May 2005 - April 2006**

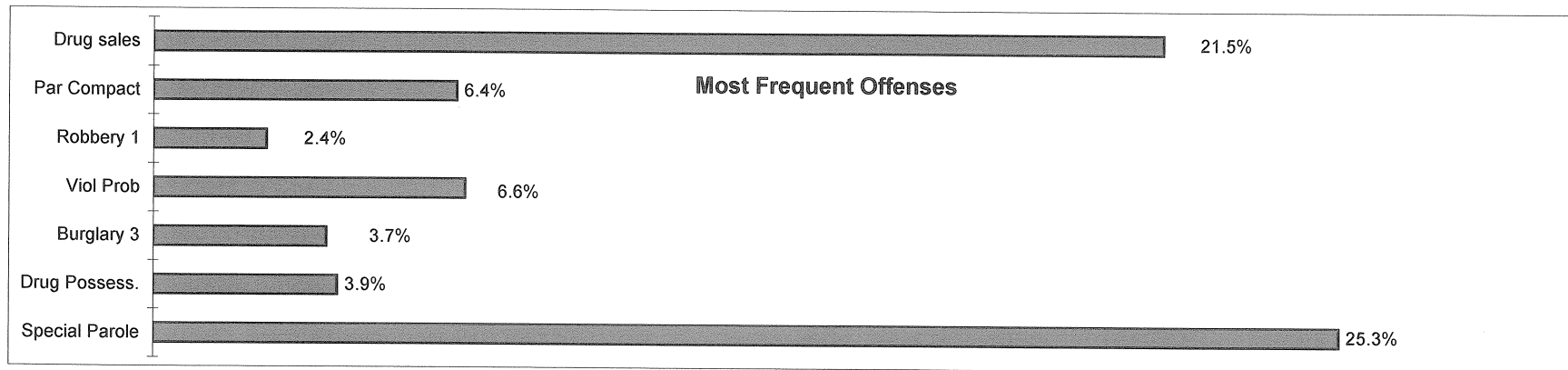
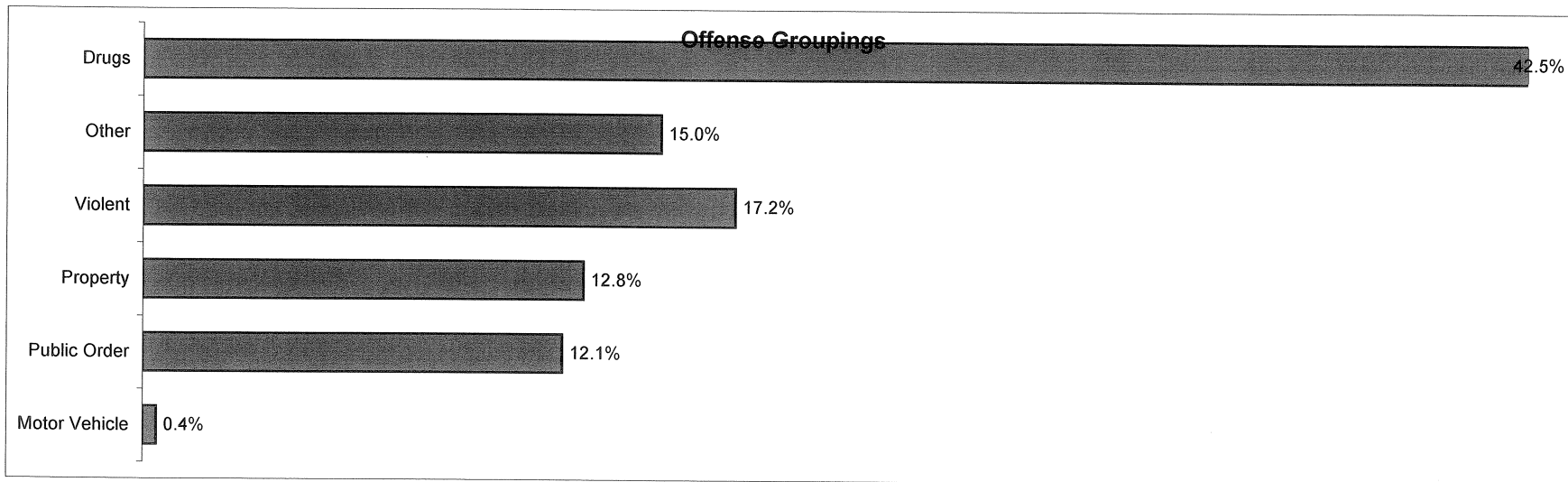

