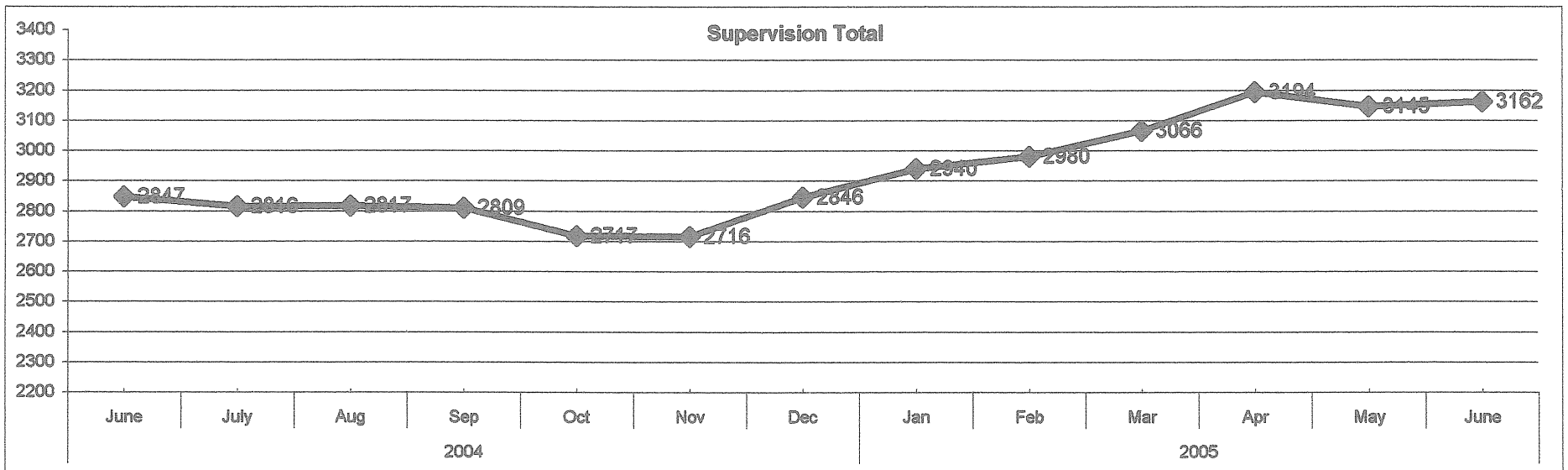


**Parole Granting Rate

