Medical Group Practice Statutory Requirements

- ❖ Connecticut General Statutes (C.G.S.) § 19a-486i (g) and (h), requires:
 - ❖ each hospital, hospital system, non-hospital owned/affiliated group medical practices comprised of **30+ physicians** to submit an annual report to the Attorney General and Office of Health Strategy ("OHS") by January 15th.
- ❖ The filings include the following:
 - ❖ Medical group practice and its affiliation to a hospital or health system
 - ❖ A list of the practice's physicians and their specialties
 - ❖ Practice location, primary service area zip codes and specialty services provided at the location

Companion Filings

❖ Companion requirements are filings of:

1. C.G.S. §19a-486i (c) requires a group practice to notify OHS on any “material change to the business or corporate structure of a group practice”
 - ❖ For a practice with two or more physicians legally organized into a partnership, limited liable company to provide health care services, medical foundation, not-for-profit corporation which have overhead expenses and bill for services
 - ❖ Filing required **30 days** prior to the effective date of a merger, consolidation or other affiliation with another **group practice of 8+ physicians, hospital or healthcare system**
2. C.G.S. §33-182bb(g) requires a hospital, health system, medical school, independent association or business entity organized as a medical foundation to practice medicine and provide health care services to file certain information with OHS
3. C.G.S. §19a-486i(i) requires notifications to OHS on affiliations of 2+ entities that permit the entities to negotiate with third parties for professional medical services

Purposes of the Requirements

❖ For Certificate of Need purposes:

- ❖ To assess if the consolidation will adversely affect health care costs or accessibility to care
- ❖ To assess where the change will negatively impact the diversity of health care providers and patient choice in the geographic region

❖ To enable the CT Attorney General's Office to review issues related to monopoly and their impact on consumers

