

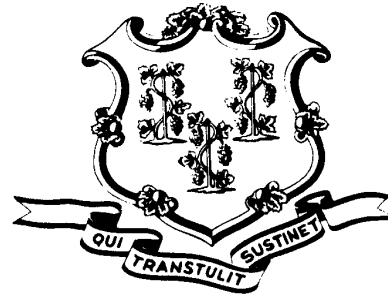

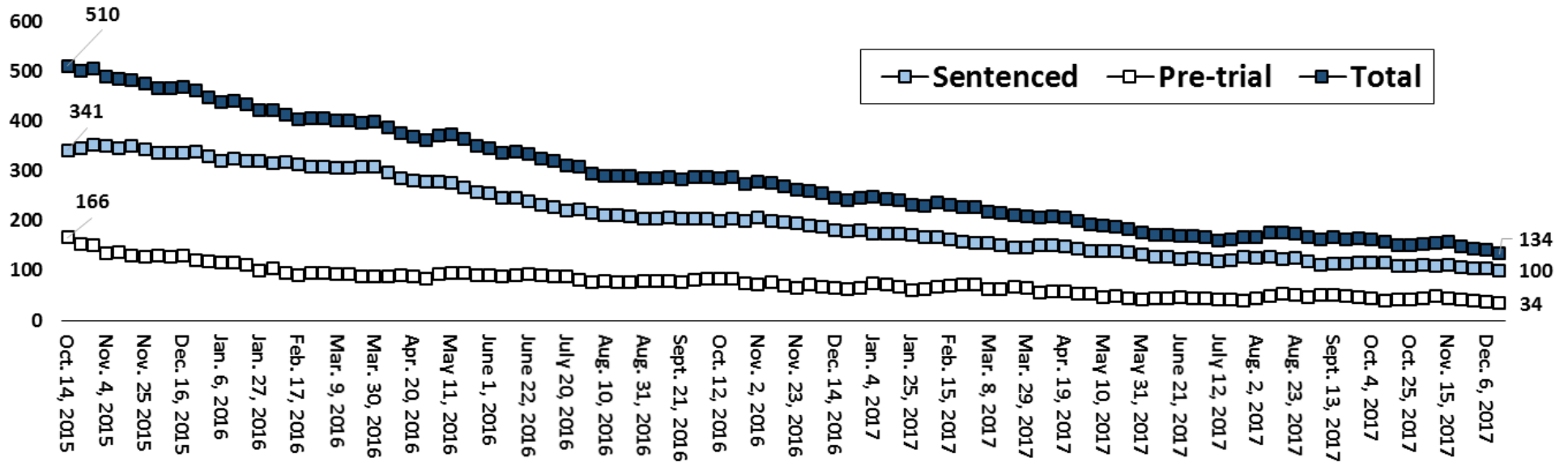

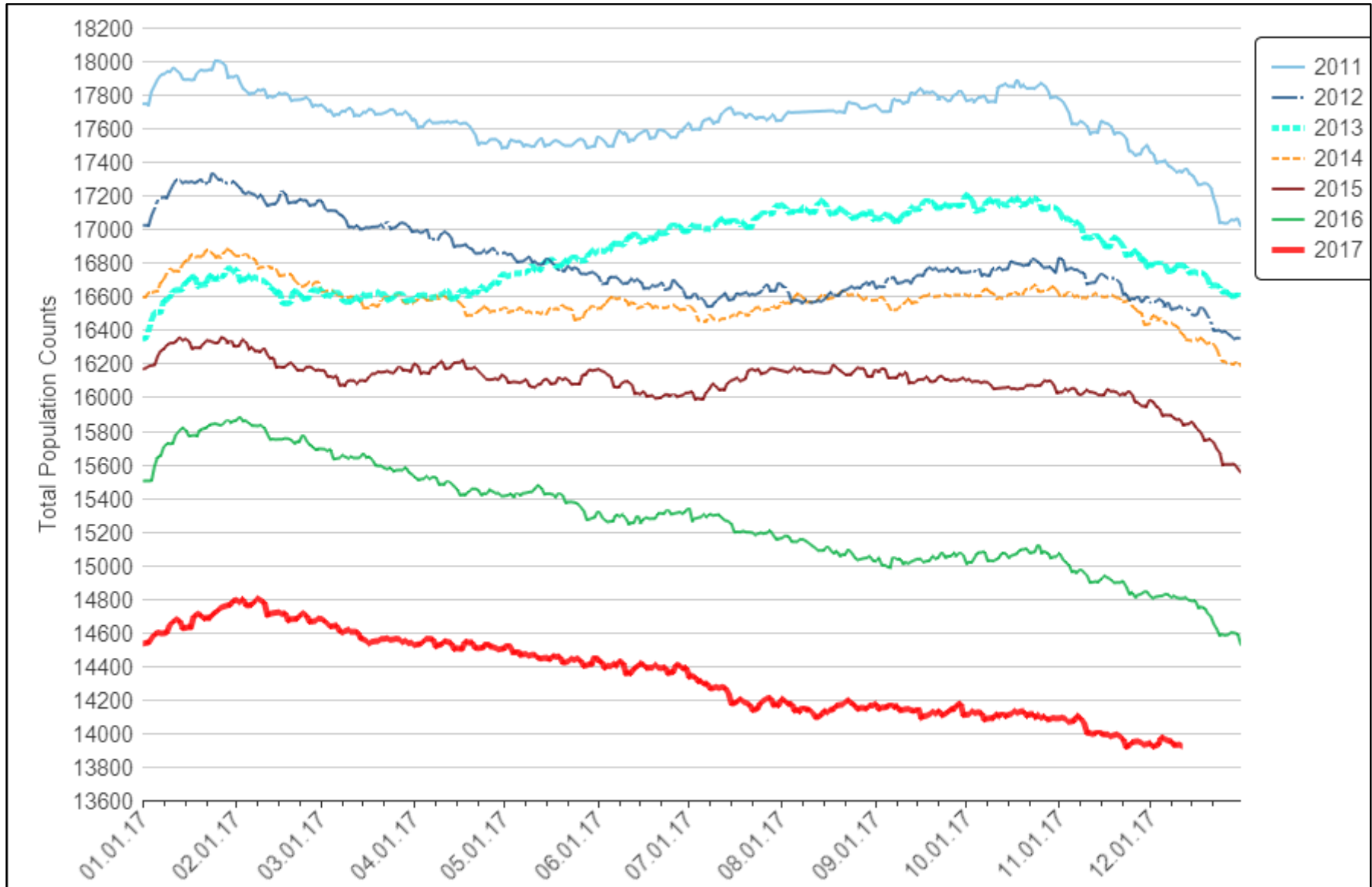
