## Duals Demonstration

enable person-centered, multi-disciplinary care coordination for Medicare-Medicaid enrollees via two models - one through the Medicaid medical Adminstrative Services Organization (ASO) and the other through new networks called "health neighborhoods"

## Integration

## DMHAS Behavioral Health Home

use person-centered care planning to integrate behavioral health, medical and community services and supports for Medicaid beneficiaries with Serious and Persistent Mental Illness through Local Mental Health Authorities

## Medicaid Quality Improvement Shared Savings Program

improve health outcomes and care experience of Medicaid-only beneficiaries served by Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and "advanced networks" (e.g. Accountable Care Organizations, ACOs)