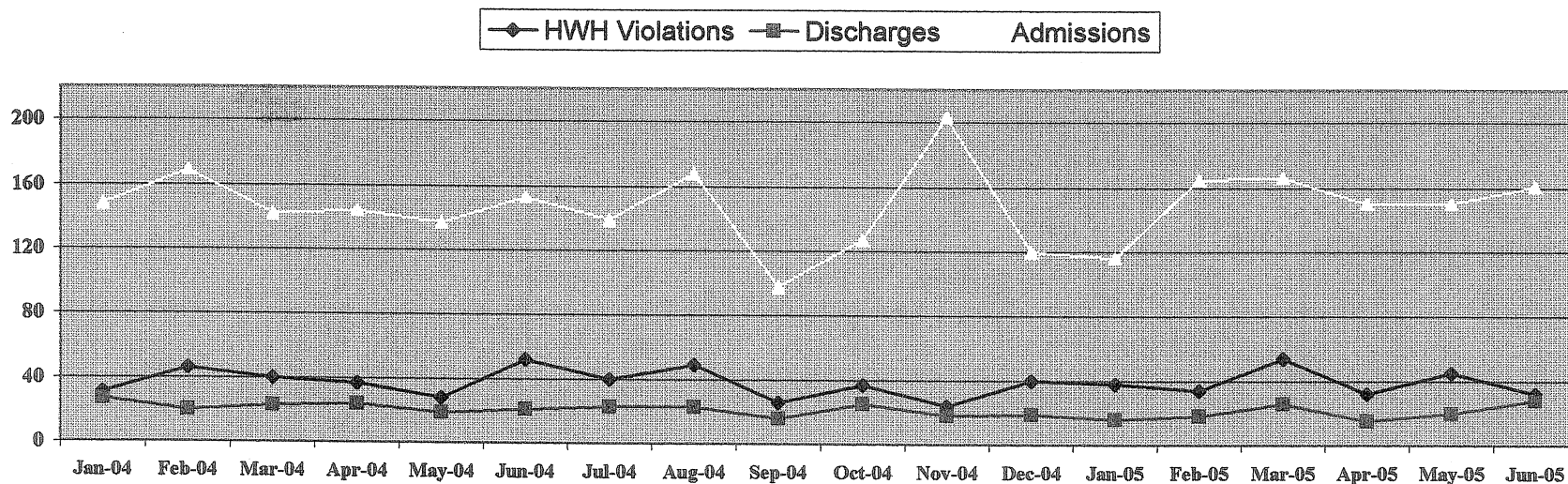

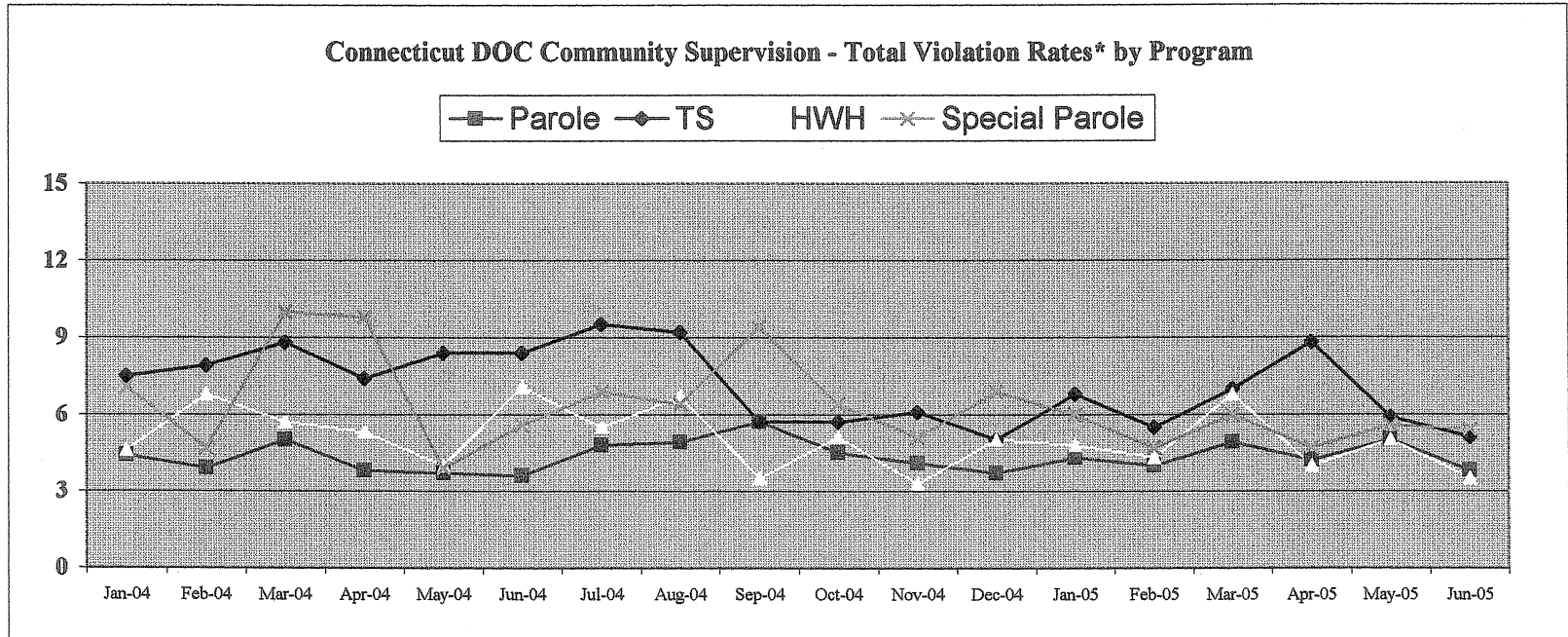

