Please be advised that this office represents Strategic Commercial Realty, Inc. DBA Rawson Materials ("Applicant") and Richard L. Gilman, Trustee of the Lawrence M. Gilman 1989 Trust ("Property Owner"). The Gilman Trust is the owner of a 95 acre, more or less, parcel of land located on the northerly side of Fitchville Road, the easterly side of Brush Hill Road and the westerly side of Stockhouse Road in the Town of Bozrah, Connecticut. Rawson Materials has filed an application with the Town of Bozrah Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Commission for licenses to conduct regulated activities in conjunction with an earth products excavation, processing and removal operation on that portion of the Gilman Trust property which is located within the limits of the Industrial-80 Zoning District located on the easterly side of Brush Hill Road and the westerly side of Stockhouse Road.