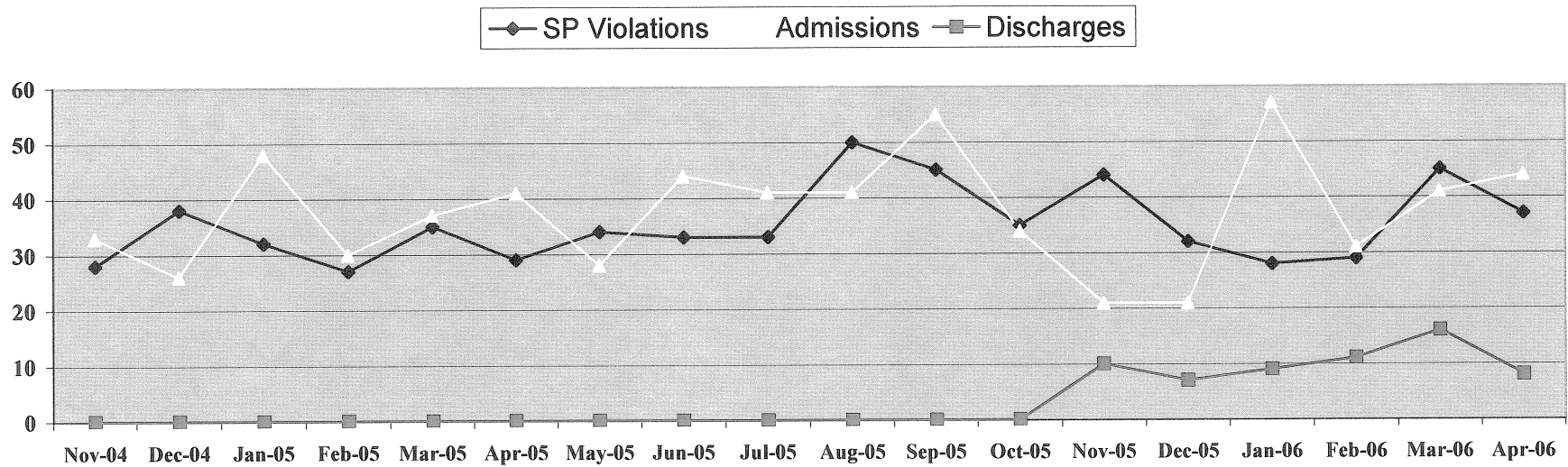

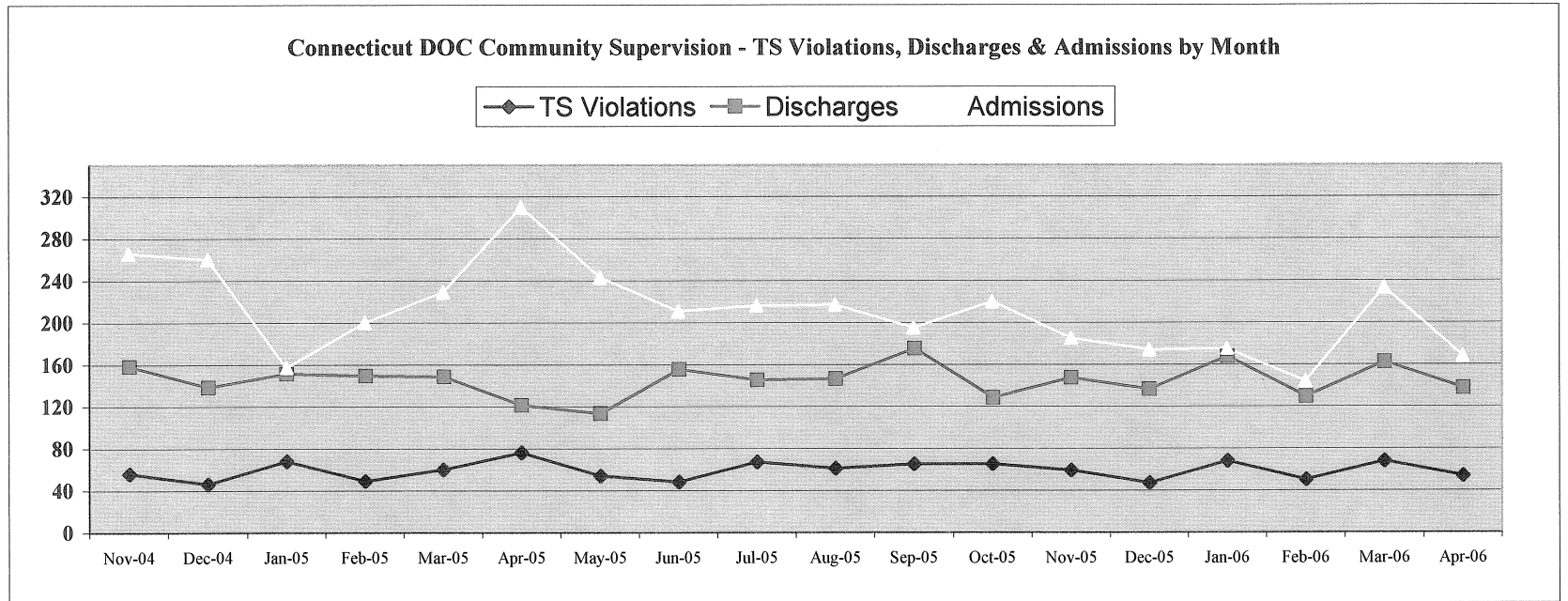

