Re: Purchase of Service Part II Standard Contract Template Revision

## **Overview**

The Office of Policy and Management (OPM) has revised the Purchase of Service (POS) Standard Contract Template - Part II Terms and Conditions Non-Discrimination Provision pursuant to <u>Public Act 25-168 Section 227</u>. In addition, the reference to the State Elections Enforcement Commission (SEEC) Form 10, Campaign Contributions Restriction, has been removed.

The contract module in CORE-CT will be updated with the revised POS part II contract language for new contracts on Friday October 3, 2025.

Attached are two POS Part II Standard Contract Templates: the final version and the red-line version.
