Section 39, CJIS Governing Board

Changes in Governance --

Establishes co-chairs

Chief Court Administrator

Person appointed by the Governor from the membership of the CJIS Governing Board

Adds as members the chairpersons and the ranking members of the Judiciary Committee

All other memberships are not changed

Section 39, CJIS Governing Board

Executive Director --

Serves at the pleasure of the Governing Board, not a member of the Board

Oversees the design of and the implementation of a comprehensive, state-wide information technology system for criminal justice information

OPM provides space, staff, and services to support the work of the Executive Director

Section 40, CJIS Information Sharing

CJIS Governing Board Responsibility

Design and implement a comprehensive, state-wide information technology system

To facilitate the immediate, seamless, and comprehensive sharing of information

Between all state agencies, departments, boards, and commissions and organized local police departments and law enforcement officials

CJIS Information Sharing System

Central tracking and information database

Central electronic document repository

Centralized analytical tools

Section 40, CJIS Information Sharing

CJIS Information Sharing System

A central tracking and information database providing --

Complete biographical information and vital statistics (on all offenders and living former offenders)

Tracking info from investigation, through incarceration and release

Integration with electronic monitoring, global positioning, and offender registries

Section 40, CJIS Information Sharing

CJIS Information Sharing System

A central integrated electronic repository of records and documents providing access to –

State and local police reports
Pre-sentence investigations
Psychological and medial reports
Criminal records
Incarceration and parole records
Court records and transcripts

Whether in electronic or hard copy form

Access to scanning and processing facilities for immediate system integration and updating

Section 40, CJIS Information Sharing

CJIS Information Sharing System

A custom designed enterprise system with bundled, centralized analytical tools that enable/enhance –

Criminal case assessment
Sentencing and plea agreement analysis
Pardon, parole probation, and release decisions
Forecasting recidivism and future offenses for each offender
Seamless, cross-department communication, information exchange, note-taking, and comment capabilities for each offender

Section 40, CJIS Information Sharing

CJIS Information Sharing System

Utilizes a state-of-the-art relational database technology, software, and hardware, which is –

Completely accessible through the Internet, as authorized

Completely integrated with other agency information systems and databases Indexed and cross-referenced by offender name, other parameters, etc.

Fully text searchable

High-level security and protocols

Publicly accessible, subject to privacy protections and controls

Monitored and administered by the CJIS Governing Board, with the assistance of DOIT

Section 40, CJIS Information Sharing

CJIS Information Sharing System

For the CJIS information technology system design and implementation –

Hire a consultant, by July 1, 2008, to develop a plan Issue a request for proposals, by July 1, 2008 (Date Subject to Change)

Beginning on July 1, 2008 and every six months thereafter, reports to the General Assembly Committees of cognizance