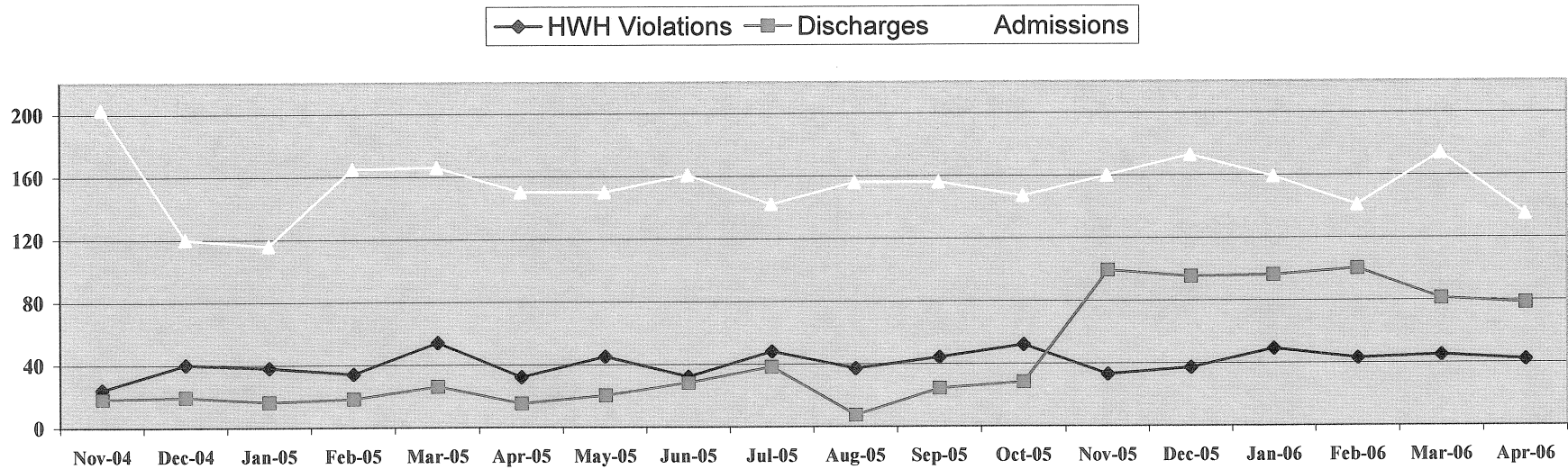

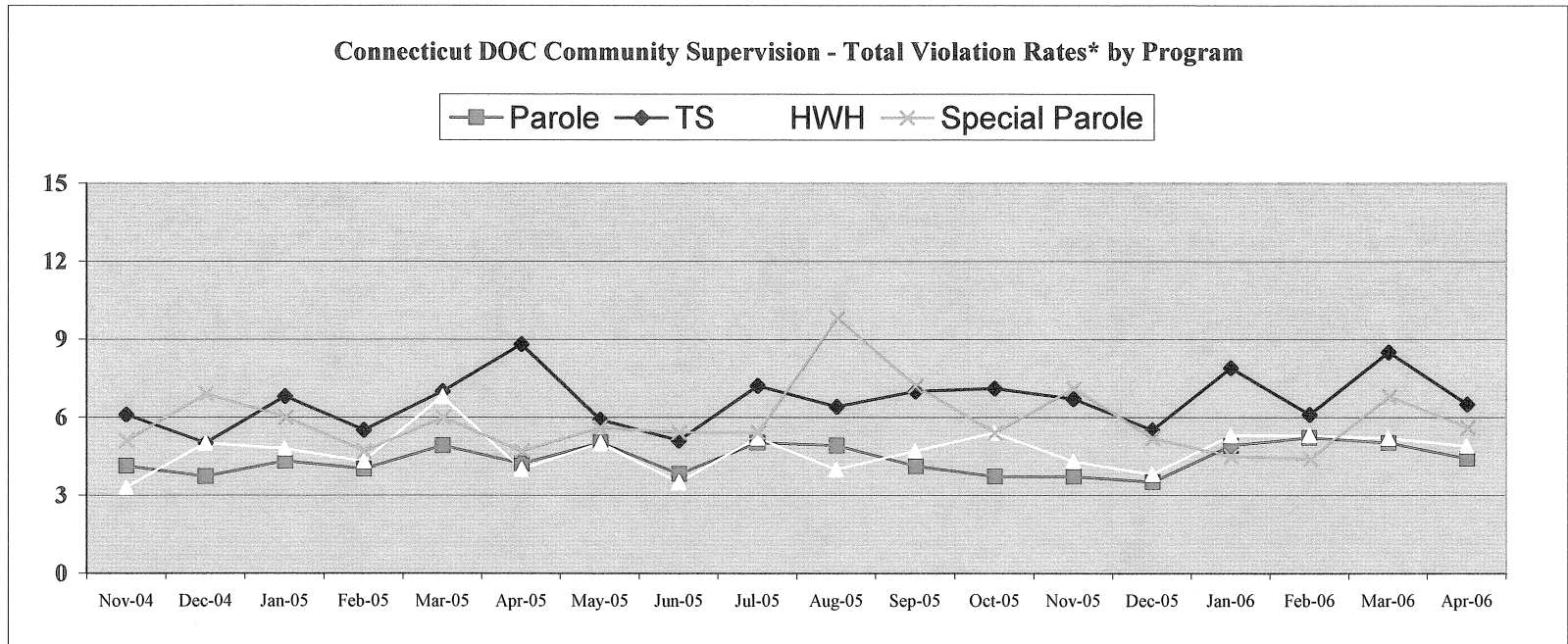