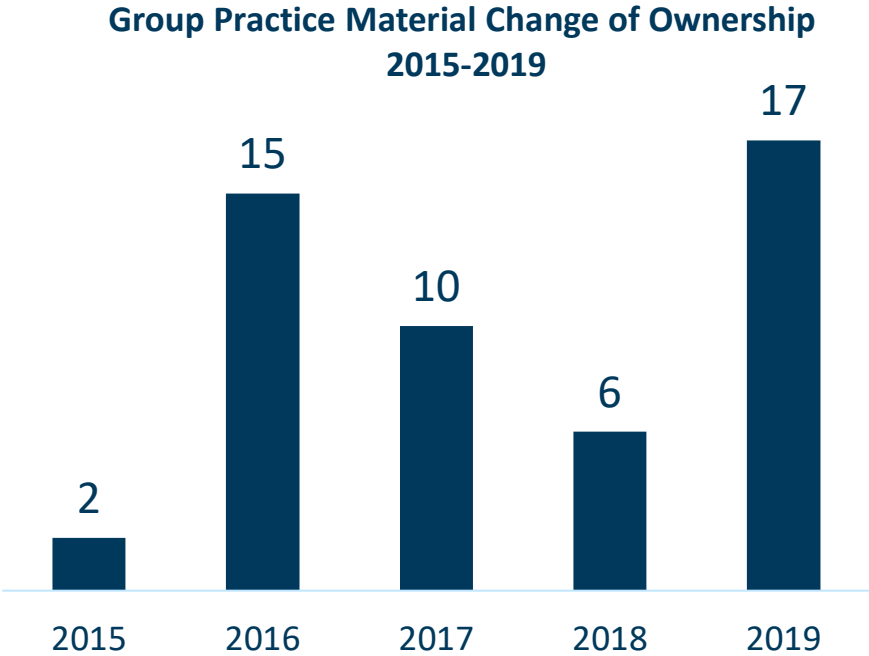

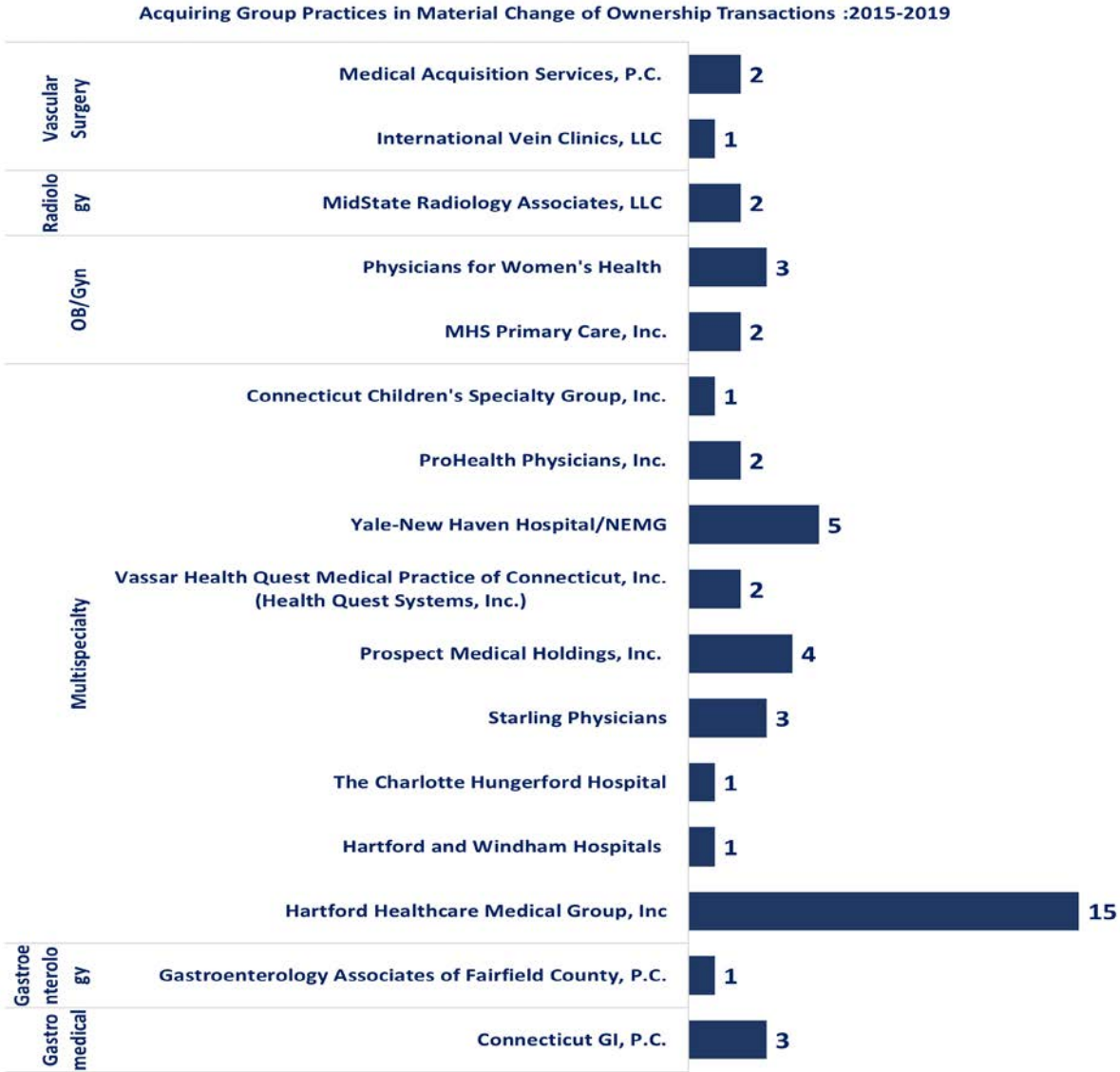

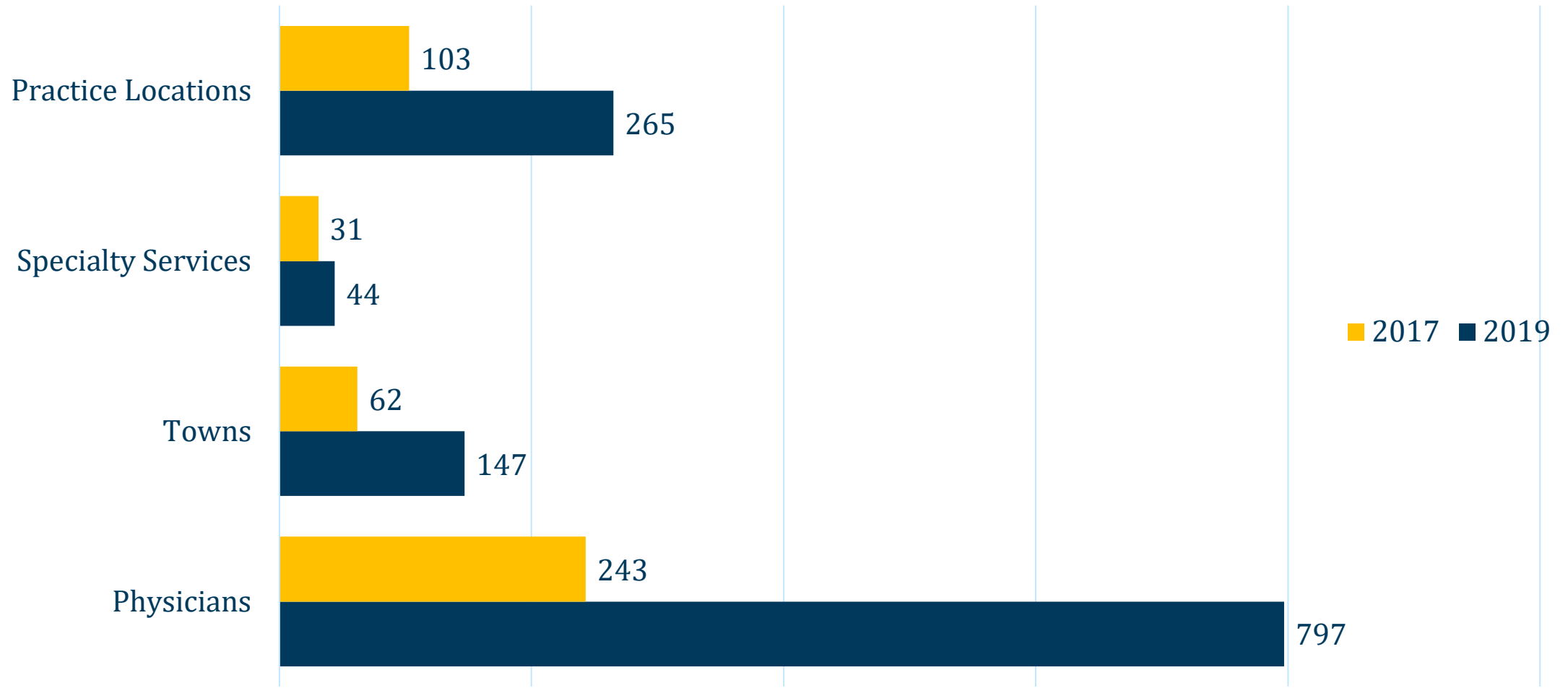

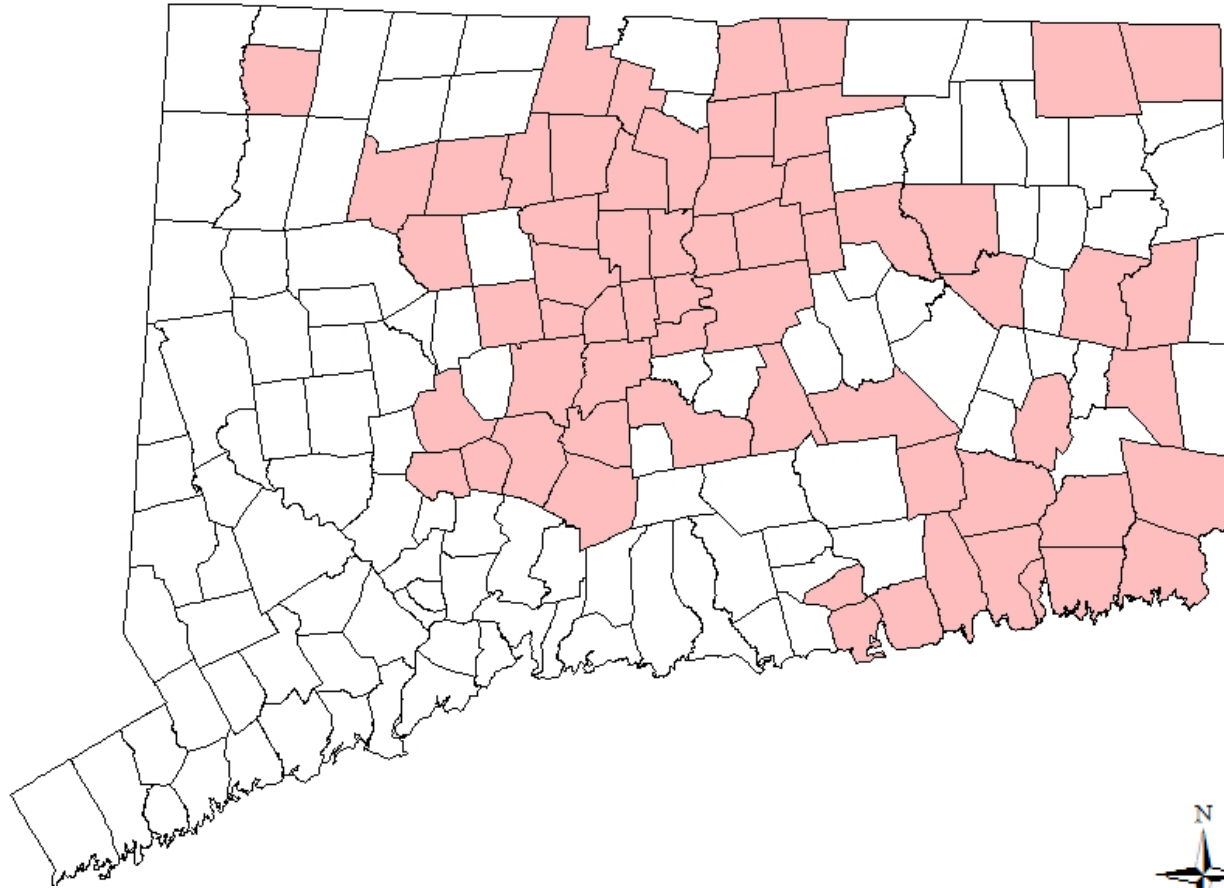