In prison on 21a-279 (Possession of Narcotics) class offenses, controlling



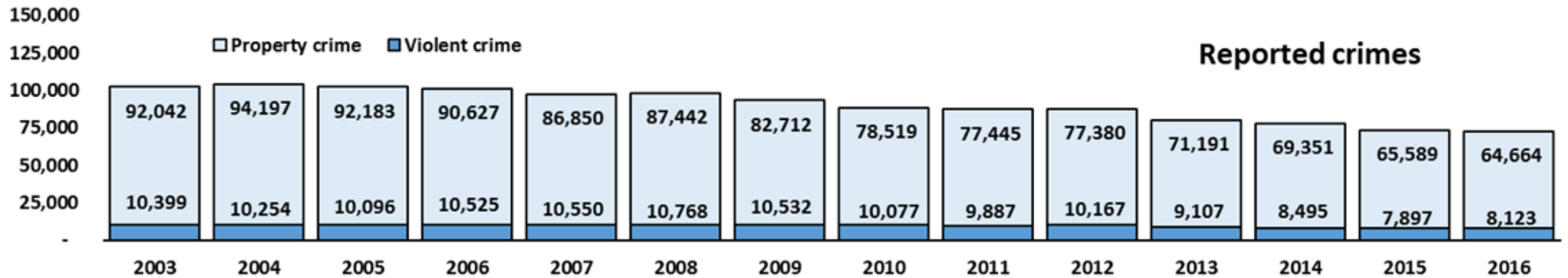
Since October 2015:

