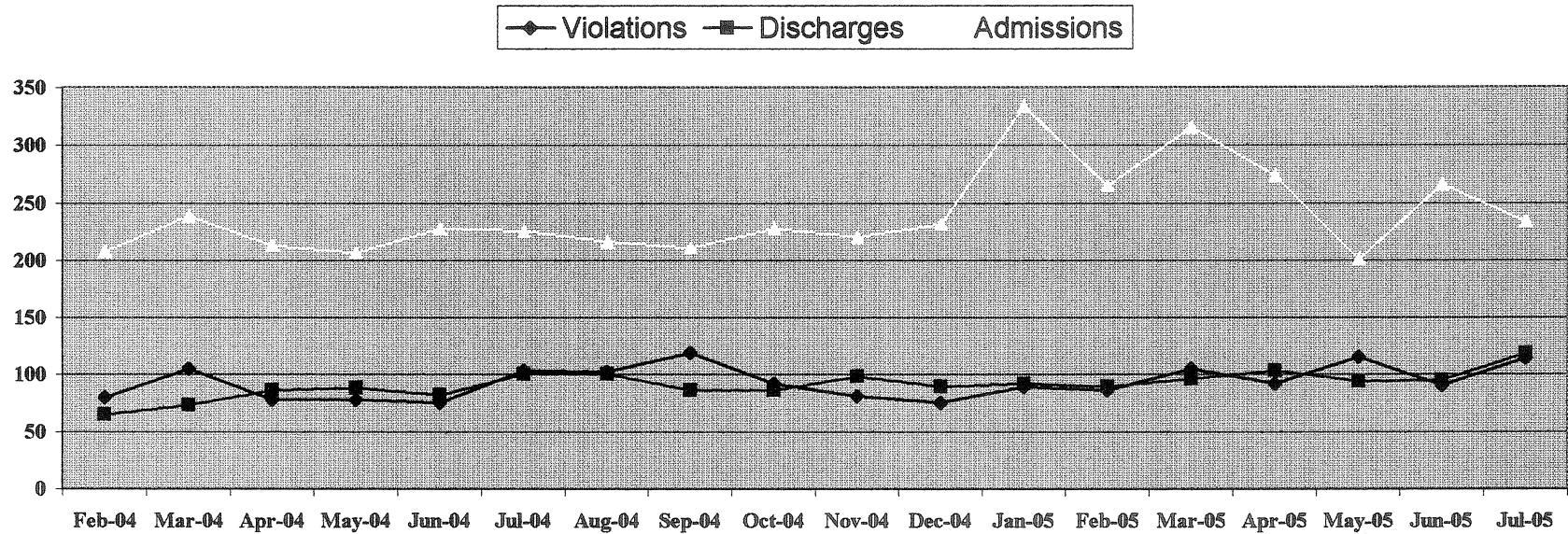

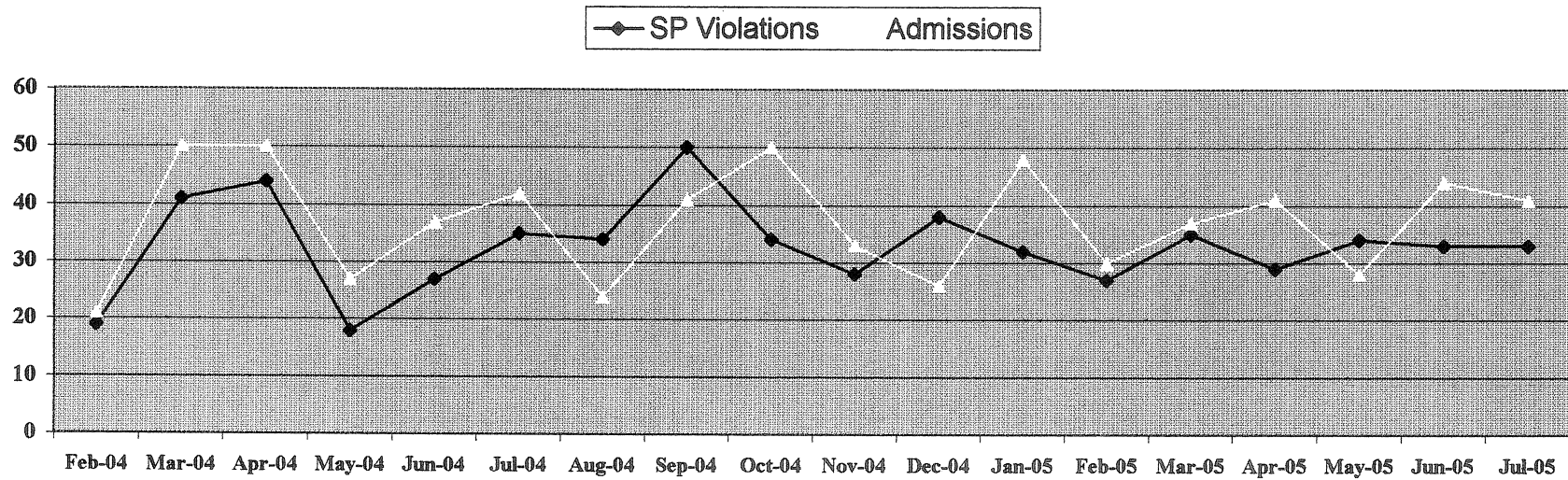
**Connecticut DOC