PRIMARY SERVICE AREA CHANGES FOR THREE GROUP PRACTICES

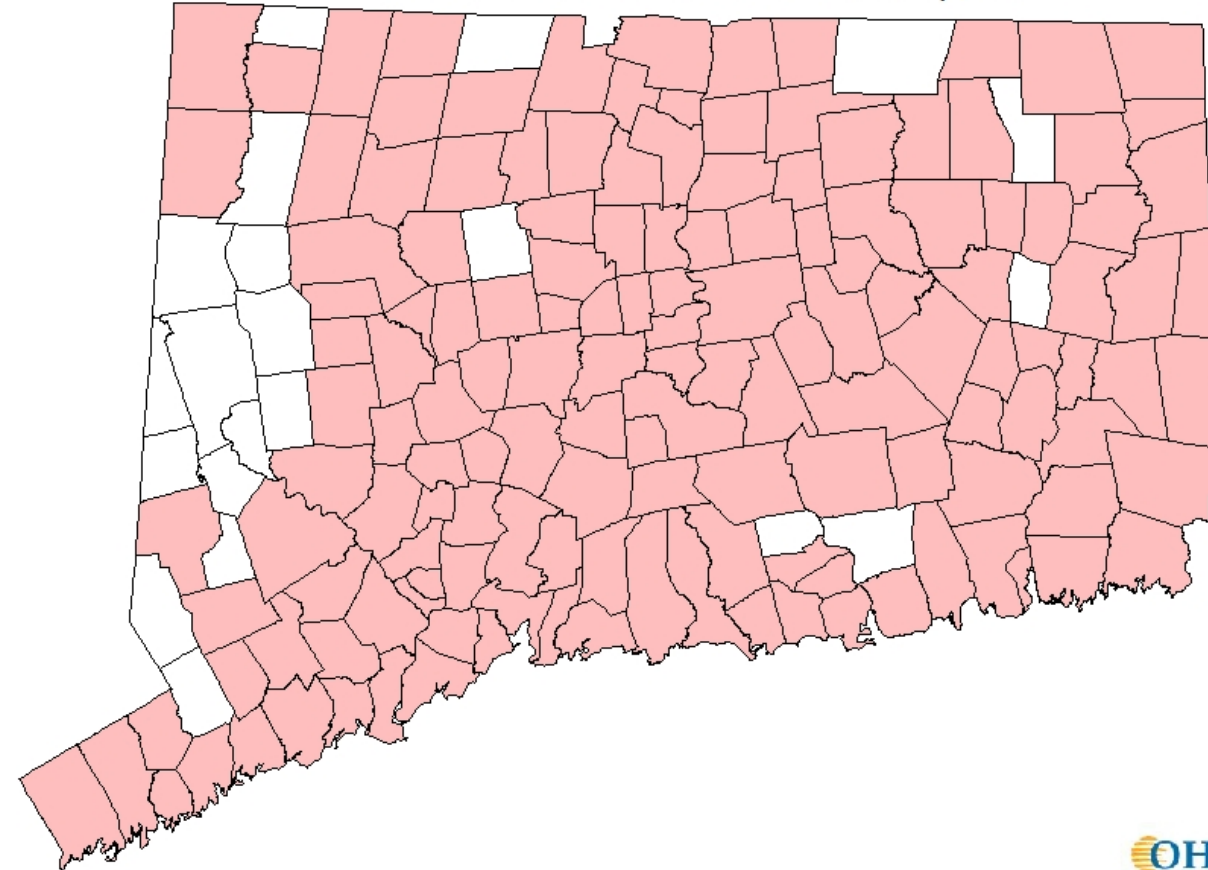


Hartford Healthcare Medical Group Primary Service Area, 2017 v 2019

