Project Goals and Purpose of Claims Analysis

The purpose of this project is to understand external and internal factors contributing to PPSNE's reduced visit volume and identify service enhancements and operational improvements that can increase visit volume.

Demand Analysis 

How does PPSNE's current demand compare to available market share and population needs?

Landscape Analysis 

What market trends impact PPSNE, and what opportunities exist to enhance/expand current service offerings?

Operational Assessment 

What opportunities exist to improve operational performance and service delivery?

We will analyze APCD claims to quantify and describe market demand for PPSNE's service types. ←

Demand Analysis: Implications

Analysis of Connecticut APCD claims data, paired with other market analyses, will help PPSNE to better understand:

Market Share



What proportion of services does PPSNE provide?

Payor Mix



How does PPSNE's payor mix compare to that of the market?

Reimbursement Rates



How do PPSNE's reimbursement rates compare to the market?

Unmet Need



In which zip codes are there pockets of unmet need?

Demand Analysis: Methodology

The Demand Analysis will use Connecticut All Payor Claims Data to estimate total met and unmet need for PPSNE's service types, describe utilization patterns for these service types, and describe the population using these services.

APCD Data Elements Needed

Medical Claims 2018 – 2023

- Date (Month) of Service
- Member age
- Insurance type
- Procedure code
- Telehealth flag
- Claim charged and paid amount
- Member costs

Provider Information (to be linked)

- Provider NPI
- Provider Type
- Provider Specialty

We will identify and sort claims belonging to one of PPSNE's four service types, and for each service type:

- Calculate **proportion of visits (by type) provided by PPSNE** for each year
- Calculate **average reimbursement** and **patient cost** for each specific service
- Calculate **payor mix** for the market and for key service providers
- **Calculate the proportion** of telehealth visits provided
- Compare **total claims to expected market demand**

Data and Work Product Safeguards

We take the security of APCD data seriously. Data will be transferred, stored, and accessed in accordance with PPSNE and Day Health's respective WISPs, and is covered under our shared BAA. We will take the following measures to safeguard APCD data:



Secure cloud storage

All data files and resulting work will be stored securely on PPSNE's MS Azure sharefiles or AWS servers. Data provided to Day Health will be transferred and stored on ShareFile.



Minimum Required Data and Users

We have ensured our request limits the amount of data to only what is required. During analysis, all files will be stored in password-protected, limited access folders on ShareFile.



Written Information Security Policies

All data use for this analysis will abide by PPSNE and Day Health's WISPs and our shared business associates agreement. These documents address compliance with HIPAA and HITECH standards.

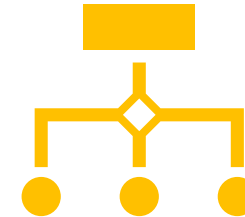