Community Supervision - Parole Violations, Discharges & Admissions by Month**

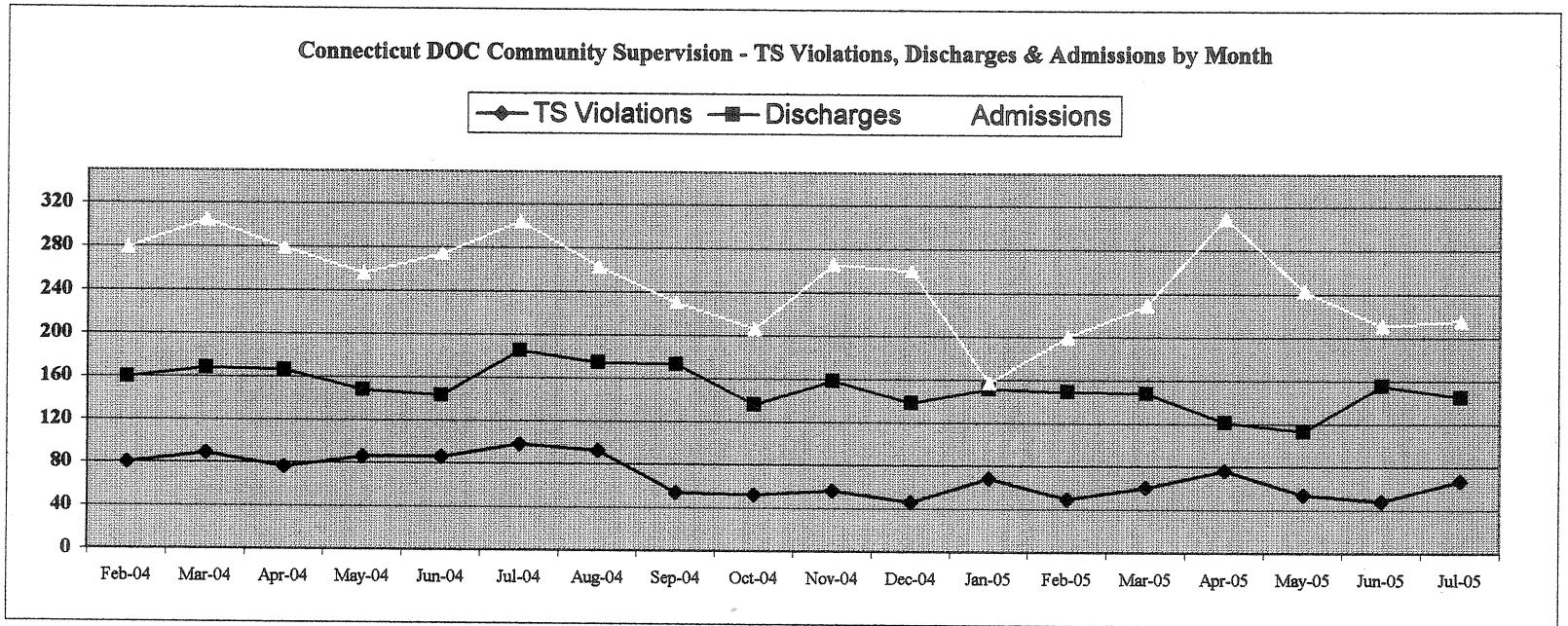