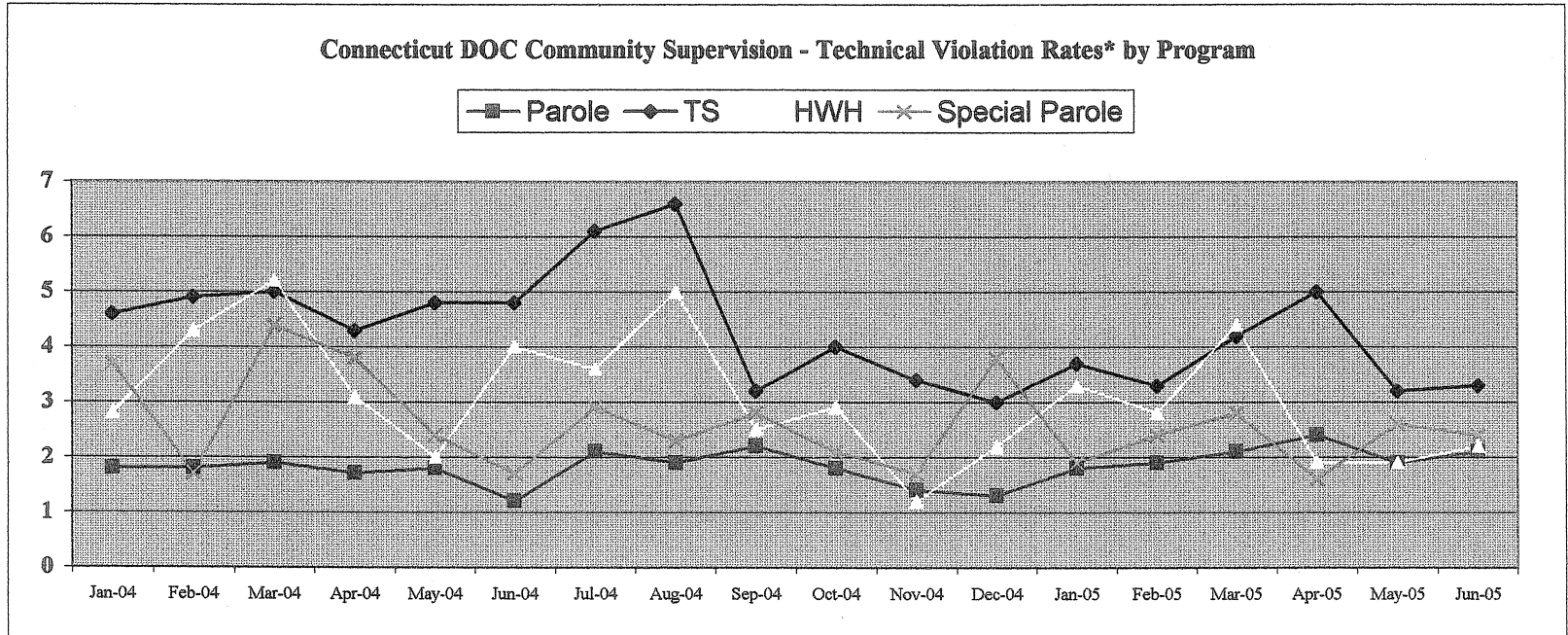

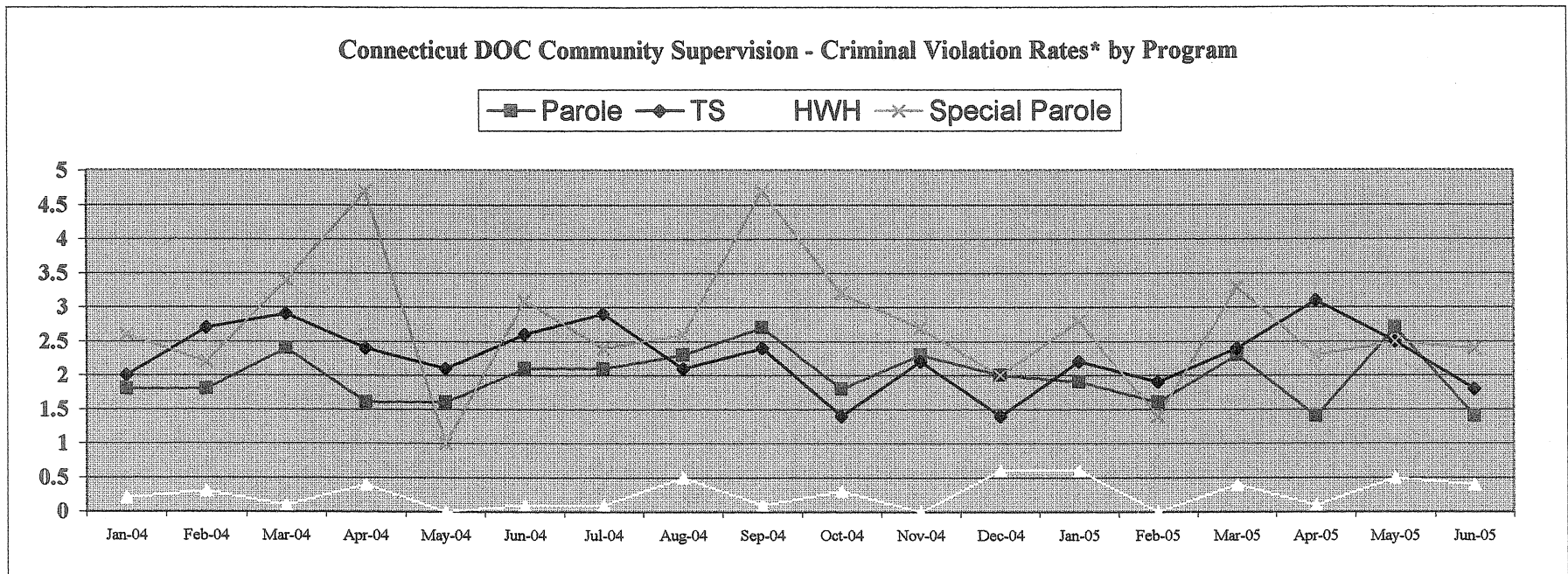

