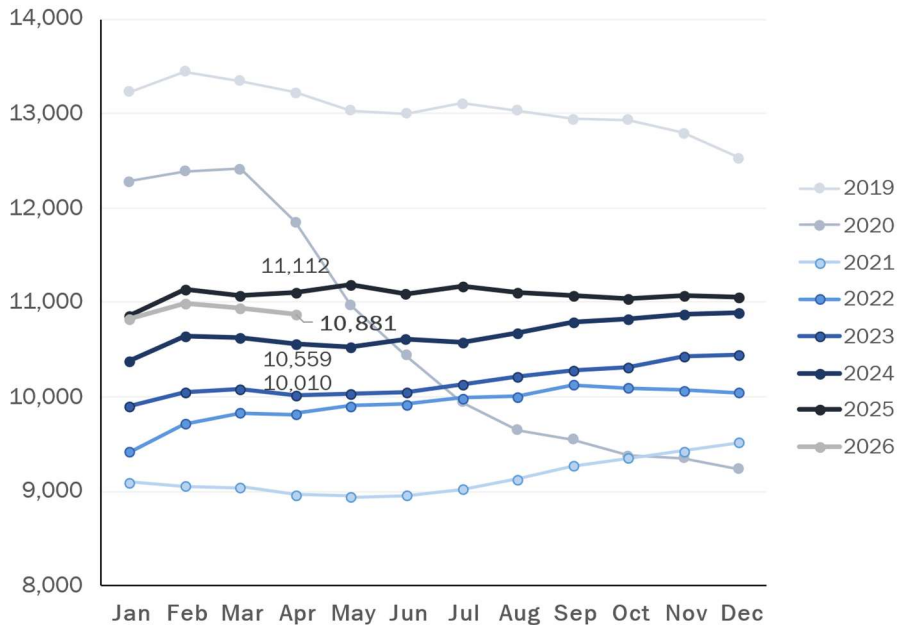

### First-of-the-Month DOC Facility Population

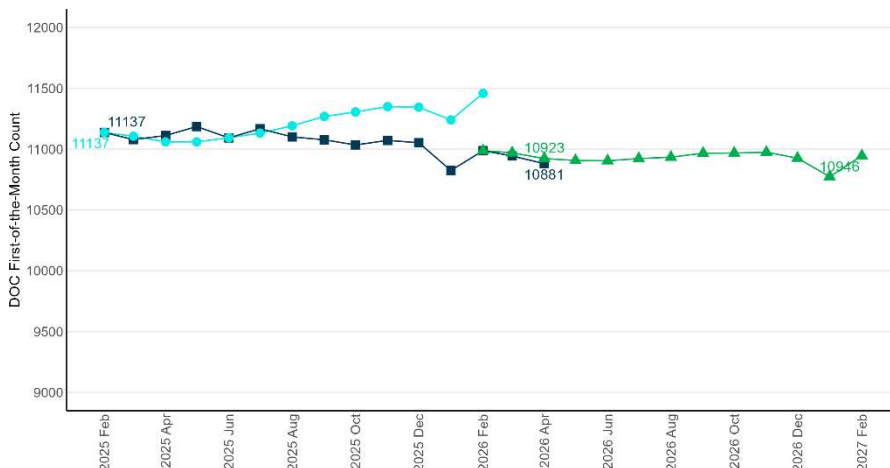

Forecast period: March 2026 - February 2027



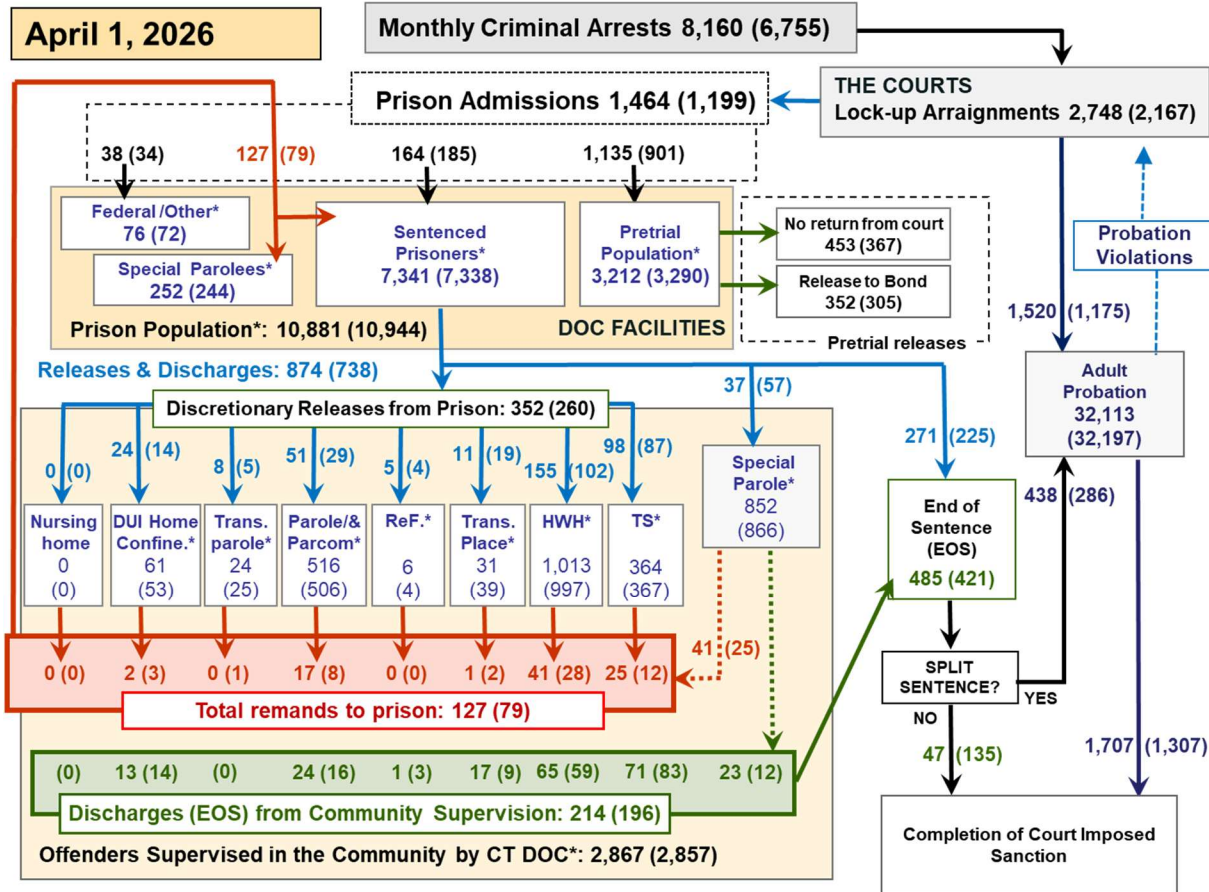

