Approval of November 9, 2021 Meeting Minutes

WA-APCD statute allows for different categories of potential users to request different levels of WA-APCD data elements

I. Researchers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Eligible to request the broadest set of data elements, including proprietary financial information, direct patient identifiers, indirect patient identifiers, unique identifiers, or any combinations of these
II. Federal, State and Local Government	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Eligible to request data products that contain proprietary financial information, indirect patient identifiers, unique identifiers, or any combination of these
III. Agencies, Research, and Other Entities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Eligible to request data products that contain indirect patient identifiers or unique identifiers, so long as they do not contain proprietary financial information, direct patient identifiers, or any combination of these
IV. Any person or entity (Release Upon Request)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Eligible to request a dataset that does not contain direct patient identifiers, indirect patient identifiers, proprietary financial information, or any combination of these

WA-APCD data products

I. Analytic Enclave Subscription	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A managed, cloud-based analytic platform offering standard or custom extracts (refreshed quarterly) and a set of analytic tools; annual site license
II. Data Extract	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Standalone data set customized based on data requestor needs; SFTP transfer
III. Custom Analytic Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Program analysts work with the data requestor to pull particular WA-APCD data and perform analyses to answer specific questions
IV. Release Upon Request Data Files	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Two standard de-identified Release Upon Request (RUR) Data extracts
V. Public Use File	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Quality and cost summary report

Select state agency WA-APCD use cases

- WA-APCD surprise billing data set
 - The Surprise Billing Data Set provides payment data for services subject to the Balance Billing Protection Act and was made available by The Office of the Insurance Commissioner in 2020 to assist insurers, facilities, providers, and arbitrators as an independent source of claims payment information.
- Cost of diagnosed diabetes in Washington State
 - Using data from the WA-APCD, Washington State Department of Health (DOH) provided insight into the financial impact of diabetes for individuals in Washington state. In a report to the legislature, DOH estimated health care costs for WA-APCD members with diabetes totaled \$4.9 billion in calendar year 2017.
