#### **Working Groups**

##### **1. Ariel Imagery and Data Acquisition**

- Vender selected
- Nearing end of contracting process
- Vender is getting ready to fly for when contract is executed
- Purchased addition lidar classification for vegetation
- True ortho imagery for bridges overpass and high population areas
- 3-D terrain and building for level of detail 2
- Impervious surface analysis held off due to costa and few questions. Didn't want to hold up contract
- Inland for waterbodies held off due to similar issues as above
- Hydrography on hold similar as above. Will still be getting updated layer
- Change detection is depended on impervious service on hold.
- By in option is still pretty open for towns.

##### **2. Geospatial Data Clearing House**

- Launched GeoData portal at last GIS Day.
- Positive feedback, need to increase education and awareness.

##### **3. Statewide Addressing and Geocoding**

- On hold still. Improving address layer. Have a list of missing areas.
- Still pulling info to understand whole scope.
- Draft schema underway. Will be sent to be reviewed when draft is confirmed.

##### **4. Broadband Mapping**

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- Continue analysis underserved area. QA the data still.
- Working with ISP to make sure they are not duplicating efforts.
- Have to go in the order that is required for the funding.
- Strong emphasis for state and local cooperation.
- Survey to help facilitate efforts.

### 5. CAMA working group

- Schema version 5.
- Version 6 is the new one. Fixed errors in version 5 form vendors.
- V6 is handed to OPM to send to vendors for towns.
- CAMA data should be reflecting of October 1<sup>st</sup>. April 1<sup>st</sup> cogs request, May 1<sup>st</sup> submitted to OPM, July 1<sup>st</sup> COGS report to OPM.
- Looking to publish the 2022 data, Still deciding if it goes on Open data portal or GeoData portal.
- 2023 parcel wants to publish as a service for town.
- Data for 2022 should be up soon.

### 6. Parcel Drafting Guidelines

- Standards are continuing to work on final document. At the point where document is in rough draft form.
- Something to review for Spring, will submit to advisory board.

### 7. State Data Plan

- Due every two years at end of calendar year
- Covers use management and sharing of data between state agencies.
- 2 year cycle fir state data plan, GIS data plan 5 year plan. Link to document below.

  - Improving access to data
  - Improving agency capacity (trained staff)
  - Ability to use data in decision making (data driven decisions)
- Seamless navigation between Open data portal and Geodata portal. Auditing meta data, and no duplicates in the portal.
- Working to expand the data in the portals

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- Work on Standardization across state agencies.