Connecticut DOC Community Supervision - HWH Violations, Discharges & Admissions by Month

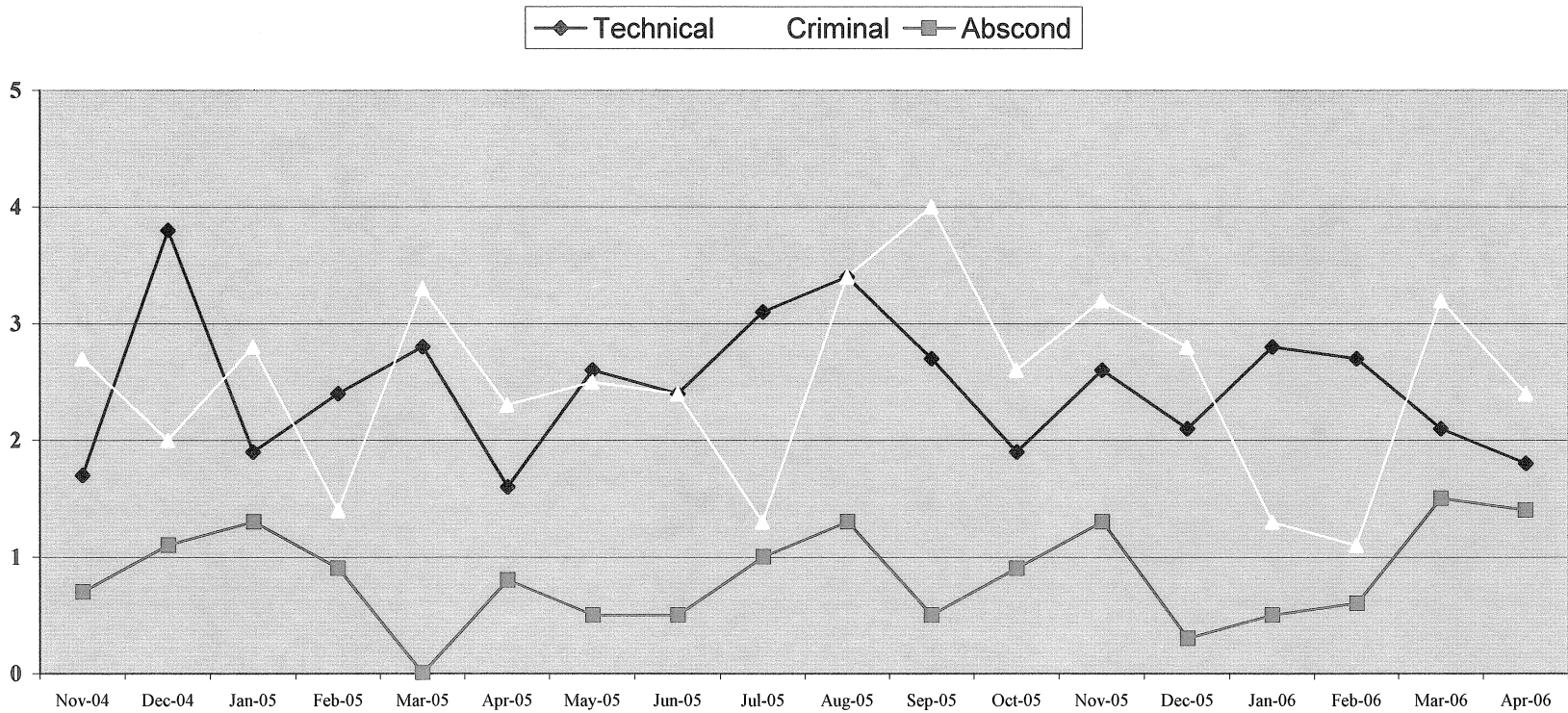

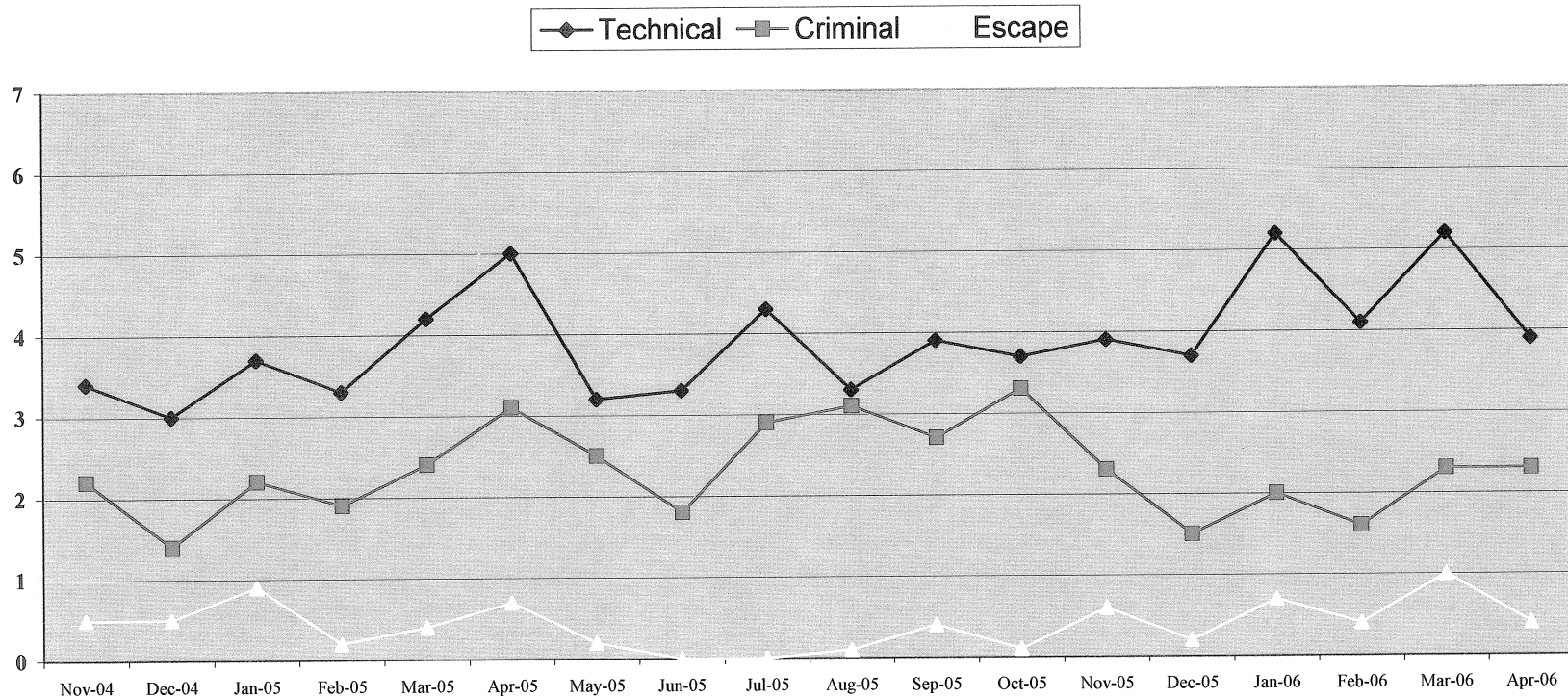

Connecticut DOC Community