- Total 74% decrease

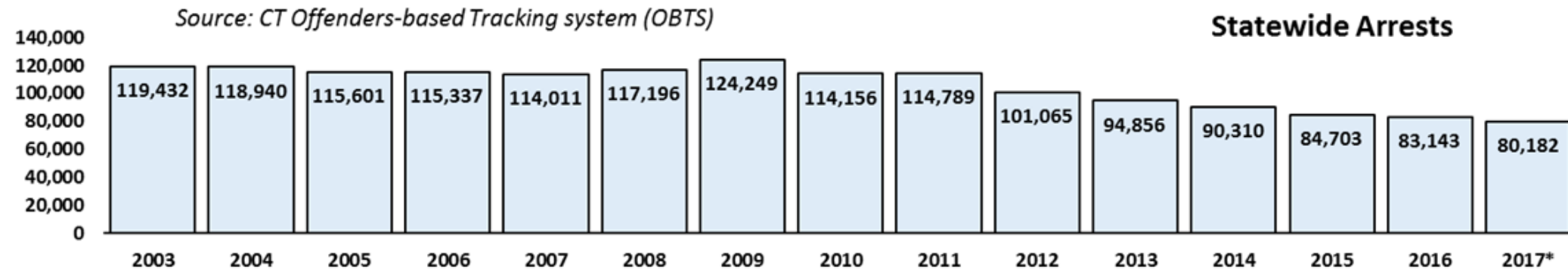
Dropping Prison Population



