CT Alliance to End Sexual Violence	Funding will be used for technology to support remote services and advocacy. This project includes funding for text support through a text-to-talk platform, cell phones and Wi-Fi hotspots to implement updated on-call advocacy, and an upgrade of the server and case management files for the Victim Rights Center of Connecticut Legal Services.	\$178,008.20
Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection	Funding will be used for technology to unsworn personnel in order to support teleworking. This technology includes laptops, docking stations and required tech support.	\$226,500.00
Division of Criminal Justice	Funding will support technology to enable prosecutors, inspectors, and other staff to work remotely. Funding used to purchase tablets, VPN tokens, and required network and server materials.	\$278,316.00
Board of Pardons and Paroles	Funding will be used for technology to support remote hearings, including full pardon hearings. This technology will enable the BOPP to stream virtual live hearings between the BOPP, the Judicial Branch, the Department of Correction, and the general public. This proposal includes technology needed at both the Board and the DOC to conduct hearings.	\$447,000.00
Division of Public Defender Services	Funding will be used for technology and staffing to support the division in teleworking and to help with cases that have been backlogged during COVID-19. Technology includes webcams, smartphones, licensing for video conferencing, and VPN keys. Staffing includes six full time temporary attorneys for six months.	\$469,290.35
Department of Correction	Funding will support technology to establish virtual programs and services at MYI and York, technology to establish wireless infrastructure at MYI.	\$1,280,000.00
	Funding for reentry and rehousing assistance to be awarded directly to the Connecticut Coalition to End Homelessness. Funding will support housing for individuals discharged from the DOC.	\$1,800,000.00
