Expense Definitions

Beginning with 2017, OHS established a new hospital reporting system (HRS) database for hospital filers. At that time, we reconfigured the expenses from the old database's Report 175 and moved them into 7 main groups (see Financial Stability Report- FSR Figure 5). The sum of each group should agree to the hospital's Audited Financial Statement (AFS) amount. As an example, all salary and wage inputs should agree back to the (AFS) amounts for salaries and wages.

We removed the definitions from the instructions because the amounts need to tie back to the AFS. Most of these definitions are self-explanatory (Electricity, Building leases, laundry/linen, etc). Hospitals may reclassify amounts in the filing whether due to personnel changes, mistakes gathering data, or changes to their computer systems, therefore, we felt it was best to indicate they need to agree to the AFS amounts.
