



#### **Medication History**



Value is greatest when medication history/reconciliation functionality is integrated seamlessly into EHR workflows

Data timeliness, completeness, structure/ontologies may be preconditions.

Chronic Disease
Management &
Medication Therapy
Management (MTM)



Medication data associated with chronic care management and medication management therapy is required for Medicare compliance

#### **Population Health**



Data normalization are necessary for effective analytics

Timeliness of data availability (i.e. near real-time) is less important than it is for other use cases
