Establish Psychiatric Outpatient Clinic for Adults in Clinton, Meriden, Middletown, New Britain, and New London

Dear Mr. Kearney:

The Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") is in receipt of your request for exemption from the Certificate of Need ("CON") process, pursuant to Section 19a-639(c) of the Connecticut General Statutes ("C.G.S."), for the establishment of a psychiatric outpatient clinic for adults at the Community Health Center, Inc. at 114 East Main Street in Clinton, 134 State Street in Meriden, 631 Main Street in Middletown, 1 Washington Square in New Britain, and 1 Shaw's Cove in New London, CT.

Upon review of the information contained in the request, OHCA finds the following:

- 1. Community Health Center, Inc. ("CHC") is a private, non-profit, Federally Qualified Health Center ("FQHC").
- 2. Community Health Center, Inc. is proposing to establish a psychiatric outpatient clinic for adults at 114 East Main Street in Clinton, 134 State Street in Meriden, 631 Main Street in Middletown, 1 Washington Square in New Britain, and 1 Shaw's Cove in New London, CT.
- 3. Community Health Center, Inc. receives funds from the Department of Public Health.

- 4. Each of the CHC sites is located in a designated medically underserved population area or derives more than half of its patients from a designated medically underserved population area.
- 5. The Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services ("DMHAS"), in a letter dated June 22, 2005, from Commissioner Thomas A. Kirk, Jr., Ph.D., recommends an exemption under CGS Section 19a-639b for Community Health Center, Inc. to provide outpatient psychiatric services for adults at 114 East Main Street in Clinton, 134 State Street in Meriden, 631 Main Street in Middletown, 1 Washington Square in New Britain, and 1 Shaw's Cove in New London, CT.
- 6. DMHAS states that CHC reported serving the following number of clients over a recent six-month period at the following locations: Clinton 147, Meriden 304, Middletown 549, New Britain 226, and New London 62.
- 7. The total capital expenditure associated with the proposal is \$0.

Based on the above findings, OHCA has determined that the establishment of a psychiatric outpatient clinic for adults at the Community Health Center, Inc. at 114 East Main Street in Clinton, 134 State Street in Meriden, 631 Main Street in Middletown, 1 Washington Square in New Britain, and 1 Shaw's Cove in New London, CT meets the exemption requirements of Section 19a-639(c) of the Connecticut General Statutes and, therefore, is exempt from OHCA's CON process. Termination of these services would require CON approval, pursuant to Section 19a-638, C.G.S.