Supervision - TS Violation Rates* by Type of Violation

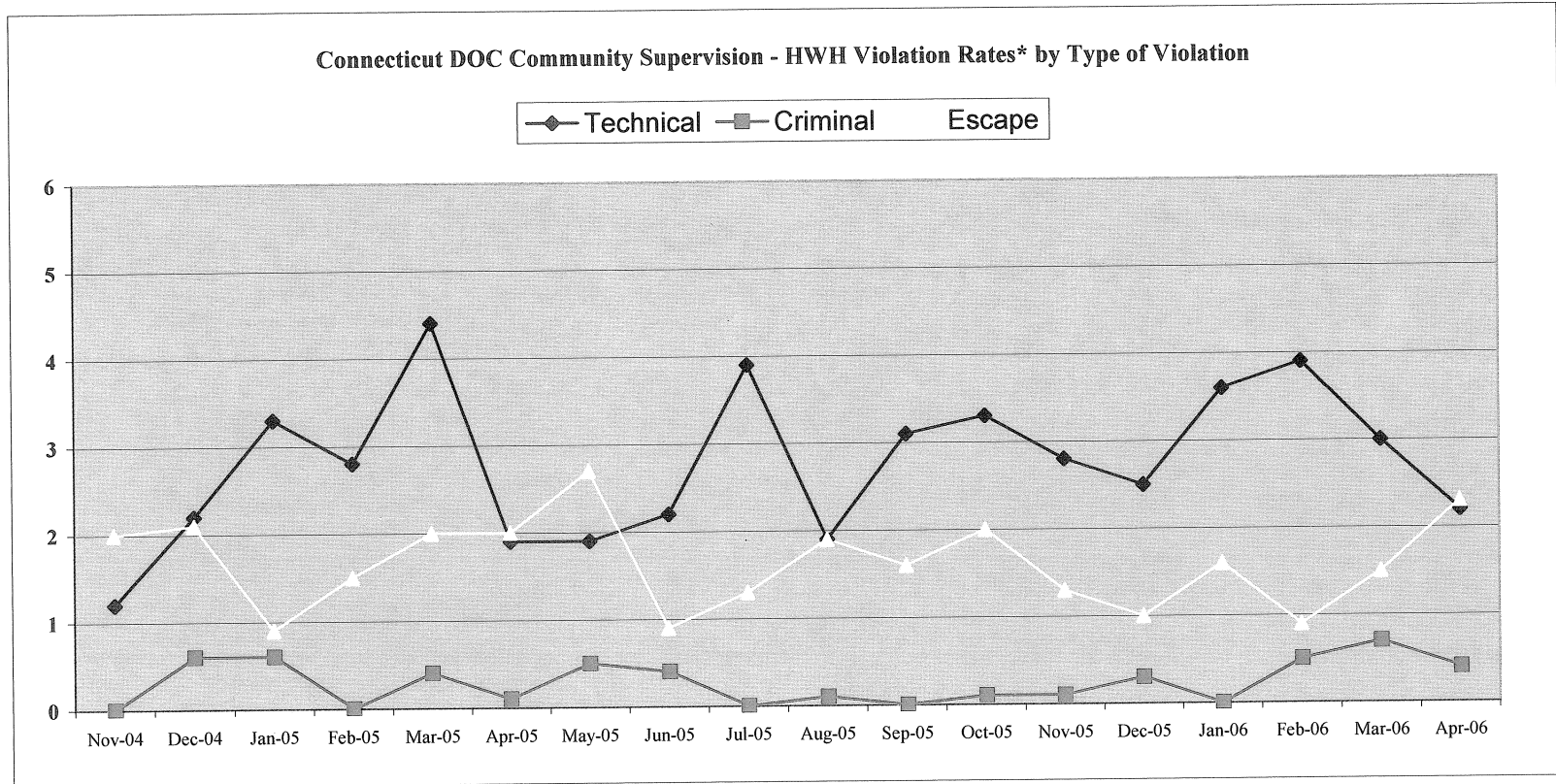
