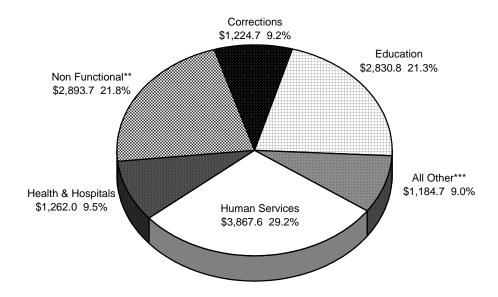

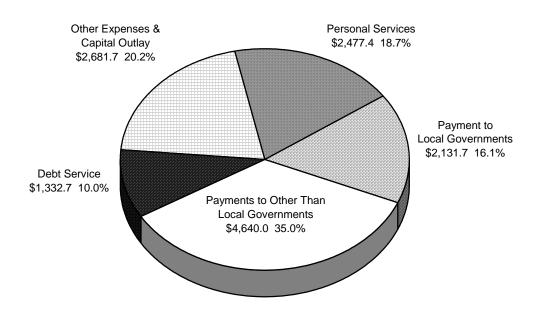

BY MAJOR OBJECT



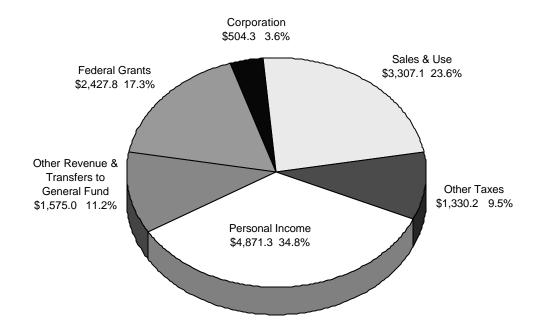

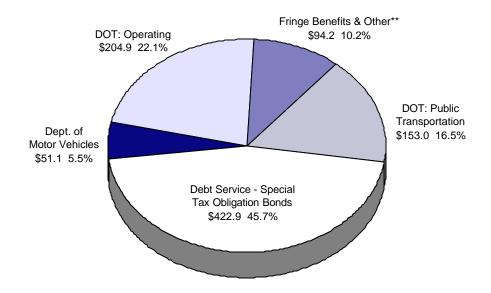

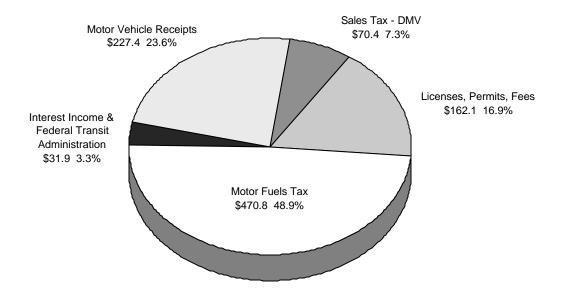
