

Eligible Expenses
JAG Violent Crime Prevention (VCP) Grant
February 5, 2015

Personnel: JAG funds may support the following police personnel costs:

- Police Over-time (OT) to conduct a specialized initiative, operation or investigation.
- Police Over-time (OT) to develop, implement or expand community policing strategies.
- Police Over-time (OT) to attend in-state training events or develop community engagement or community policing strategies.

Note: JAG funds may support OT for “back-fill” officer(s) or OT for officer(s) to implement grant funded activities but **not both.**

Note: JAG funds may not be used for personnel to administer the grant.

Contractor or Consultant Services: JAG funds may support the following types of contractor or consultant services:

- Police Officer In-State Training
- Technical assistance or consultant services to develop or revise police policies, procedures and protocol.
- Technical assistance or consultant services to develop, implement or expand community policing strategies.
- Information technology consultant services to develop or revise police department records systems, information management systems or communication systems.

Note: JAG funds shall not be used for contracts or consultant services which extend beyond the grant period.

JAG funds may be used to purchase equipment within the following program categories.

A. Computer Aided Dispatching (CAD)

- CAD System
- CAD Component
- Other CAD Accessories

B. Computers /Technology Systems /Mobile Data Terminals

- Video Recording Equipment for Interrogation Rooms
- Records Management Systems (RMS)
- Automated Fingerprint Information Systems (AFIS)
- Computer Hardware and Peripherals
- Mobile Data Terminals for police vehicles

C. Computer Software

- Police software system (incident tracking, scheduling, etc.)

D. Emergency Medical Equipment

- Narcan or Naloxone
- Defibrillators (AED)
- Trauma kits and medical equipment
- CPR training equipment and accessories

E. Police Cruiser Equipment/ Officer Equipment

- Trunk storage units
- Equipment mounts
- Push bumpers
- Emergency lighting, sirens control module, and other vehicle accessories
- Evidence collection kits
- Protective shields
- Thermal imaging spots lighting systems
- GPS equipment
- Handcuffs (metal, flex, riot, etc.)
- Helmet
- Gas masks
- Canine, training, equipment, vehicle modification and kennel.

F. In-car/On Person Camera System

- Officer body camera systems
- Vehicle video camera systems

G. License Plate Readers

- License plate readers
- New units
- Upgraded units
- Software
- Accessories

H. Mobile Access Equipment

- Mobile forensic analysis tools (phones, tablets, computers, other electronics)

I. Radios

- Portable / Mobile radios
- Base station
- Interop equipment
- Consoles
- Communication head sets systems, and accessories
- Accessories (antennas, connectors, cabling, etc.)

J. Security Systems for Station or Evidence Room

K. Tactical Equipment

- Bullet Proof Vest (requires “Mandatory Wear” certification)
- Ladders
- Night vision
- Thermal imaging
- EO Tech Sights (or similar)
- IR Illuminators
- Under door camera
- Lighting
- Eyeball systems
- Duty bags, storage bags and containers
- Dive team equipment (masks, regulators, tanks, etc.)

L. Surveillance and Investigative Equipment

- Evidence processing systems
- Investigative cameras
- Crime scene kits
- DNA collection kits
- UV lighting systems

M. Vehicles

- Patrol vehicles
- Unmarked vehicles
- Trailer

N. Video Observation (station, community, pole cams)

IMPORTANT:

- JAG funds can't pay for service, support or maintenance contracts that run beyond grant period.
- Vendor's invoice to town must have a separate "line item" for each piece of equipment.
- Installation service may be invoiced as a separate line item or the installation costs may be integrated into the equipment purchase price.

Non-allowable Use: Funds may **NOT** be used for renovation, remodeling, construction, furniture, tables, chairs, office supplies, uniforms, all-terrain vehicles, helicopters, boats, Segways, confidential "buy money", out-of-state travel and training, food and beverage.
