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	<ul> <li>Concern was expressed that the division may isolate healthcare transformation in a way that will limit its ultimate capacity and success. Suggestions were made that it would be better to have a blending of the concepts between population health, community health, and practice transformation rather than separating them.</li> <li>There was also a suggestion to keep the subgroups but create an AD Hoc structure for a discussion of issues that are relevant for the time. The Ad Hoc structure could discuss, resolve the issue, and bring it back to the larger workgroup.</li> <li>Mr. Hostetler said they will take the comments, convene with OHS and the co-chairs, think them through, and email the group on how they plan to address them. It was mentioned that it is helpful to have an inventory of all the different tools. 8.	Medicaid PCMH and PCMH+ Models Presentation Kate McEvoy
	<ul> <li>Kate McEvoy of Department of Social Services (DSS) presented on the Medicaid Person Centered Medical Home (PCMH) and PCMH+ Models.</li> <li>There was a question about whether health outcome measures are being tracked for the Medicaid population in PCMH and PCMH+ such as obesity, healthy weight, and child well-being. It was noted that an analysis was done that was outcome focused particularly for people with diabetes. They are a proxy for specific outcome measures. There is also a lot of important work being done to specific areas with observations around access and utilization. Members continued to discuss the PCMH models.</li> </ul>