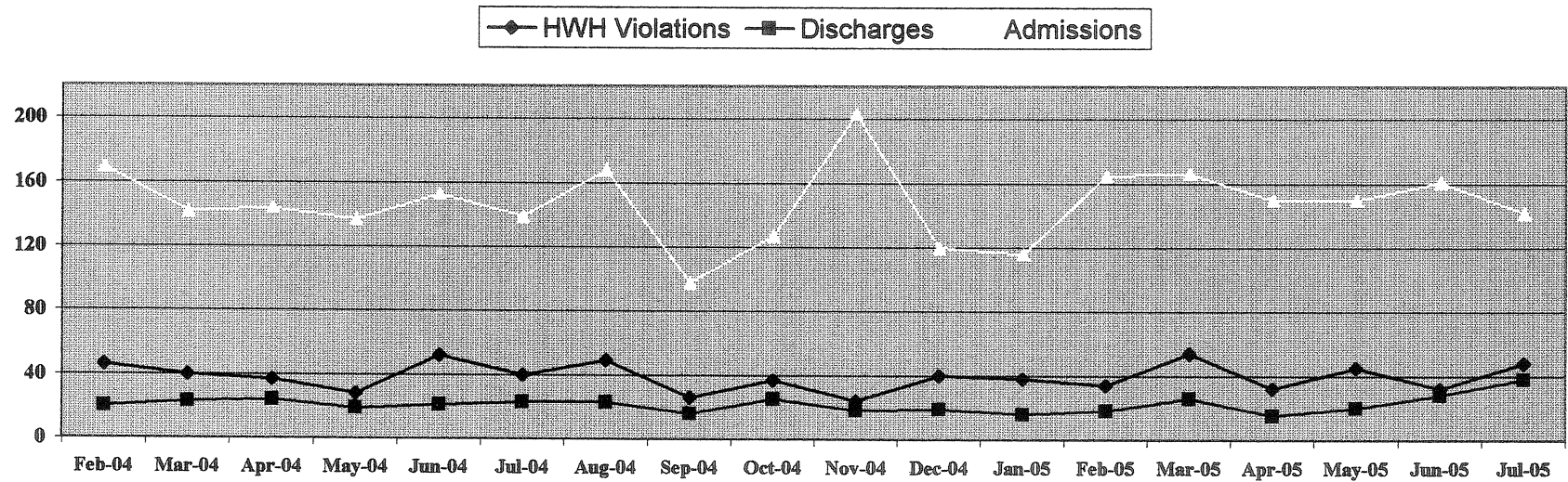

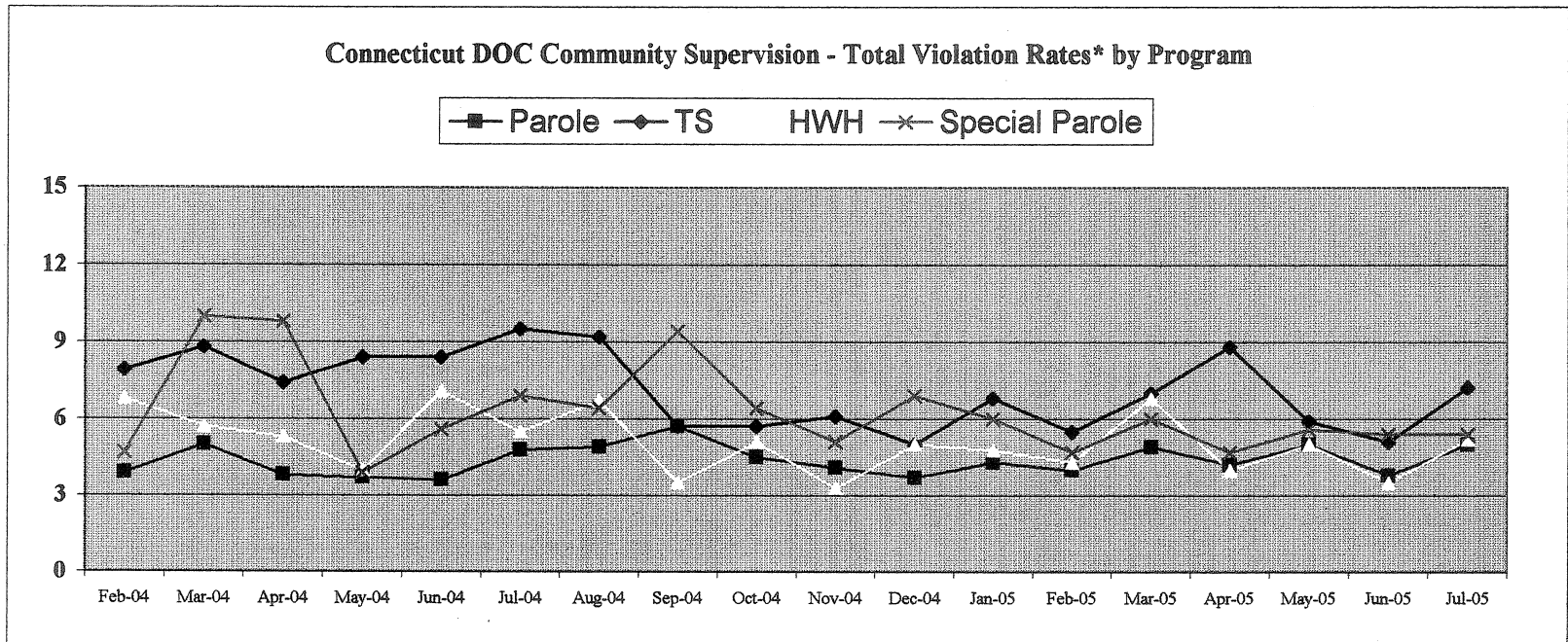
