Change Level of Neonatal Nursery Program

Dear Ms. Brown:

On April 5, 2005, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your letter concerning the neonatal nursery program's change from a Level Two to a Level Three neonatal program.

OHCA staff has reviewed the CON Determination form and has made the findings listed below:

- 1. Greenwich Hospital's ("Hospital") neonatal nursery program has been classified as a Level Two neonatal-perinatal program since 1982.
- 2. According to the American Academy of Pediatrics("AAP") and the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists ("ACOG") guidelines, the neonatal nursery program's classification has changed from a Level Two to a Level Three neonatal program. The change resulted from revisions to the guidelines adopted in 2002.
- 3. The Hospital is proposing to change the classification level of the neonatal nursery program to coincide with the AAP and ACOG guidelines.
- 4. There is no program change, expansion, reduction, or new service and no capital expenditure associated with the proposal.

Based on these findings and pursuant to Section 19a-638 of the Connecticut General Statutes, OHCA has determined that Greenwich Hospital does not intend to change, expand, reduce or introduce a new service. CON approval from OHCA is not required for Greenwich Hospital to reclassify the neonatal nursery program to a Level Three program.
