Since the initial NextGenCT proposal was developed, a lot of thoughtful planning has been done to better identify the appropriate needs to support the NextGenCT goals. Specifically, in the initial plan the "Operating Needs/Student" line (\$6M) and "Staff Operating Support" line (\$800k) were generalized expenses such as:

"Examples of other items UConn will be funding through operating budget: Graduate Assistants, new course sections, new facility maintenance, increased infrastructure costs (water, sewer, electricity, etc...), public safety, IT support, Library acquisitions/storage"

As we have evaluated the needs and impact of NextGenCT, additional required positions were identified. Therefore, a large portion of the expenses in the categories listed above fall into the Personal Services category (faculty, staff, assistant/associate professors in residence, graduate assistants, public safety personnel, IT Support, etc.). These positions are needed in order to support NextGenCT goals.

Again, we are not requesting additional NextGenCT funds, only additional FTE associated with the initial allocation request. We are asking for an additional 59 FTE in FY16 and 94 in FY17, 69.66% of the positions fall within the function of Instruction. Increasing the FTE will enhance the quality of the student experience, further the state's economic growth through research and workforce development, solidify the University's growing national reputation, and maximize the investment of parents and all taxpayers.