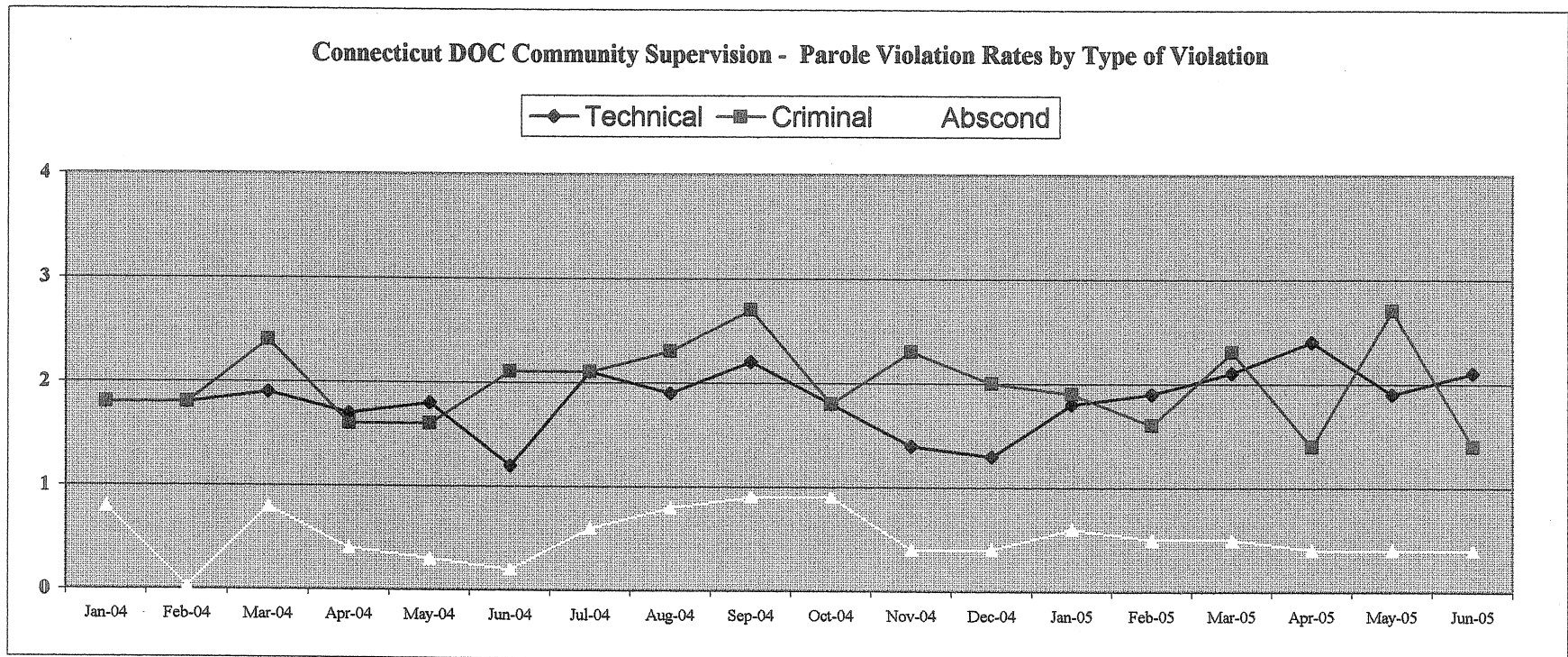

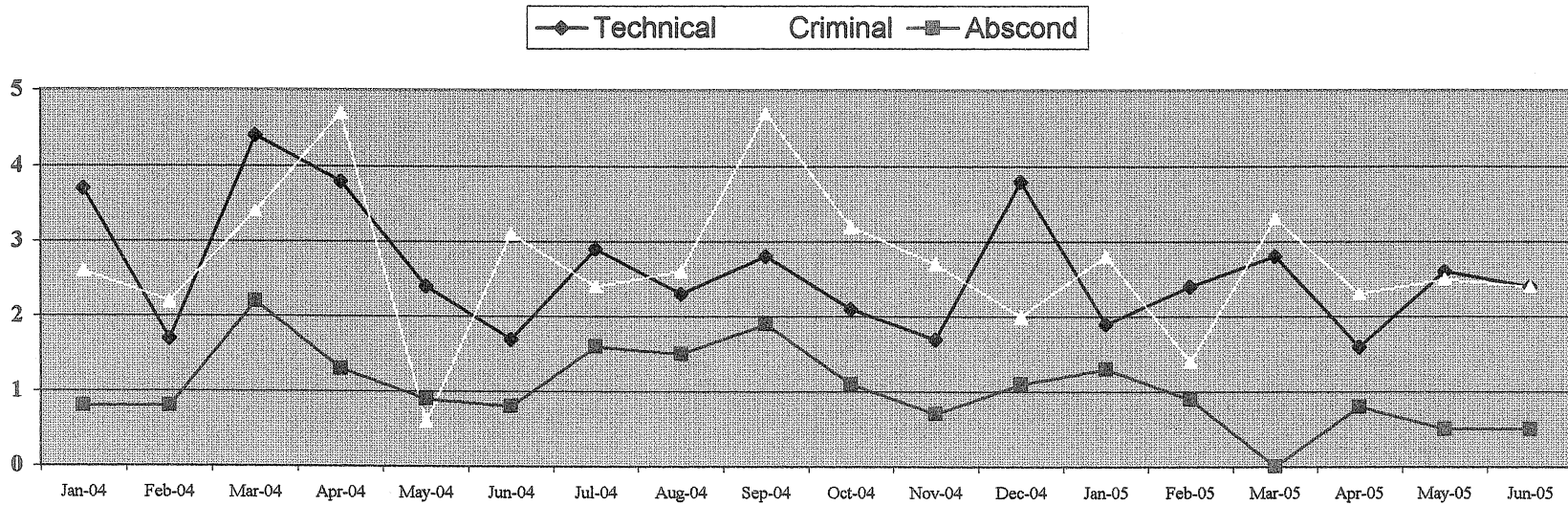

