- **Partial Summary of Current Systems**

- **Current Obstacles to Data Reporting**

There are several current obstacles that currently prevent facilities from gathering patient level data. As facilities move toward electronic medical records and upgrade systems, this will become easier. Some of the existing barriers include:

- Inability to gather and transmit the data points identified based on current systems
- Lack of widespread use of EMR and no federal incentives—unlike those provided to hospitals to move in that direction
- Increased time and staffing necessary to increase data collected during patient registration
- Proprietary information
- Lack of infrastructure, no IT department or dedicated staff
- Federal legislation with a 2015 effective date to move toward increased data gathering
- Some facilities as part of CON were providing data, but not in a useable format, often in paper and in some cases staffing has changed at those facilities
