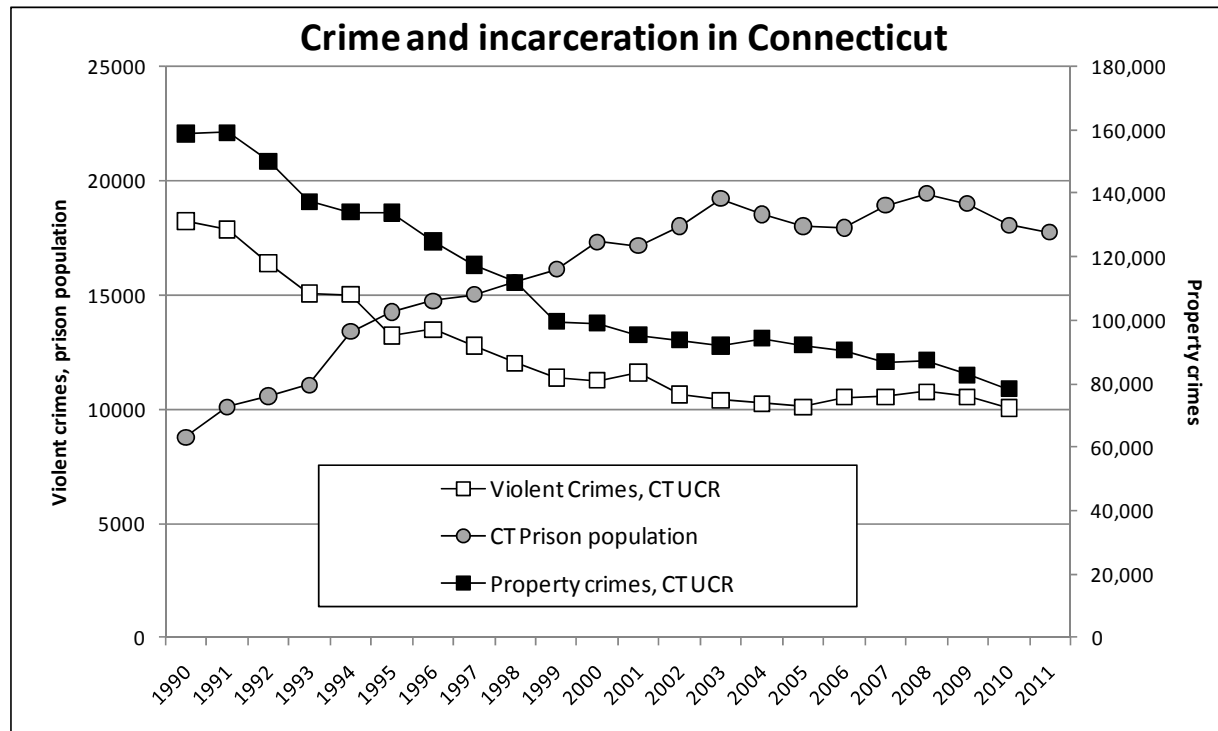


OPM – Reported crime and incarceration

According to Uniform Crimes Report data, violent and property crime rates have been in decline since 1990. In Connecticut, incarceration rates rose dramatically from approximately 1990 to 2004.