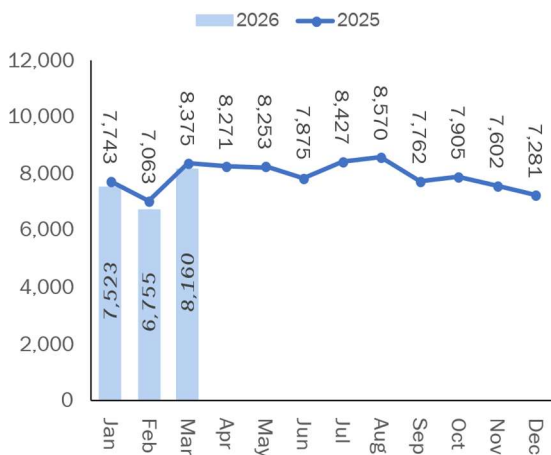


### Criminal Justice System Monthly Counts & Flow Chart



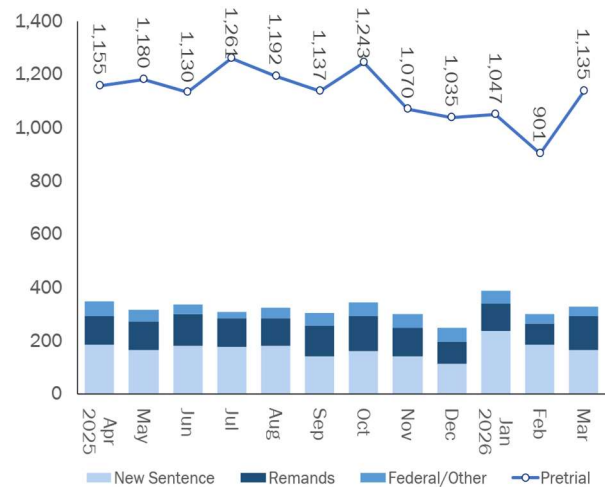

#### Monthly DOC Admissions: 2025 & 2026

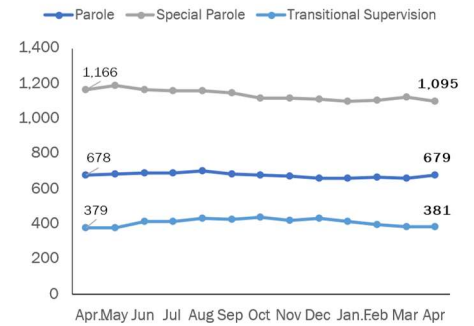

