- 1. It was voted to approve the minutes of the meeting of June 5, 2002.
 - 1. The following new transactions were approved by the Committee:
 - 2003-01 Office of Policy & Management -- A transfer of \$275,000.00 from the Unencumbered Balance, Homeowners Freeze Account to Elderly Renters Account. This transfer is required to cover the higher than anticipated costs in the Homeowners Freeze Account.

This transaction was unanimously approved by the members.

2003-02 <u>Department of Public Health Services</u> -- A transfer of \$150,000.00 from the Unencumbered Balance, Personal Services to X-Ray Screening and Tuberculosis Care Account. This transfer is required to cover increased costs to identified tuberculosis patients.

The members unanimously approved this transaction.

2003-03 Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services -- A transfer of
\$1,213,485.00, Personal Services - \$563,485.00 and Housing Support \$650,000.00 to Various Accounts. This transfer is required to cover higher than anticipated expenses.

The members unanimously approved this transaction.

2003-04 <u>Department of Social Services</u> -- A transfer of \$14,739,405.00 from the Unallotted Balance, Various Accounts to Various Accounts. This transfer is required to cover increased expenses.

The members unanimously approved this transaction.
