Dear Ms Freimuth:

On July 21, 2008, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your Certificate of Need ("CON") Determination request concerning the proposal of Catholic Charities, Inc. - Archdiocese of Hartford for the relocation of its services from 478 Orange Street in New Haven to 501 Lombard Street in New Haven, Connecticut. OHCA has reviewed the information contained in your CON Determination request letter and makes the following findings:

- Catholic Charities, Inc. Archdiocese of Hartford ("CCI") is a non-profit facility
 providing adult outpatient psychiatric and substance abuse treatment at various locations
 in Connecticut.
- 2. CCI is proposing to relocate its existing licensed services for adults and children from 478 Orange Street in New Haven, to 501 Lombard Street in New Haven, Connecticut. The new location is owned by CCI, and this new facility with expanded space and parking will allow CCI to better serve its clients from the Greater New Haven area.
- 3. The 478 Orange Street office of CCI is currently licensed as follows:
 - Psychiatric Outpatient Clinic for Adults (DPH),
 - Facility for the Care or Treatment of Substance Abusive or Dependent Persons (DPH),
 - Outpatient Psychiatric Clinic for Children (DCF), and
 - Child Placing Agency (DCF).

- 4. The service area and target population will not change as a result of the relocation of the existing licensed services for adults and children.
- 5. No additional programs are proposed and no services will be terminated.
- 6. The total capital expenditure associated with this relocation is \$2,400,000.

Based on these findings, OHCA has determined that Certificate of Need approval is not required for Catholic Charities, Inc. – Archdiocese of Hartford to proceed with the relocation of its existing licensed services for adults and children from 478 Orange Street in New Haven to 501 Lombard Street in New Haven, Connecticut. Termination of these services would require CON approval, pursuant to Section 19a-638, C.G.S.