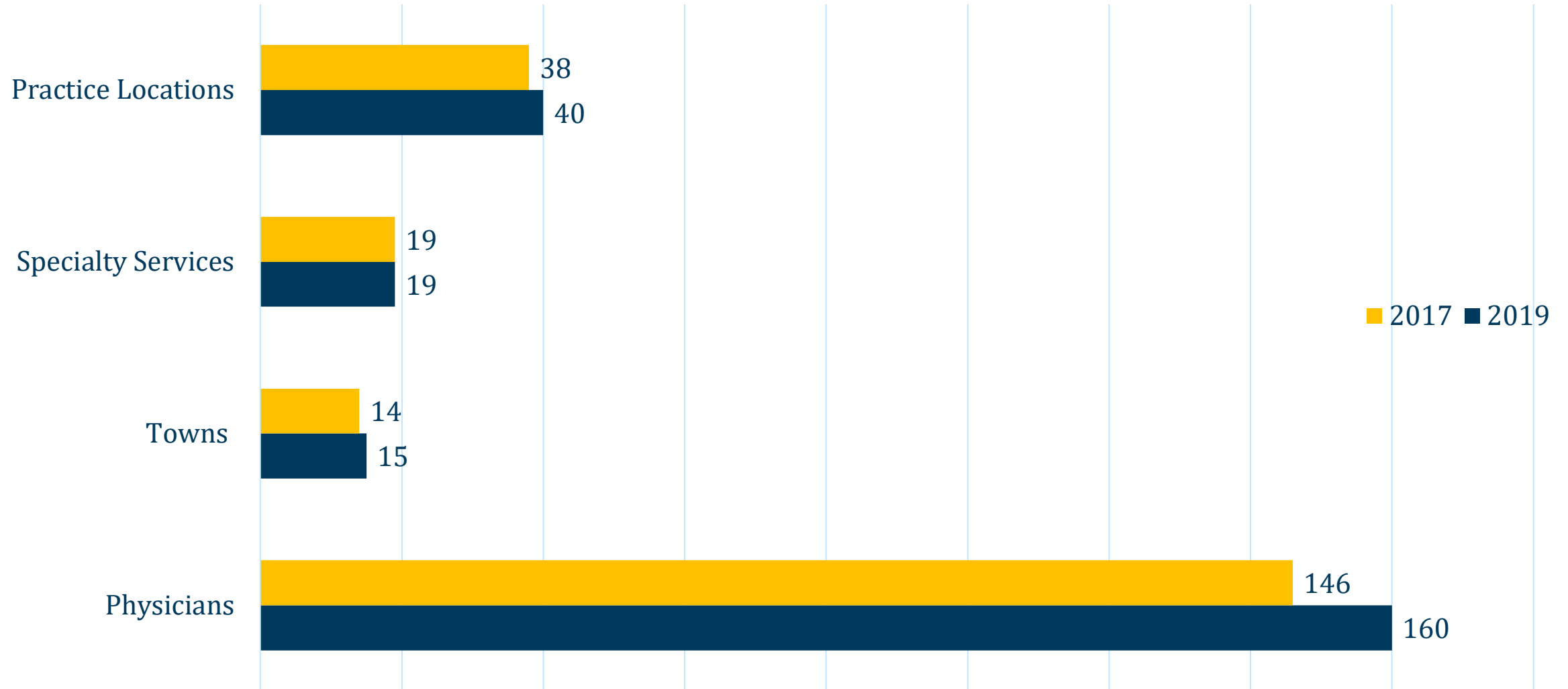

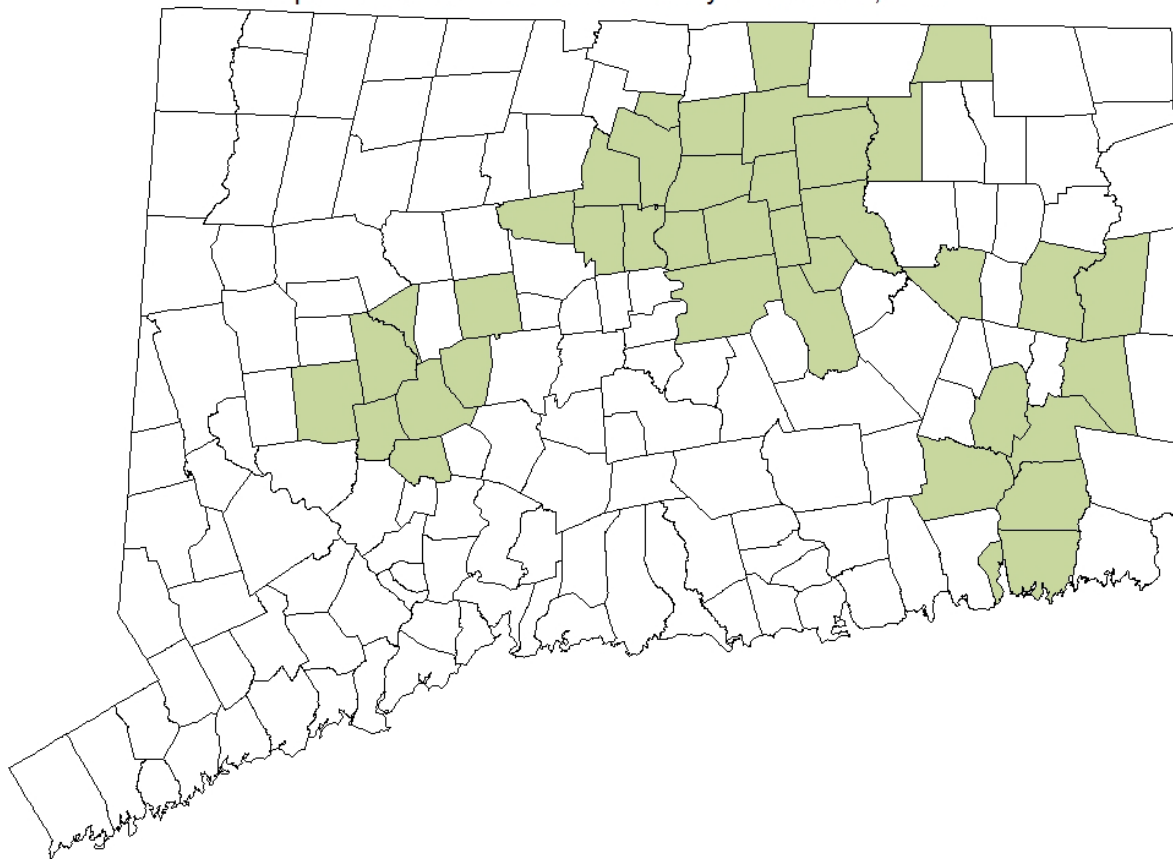

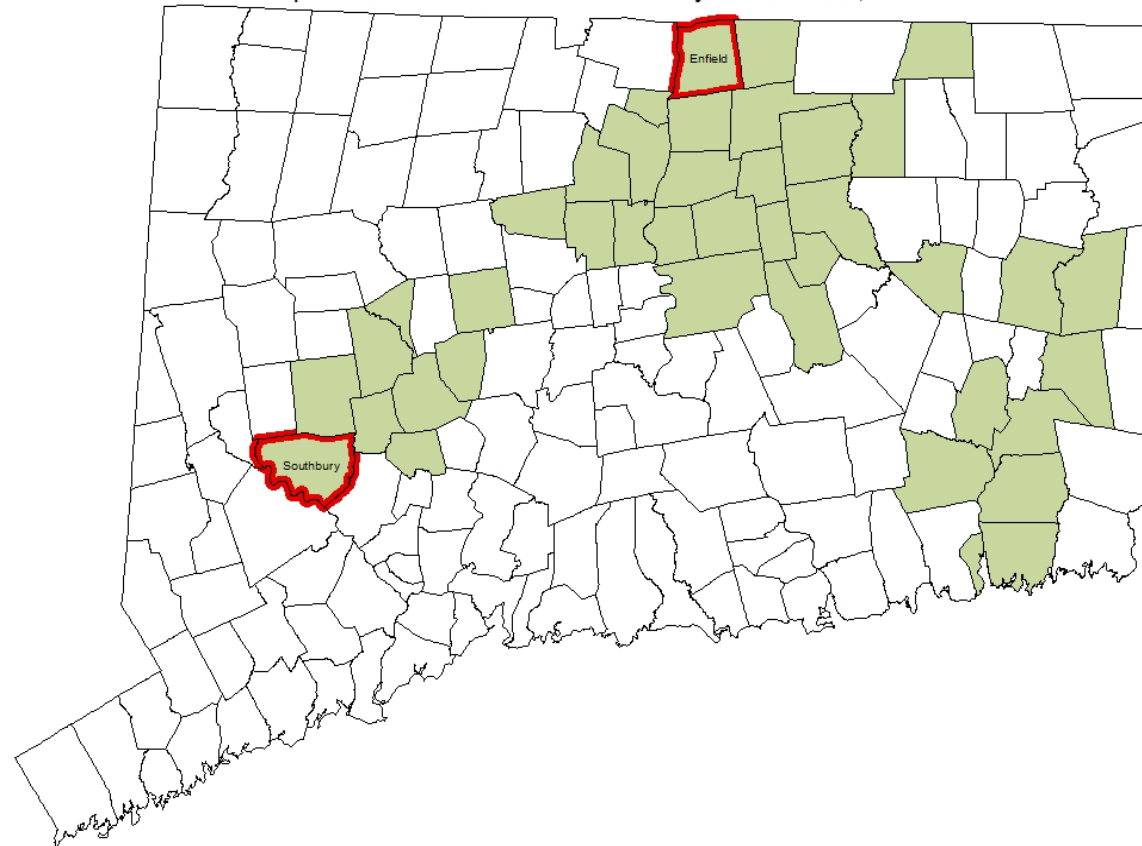


