve health equity and address health-related social needs (FA2)

- Electronic closed loop referrals for identified health related social needs. Currently focused on home-based care.
- Scope will be expanding to other social needs.
- Identifying patient encounters with SDOH conditions associated with the encounter

Improve Service Coordination and Data Sharing Across HHS Agencies (FA3)

- Planning has been done by OHS, in collaboration with OPM, for future activities of a multiagency working group focused on data exchange, data system interoperability, data-sharing agreements, and consent management
- Planning Greater engagement with components of MyCT pertaining to HHS agencies
- Evaluating CT Enhanced Resource Centers DSS, DDS, DCF, DOH, DOL, DMHAS, DPH, OEC and CBO's
- Agencies are meeting monthly to share REL implementation experiences

Protect Individuals' Health Information Privacy (FA5)

- Presented an introductory overview on the status of consent management for data sharing across communities of care (October 2023)
- Engaged with leaders from the Washington State Health Care Authority to present on the statewide Electronic Consent Management (ECM) system (hope to have them present at a HITAC meeting in 2024)

Protect Individuals' Health Information Privacy (FA5)

Connie Provider-Mediated Affirmative Consent Functionality

- Follows HIE general designation of the program or person permitted to disclose SUD data and able to view data
- Any provider with a treatment relationship with the patient can:
 - Facilitate consent
 - View the patient's Consent History
- Electronic signatures for patient consent
- Flexible expiration dates for consent registration
- Accounting of Disclosures tracking anyone accessing SUD data

Supporting Providers and Agencies in Implementing REL Data Collection Standards (FA2, FA6)

- OHS has drafted updates to the Race Ethnicity and Language (REL) Data Standards and Implementation Plan (Version 3.0)
- Draft Connecticut's Master Implementation Toolkit for REL Data Collection collecting feedback
- Yale's Equity Research and Innovation Center (ERIC) is facilitating provider feedback to the draft; State agencies also reviewing
- Provider information sessions to be hosted by OHS in 2024
- State agency leaders are meeting regularly in a REL Implementor Collaborative



- ☐ Strategic Plan Proposals (8)
 - > Two broad areas:
 - Data enhancements & utilization (4 proposals) and
 - Operational enhancements (4 proposals)
- Internal Prioritization Process
 - ➤ Development of 3 Rails (Tracks)
 - >OHS grouped the proposals based on three factors: resources, processes, and time
 - Resources = staffing, knowledge base, technical tools
 - Processes = already in place to enable execution, coordination with other states/national efforts, stakeholder engagement (insurers/payors, employers and committees/advisory groups)
 - Time horizon



CT APCD Federal Funding - Update

- ❖ OHS requested and received in the 2024 budget cycle additional resources to manage CT APCD and support analytics which include:
 - Two additional positions and,
 - Funding for data enhancement and ad hoc analytics \$50,000
- Federal funding opportunity No new information on the funding
 - No Surprises Act grant of \$2.5m over three years for states to establish or enhance APCD to support market transparency efforts and research
 - Includes provisions to make it easier for self-insured employers to voluntarily participate in state APCDs
 - still awaiting guidance from Federal Dept. of Labor about grant requirements
