

# Statewide Health Care Facilities and Services Plan

- OHS Published the preliminary draft of the 2024 FSP at the end of June
- FSP serves as advisory document and blueprint for health care delivery in Connecticut
  - Statutory element of the Certificate of Need application process
- Stakeholder engagement began with presentations to the Health Care Cabinet and to the public
- OHS reached out to providers, hospitals and community members to participate in FSP Advisory Work Groups in July

- Goal is to incorporate FSP updates as core OHS function on rolling basis