Prospect CT Medical Foundation, Primary Service Area, 2017 v 2019

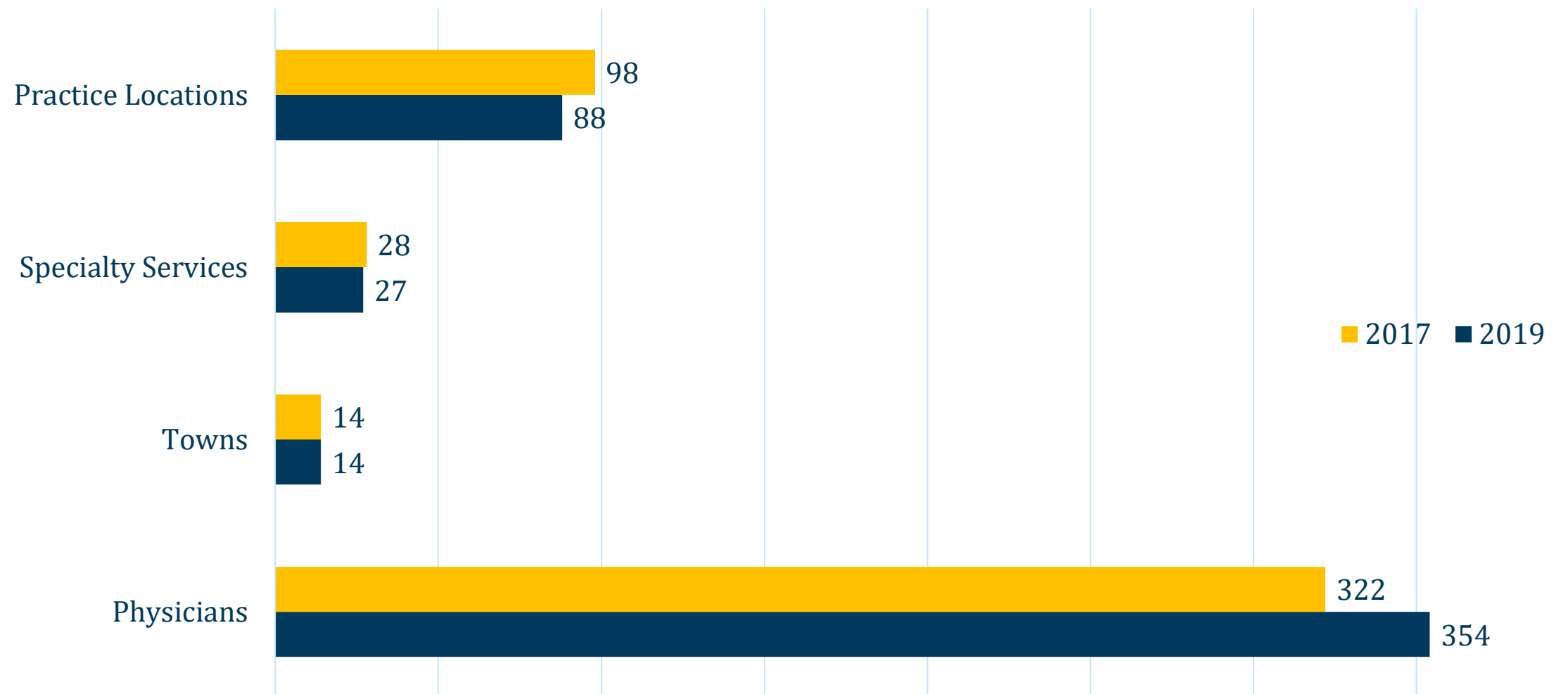
Prospect CT Medical Foundation Primary Service Area, 2017



