The division is responsible for the Municipal Accountability Review Board under the Connecticut General Statutes (Section 367 of Public Act 17-2) to provide technical and financial assistance and accountability for cities and towns experiencing fiscal distress. The intern will work closely with the Finance Division team and Executive Financial Officer to support the division while learning about a career in Finance. This internship is unpaid and is a minimum of 10 hours per week.
