What a powerful, long but amazing day we had at the Public Health Committee hearing on Monday! Here is a quick rundown of what happened:

The Public Health Committee has until April 3rd to vote the bill out of committee. They only meet on M, W, and F, so this translates to 3 days to get the bill out of committee!