Prospect CT Medical Foundation Primary Service Area, 2019

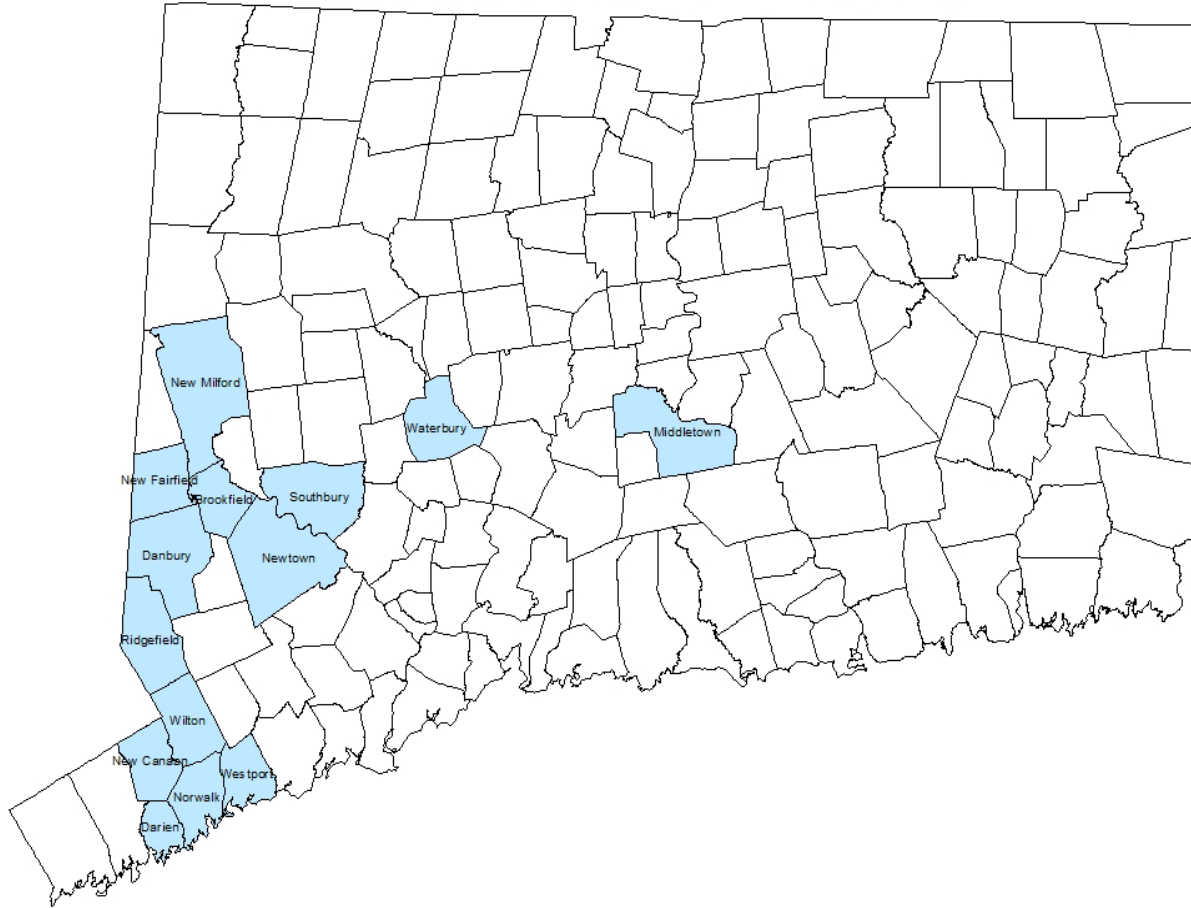

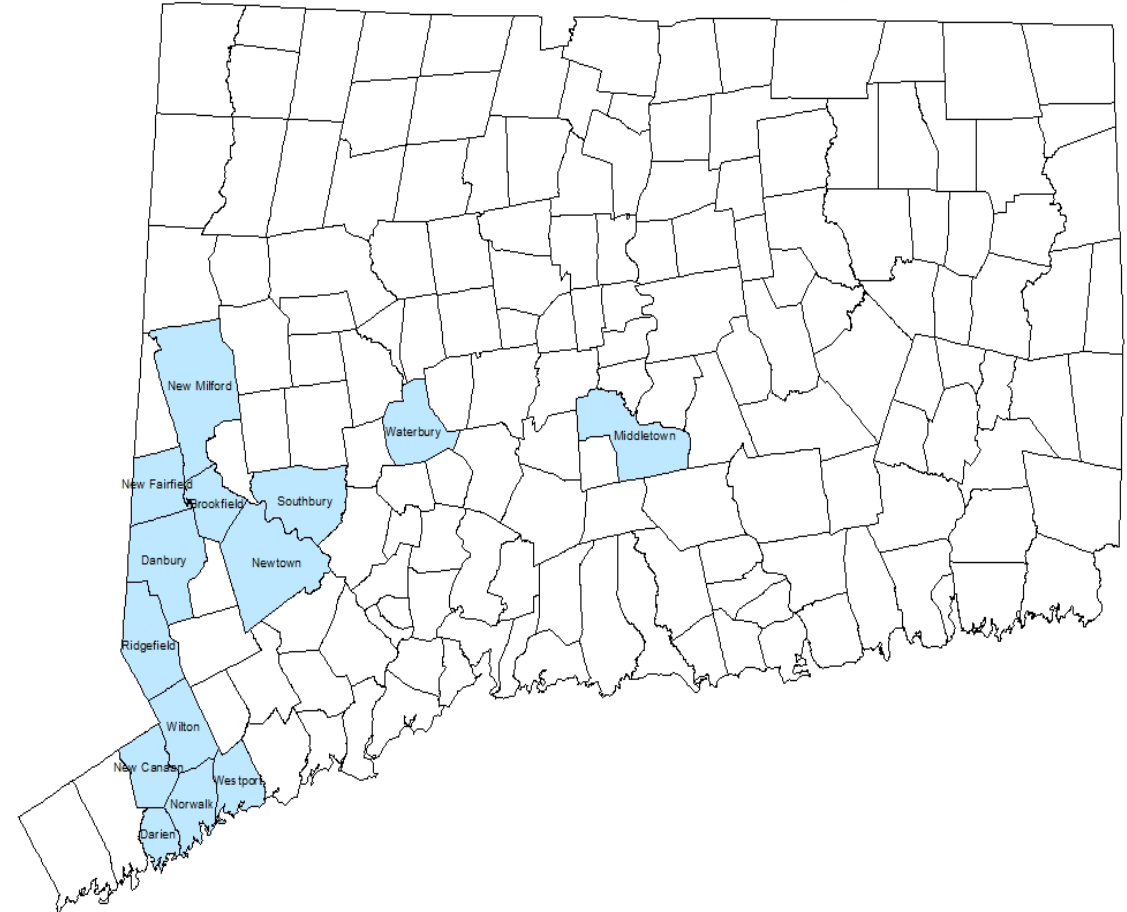


Western CT Medical Group, Inc., Primary Service Area, 2017 v 2019

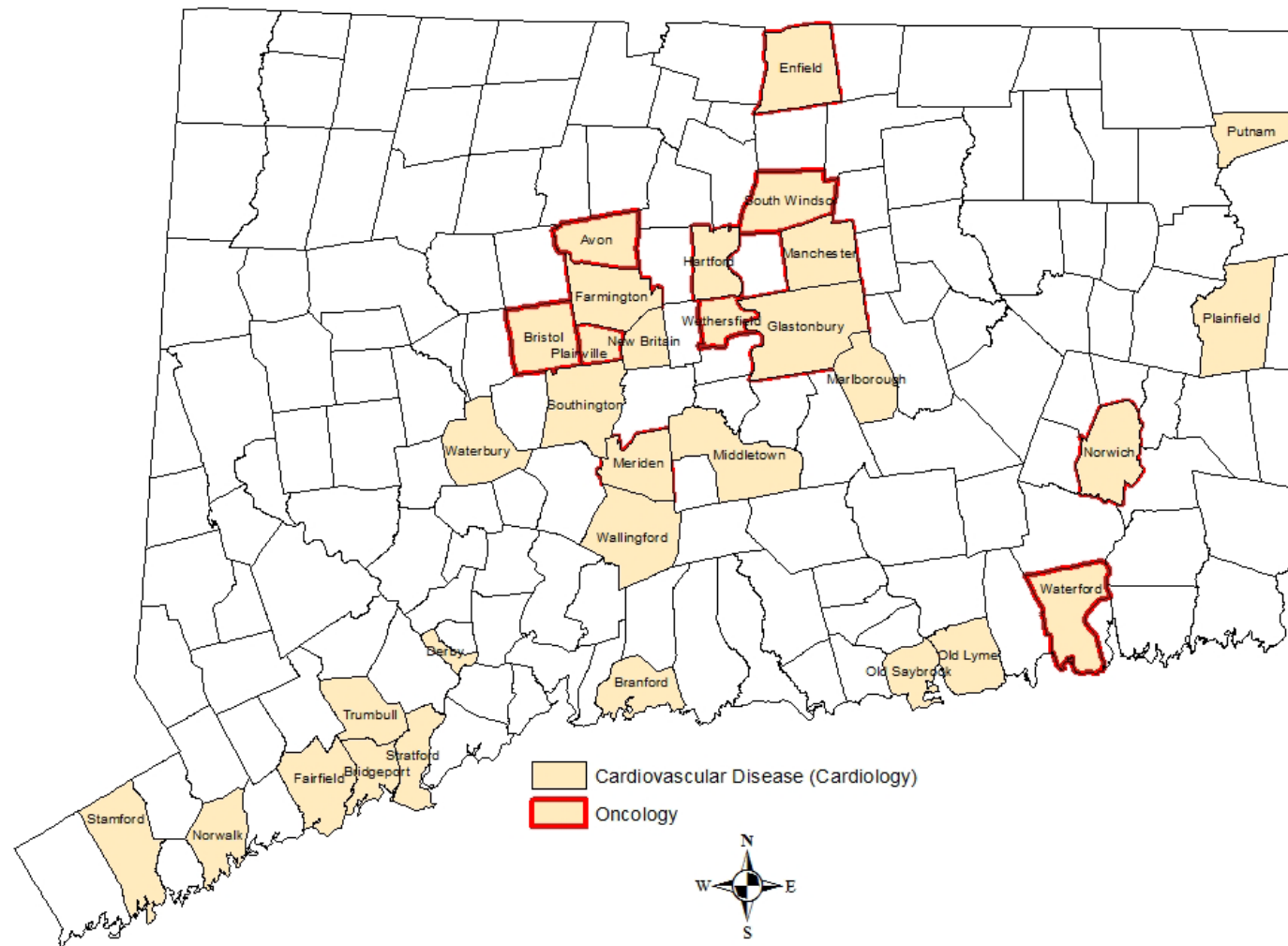


Western CT Medical Group, Inc. Primary Service Area, 2019

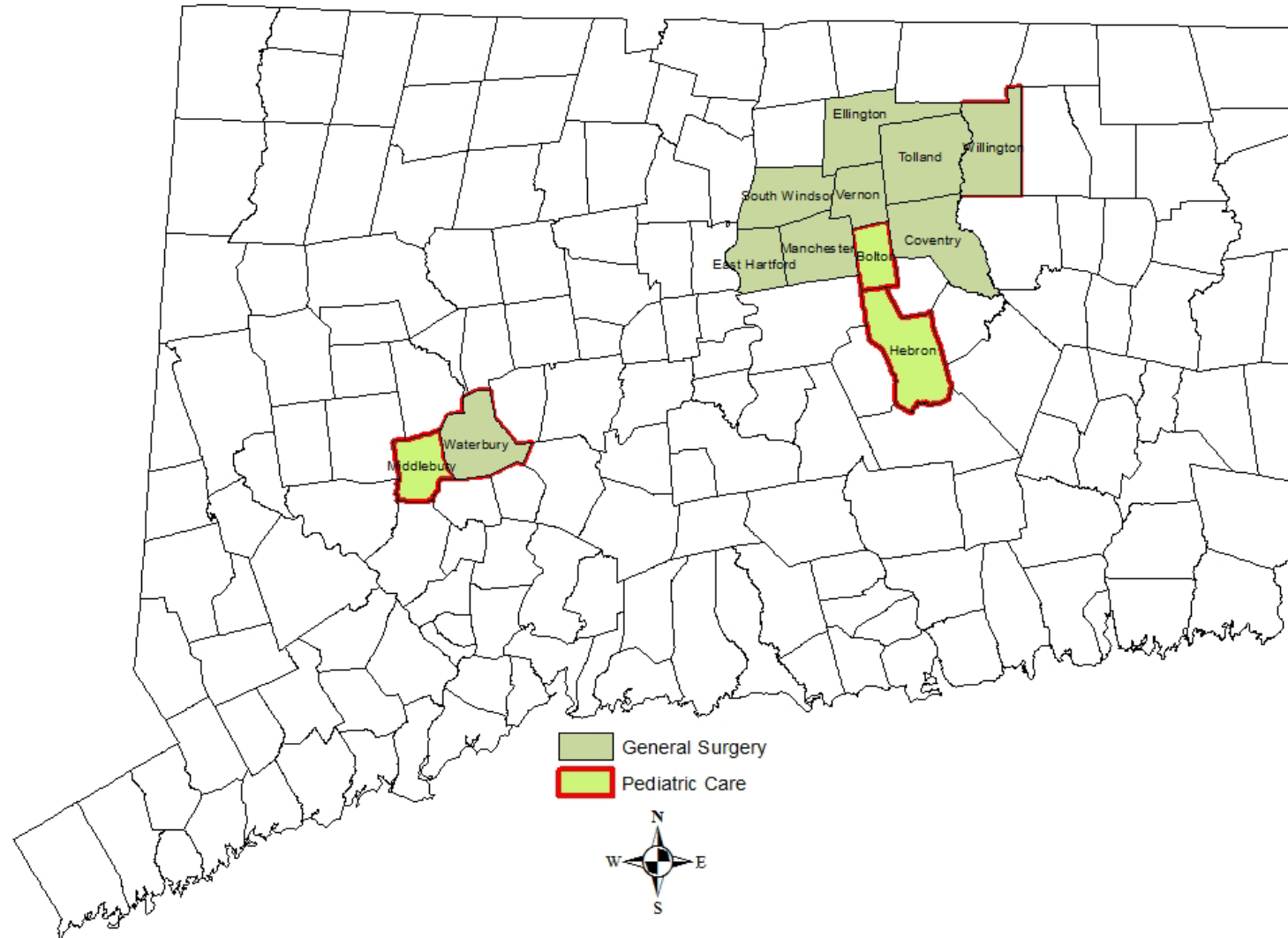


OUTPATIENT MEDICAL SPECIALTY SERVICE AREAS

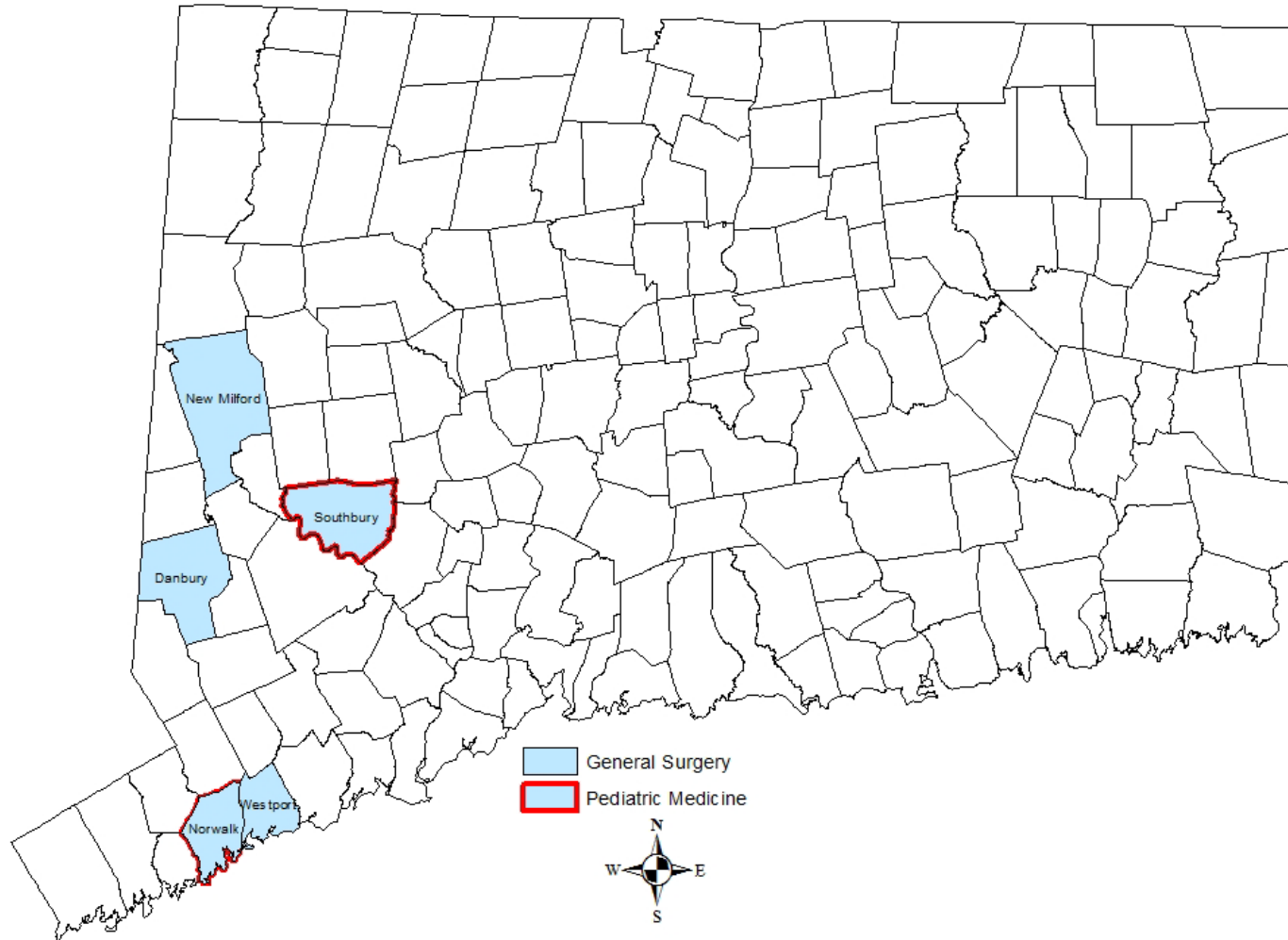
Hartford Healthcare Medical Group – Cardiovascular and Oncology Service Locations

OBSERVATIONS & FUTURE IMPROVEMENTS

❖ Observations

- ❖ These group practice filings are *not a comprehensive* list of group practices in the state
 - ❖ Limited to only group practices and providers that have 30+ physicians
- ❖ A group practice may have a wide primary service coverage area but not all specialty services are provided at all the locations
- ❖ Most large group practices:
 - ❖ are affiliated to a health system
 - ❖ provide multispecialty services and
 - ❖ tend to acquire single specialty small group practices
- ❖ Single specialty group practices tend to acquire small group practices that offer relatively similar specialty services

❖ Future improvement

- ❖ Make data more accessible to policymakers and consumers through maps and dashboards of services and locations
