5	Healthcare Markets Antitrust Presentation	Fiona Scott Morton		

Steven Lazarus introduced Fiona Scott Morton from the Yale School of Management who provided the group with a presentation entitled "Antitrust Enforcement in Healthcare Markets Physician practices and hospitals"

Below are some of the highlights from the presentation.

- An overview of the demand curve.
- A review of how competitive prices affect supply and demand.
- A look at the differences between competitive prices, consumer surplus, and monopoly prices and the result on supply and demand along with profits.
- Strategies that can be used to increase profits such as collusion, mergers or monopolies.
- The concentration of hospitals, insurers, physician specialists and primary care physicians.
- The consolidation of insurers, hospitals and physician practices in recent years.
- How to enforce hospital mergers and physician-hospital mergers.
- The potential harm to competition from hospital acquisition of physician practices including leverage, arbitrage, and steerage.
- Evidence that changes are associated with increases in health spending and physician prices.