Arrests and Reported Crimes

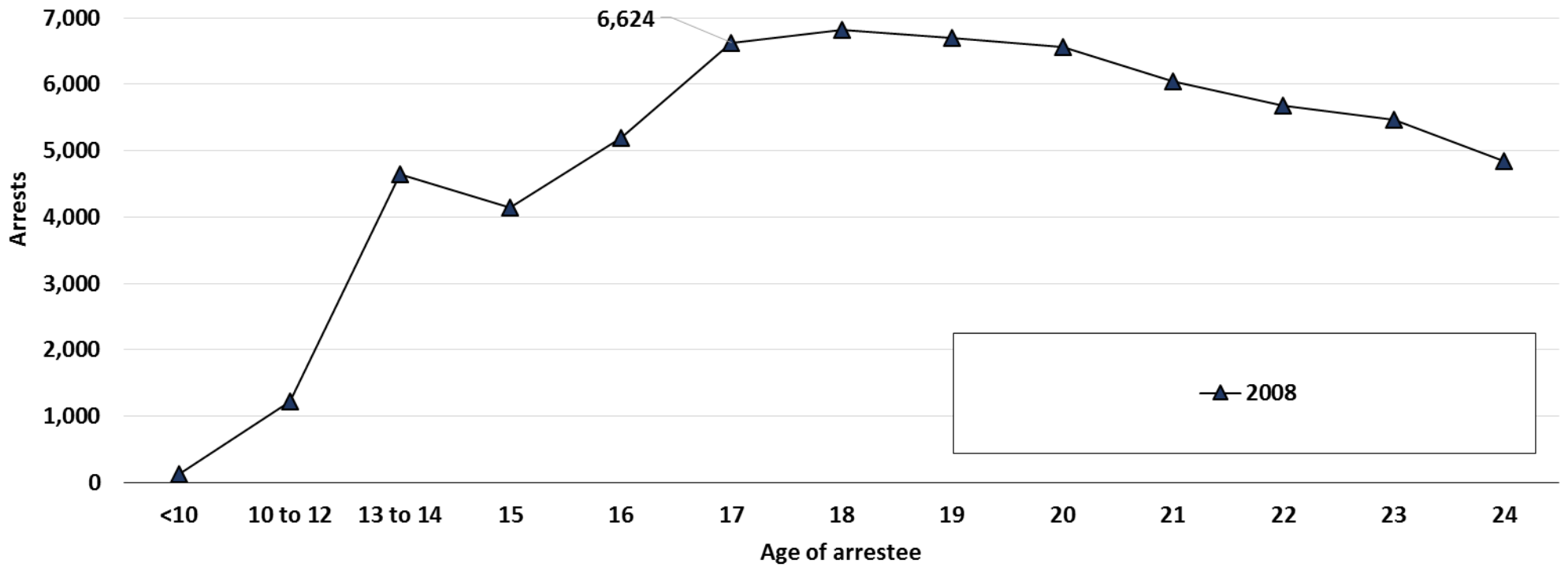

