## Rescission of Guidance Regarding the Certificate of Need Requirements for the Acquisition of Imaging Equipment

## OHS\_HSP Guidance 19-001

The Office of Health Strategy, Health Systems Planning Unit (HSP) has rescinded Guidance Document 19-001. **Effective immediately**, a Certificate of Need (CON) will be required for the acquisition of a single positron emission computed tomography (SPECT), SPECT-CT and/or cone beam computed tomography (CBCT) scanner.<sup>1</sup>

The HSP will not require any person, physician, provider, short-term acute care general hospital or children's hospital that acquired a SPECT, SPECT- CBCT scanner between **May 10**, **2019 and November 19, 2019**, in reliance upon Guidance Document 19-001, to retroactively submit a CON application.

Additionally, any person, physician, provider, short-term acute care general hospital or children's hospital that acquired a SPECT, SPECT- CBCT scanner between **May 10, 2019 and November 19, 2019**, who seeks to subsequently replace or relocate those scanners, should include proof of acquisition of the equipment during that period in their notification to HSP.