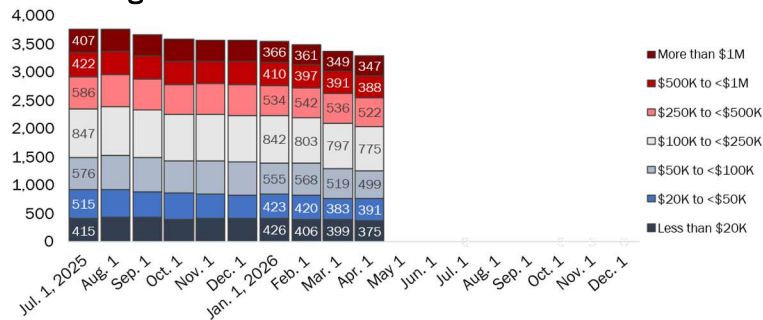

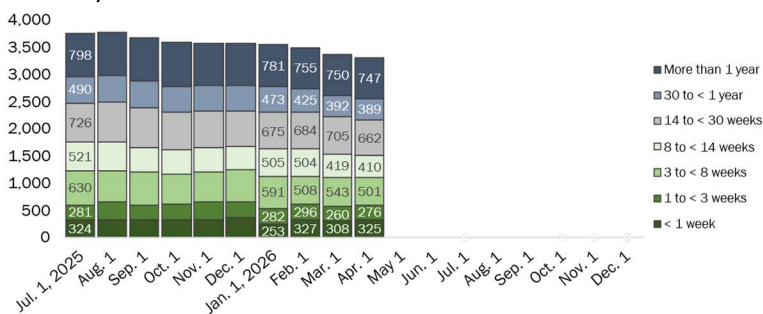
## DOC Community Supervision: First-of-the-Month Totals

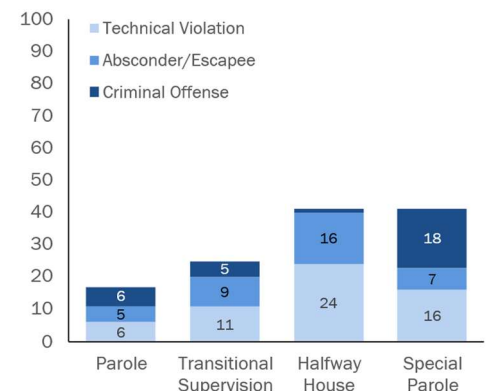