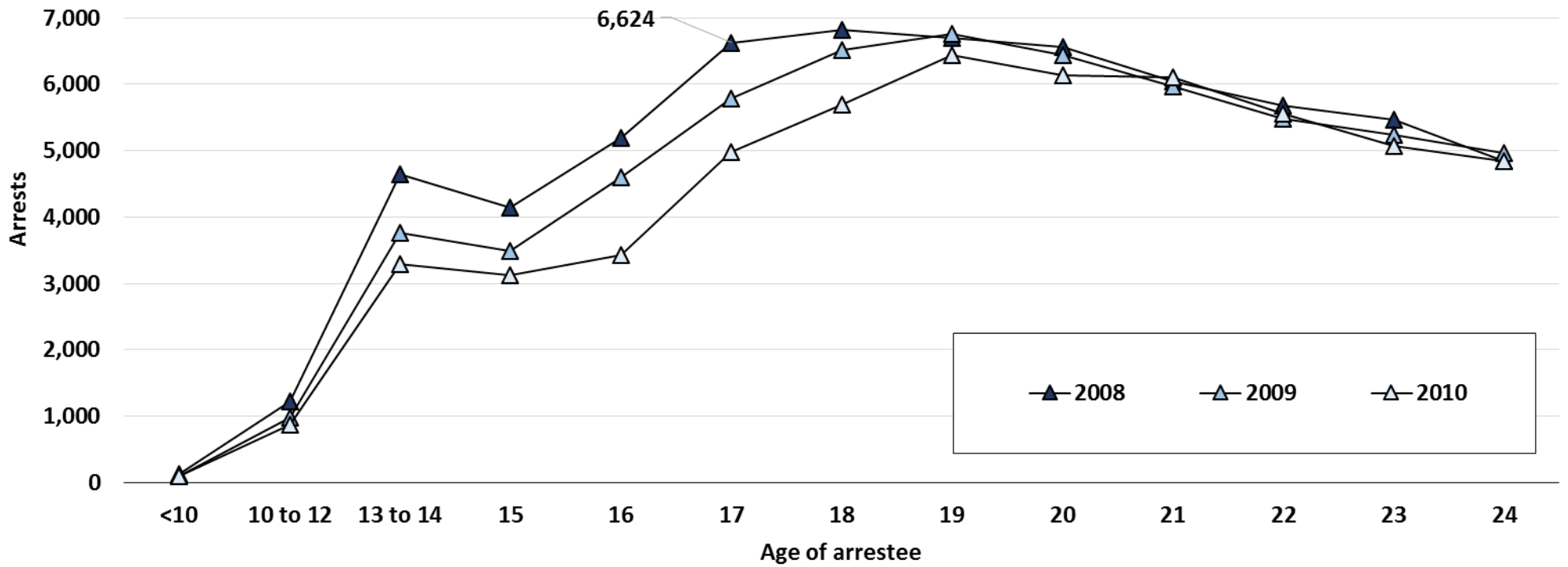

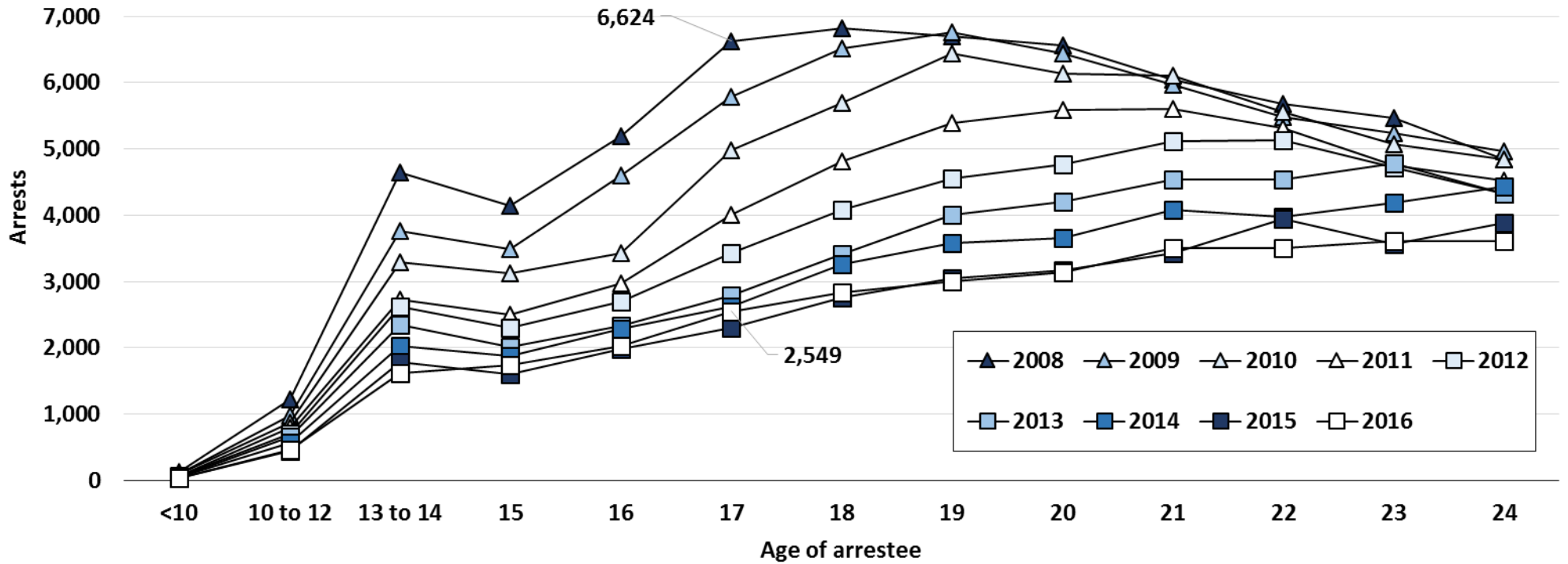

