Establish Psychiatric Outpatient Treatment Program for Adults in New Haven

Dear Ms. Rodriguez:

The Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") is in receipt of your request for exemption from the Certificate of Need ("CON") process, pursuant to Section 19a-639b of the Connecticut General Statutes ("C.G.S."), to establish a psychiatric outpatient treatment program for adults at 45 Dixwell Avenue in New Haven.

Upon review of the information contained in the request, OHCA finds the following:

- 1. 'Rkids, Inc. is a non-profit facility that currently provides clinic assessment, treatment, parent education and support services to adoptive, foster, and relative caregivers at 45 Dixwell Avenue in New Haven.
- 2. 'Rkids, Inc. is proposing to establish a psychiatric outpatient treatment program for adults at 45 Dixwell Avenue in New Haven.
- 3. The Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services ("DMHAS"), in a letter dated June 19, 2006, from Deputy Commissioner Peter B. Rockholz, M.S.S.W., recommends an exemption under CGS Section 19a-639b for 'Rkids, Inc. to provide outpatient and intensive outpatient psychiatric services for adults.
- 4. DMHAS states that 'Rkids, Inc. anticipates serving 45 to 50 children and 40 to 45

parents/adult adoptees annually. The services will assist foster and adoptive families experiencing stress and/or behavioral issue brought on by the many challenges encountered in caring for children in transition and adult adoptees.

5. The total capital expenditure associated with the proposal is \$6,000.00

Based on the above findings, OHCA has determined that 'Rkids, Inc.'s request to establish a psychiatric outpatient treatment program for adults at 45 Dixwell Avenue in New Haven meets the exemption requirements of Section 19a-636b of the Connecticut General Statutes and, therefore, is exempt from OHCA's CON process. Termination of these services would require CON approval, pursuant to Section 19a-638, C.G.S.
