



Design Subcommittee (1 of 6)

- Meetings

- > Review process
 - Pre-meeting: review task and preference survey
 - Meeting: preference survey results presented, discussion, recommendations

Design Subcommittee (2 of 6)

Navigation, Functionality and Results Display

- > Navigation to results from:
 - Home page
 - Healthcare organization results page

> Functionality of Healthcare Organization Page

- Filters results view by:
 - Broad health topic (e.g., behavioral health)
 - Measure (e.g., breast cancer screening)
 - Quality care rating (e.g., average)
- Sort results table: clicking column heading
- Hover definitions: Quality Care Rating, Score, State Average, and Measures

> Display of results:

Three visualization options: HCO overall summary, table view, graph view

Pre-Meeting Review Task:

- Find results for a specific healthcare organizations and refine results view using filters.
- Rate 11 survey items on a five point scale from: "Very Easy" to "Very Hard"

Design Subcommittee (3 of 6)

Meeting Consensus

- > Positive feedback
 - Structure includes desired functionality
 - Easy navigating to HCO results
 - Filtering by health topic/category is useful
 - Results graph summarizes information well

Design Subcommittee (4 of 6)

Recommendations

- Integrate hover or simple instructions on the results pages, in addition to a more detailed "Need Help" page.
- Search/filter drop down menus would be easier to use if the following changes can be made: notify how to select or deselect options, add visible check boxes, make closing the box easier, and integrate a scroll bar when there is a long list.
- Increase visibility of options to view results (table vs. graph).
- Further explanation of Rating criteria should be integrated (when available).
- Decision made to include the rating benchmark in the default view of the results table
- Include more definitions of terms via hover or link

Design Subcommittee (5 of 6)

Rating symbols

- > Provided options:
 - Six color schemes
 - Six shape schemes
- > Recommended approach:
 - Top ranked color and shape scheme by the 6 Design Subcommittee members

 - Develop design alternatives for review

 - Measure labels, brief measure definitions (for hover), and measure descriptions (for measure results page)

 - Navigation alternatives and results page instructions
 - Content for the "About" page