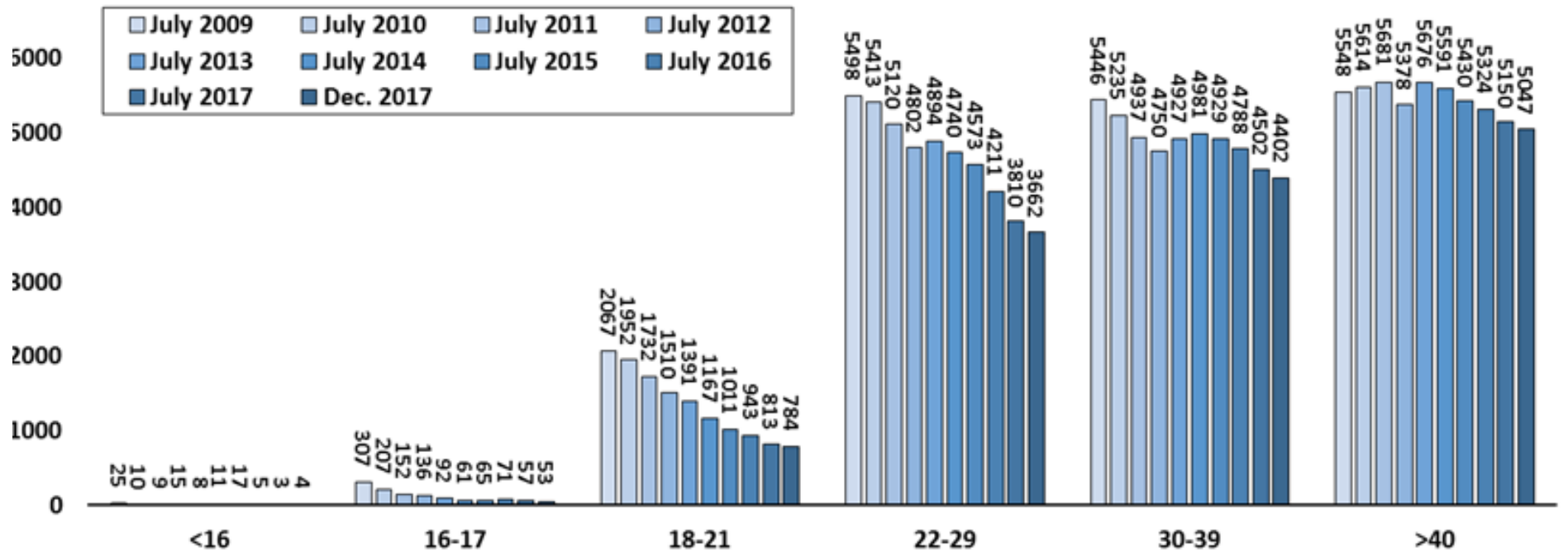

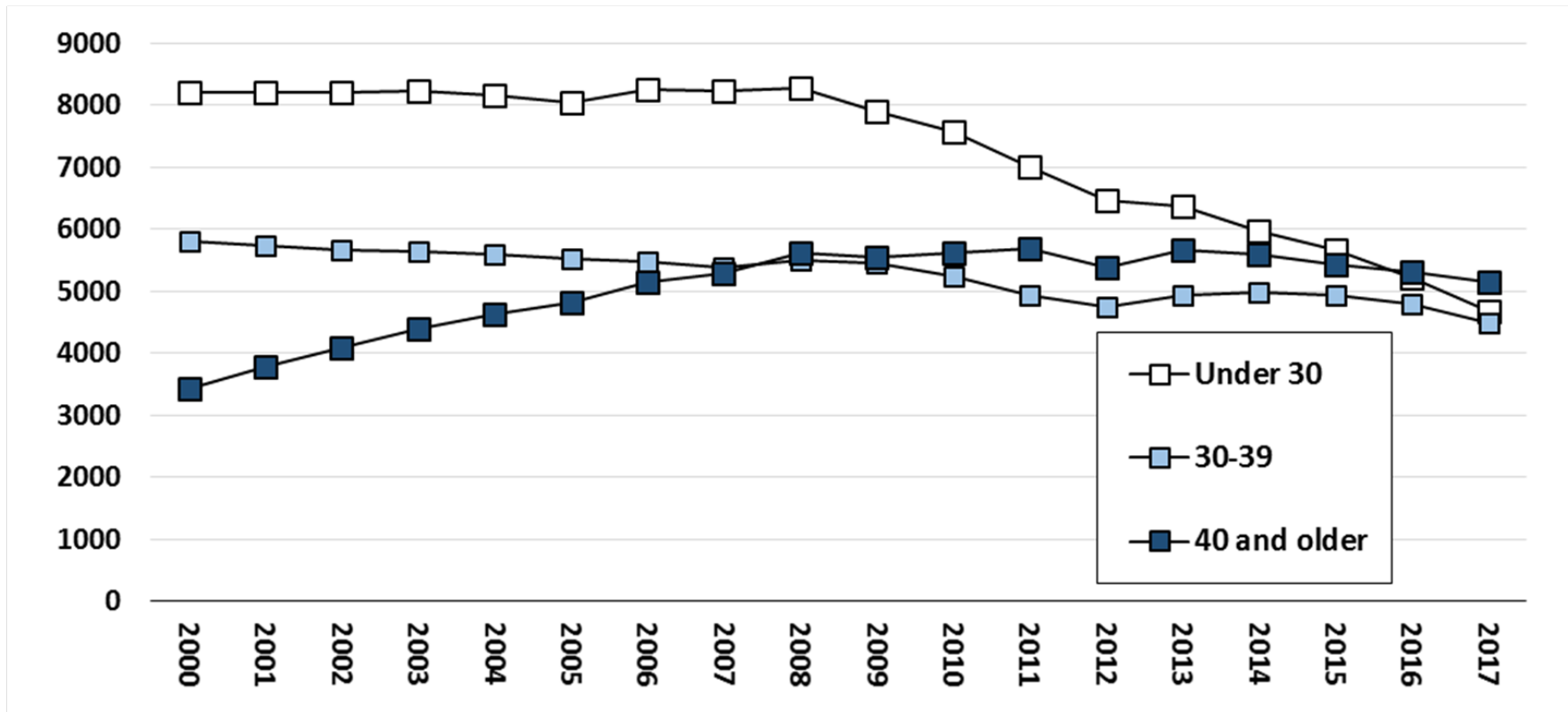