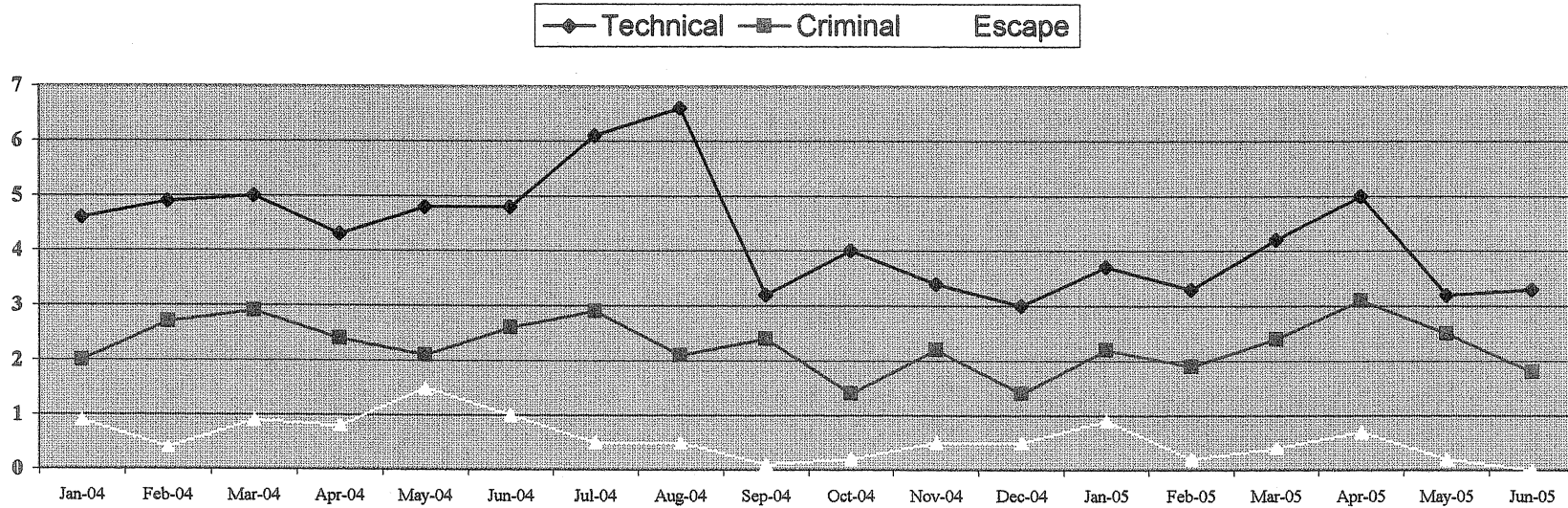

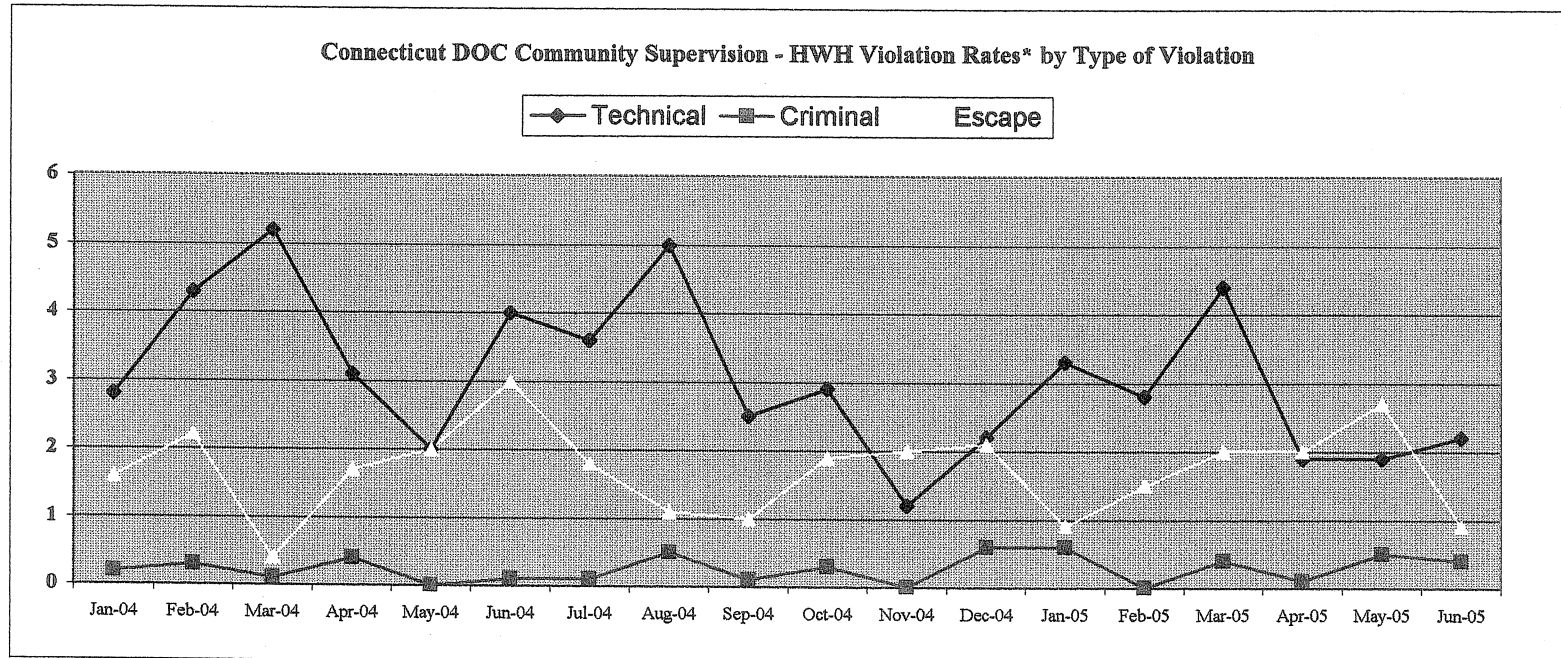
Connecticut DOC Community Supervision - TS Violation Rates* by Type of Violation
