4. Presentation by Vermont Green Mountain Care Board

Ms. O'Neill presented on how the State of Vermont operates their APCD data release of health information. Dr. Checko asked if the data collected included self-insured. Ms. O'Neill stated yes but it dropped off after the Kobe decision. Most of the information provided is through voluntary submission.

Ms. O'Neill discussed four areas of data governance concerns. These include Risk Management, Data Quality, Program Sustainability and Data Release. Dr. Checko asked if the program was fully supported by the government. Ms. O'Neill stated that the general fund supports about 40% and 60% is what is called industry bill back where the entities that are regulated pay for the privilege. Ms. O'Neill stated that VT uses a broad use DUA two-year agreement with state agencies. Non-state agencies use smaller agreements. Once an applicant is approved, they are connected with OnPoint who would then charge fees for data extracts. Ms. Freeman asked if it included access to Medicare/Medicaid data. Ms. O'Neill stated that, no, the party would not get access to that data. Non-entities must specify specific data elements requested and reason for use.