**Connecticut DOC Community Supervision - HWH Violations, Discharges & Admissions by Month**

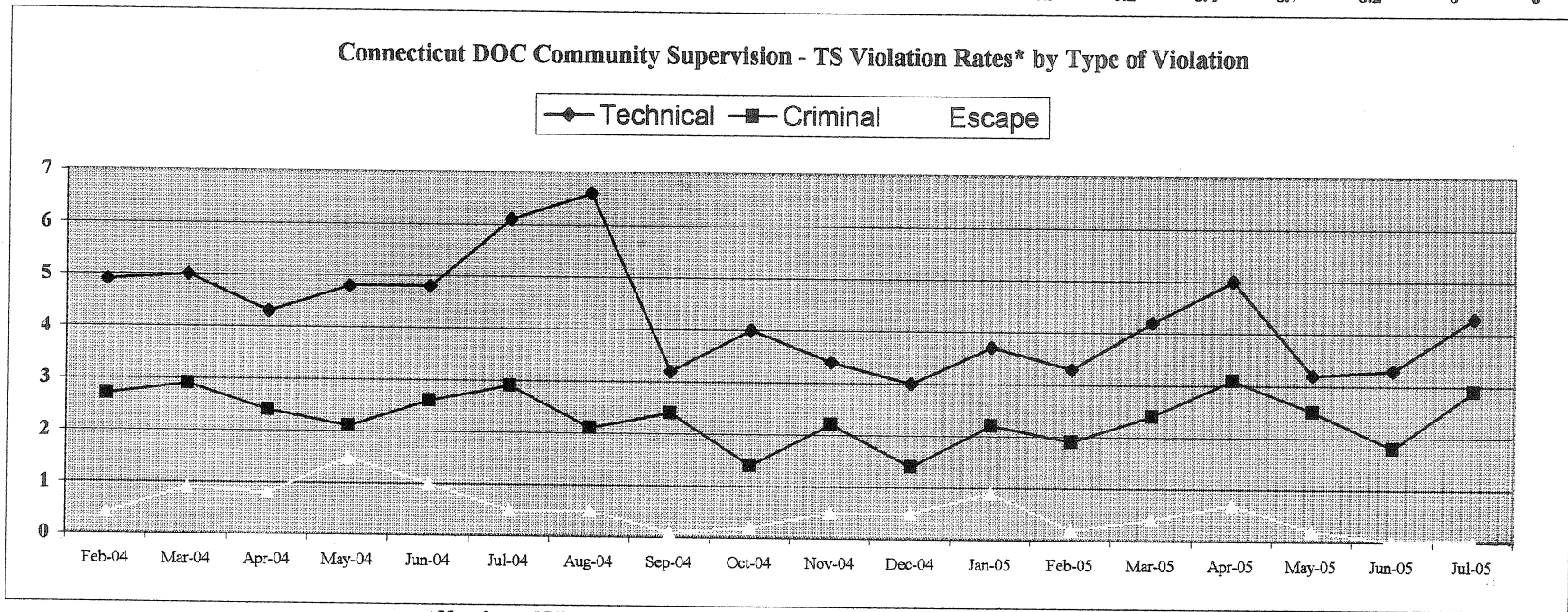

**February, 2004 through July, 2005**

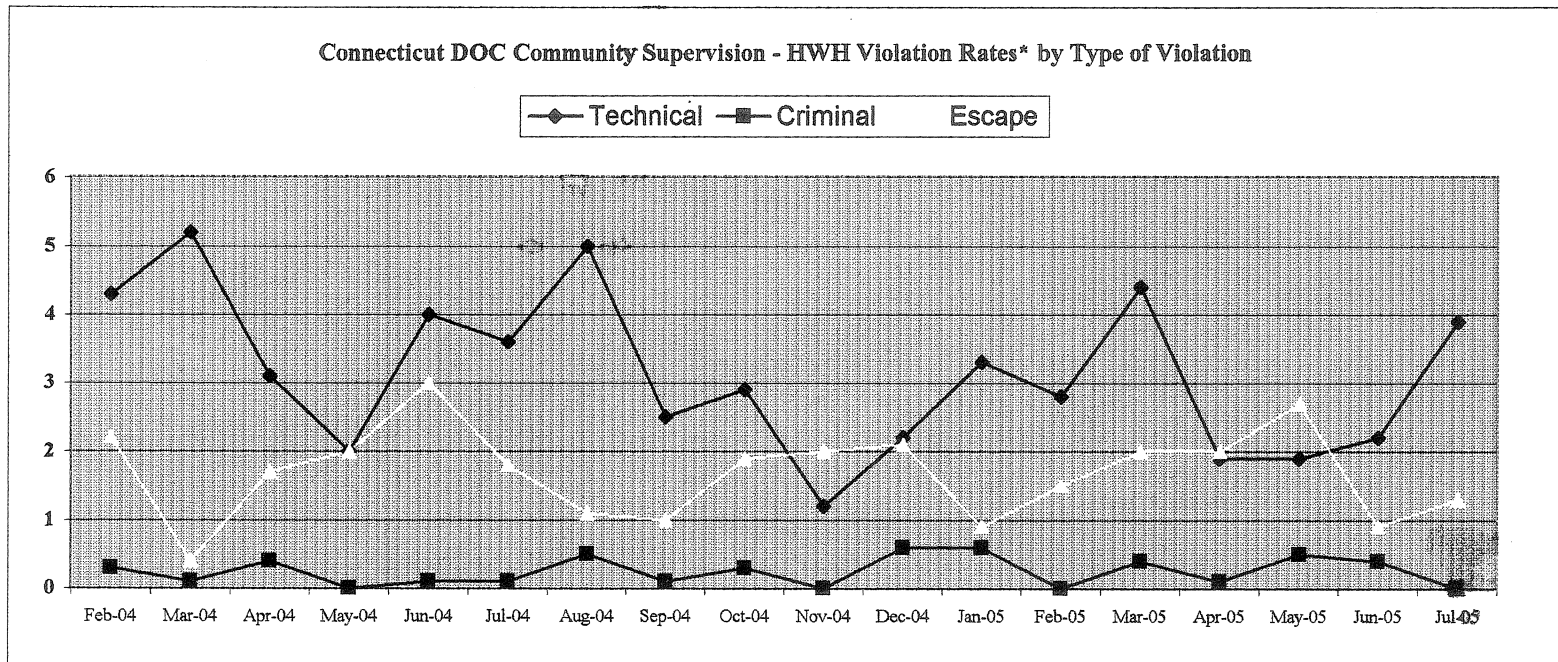
