- B. OPM provided an update on the level of need and IQ study, a contractor has been identified through the RFP process and will have an initial draft of their research by the end of August. We will be scheduling a opportunity for the council to provide feedback on recommendations before the end of the year.
- C. CSDE, a group of subject matter experts provided feedback on their initial draft of guidelines for BCBA's in schools. The final draft is in process and should be released prior to the start of the school year.
- D. DRCT, does an annual survey to determine priorities for their next fiscal year and is looking for stakeholder feedback. You can access and disseminate the survey to assist them in creating goals, SURVEY LINK. Their flyer is also attached below.
- E. DSS, Christine Weston is the new DSS appointee for the council, she offered to provide personal stories on waiver successes at future meetings and is open to providing additional information that would be of interest to the council. There are currently 243 total waiver participants. Of the 200 additional slots provided in the last biennium, 123 are filled and an additional 25 people are currently going through the

	 Medicaid process, they are working through the waitlist to fill the remaining 52 slots. They have an additional allotment of waiver slots that will become available in 2025. F. OPM autism supportive housing pilot that was proposed has been stalled due to the provider requiring additional funding, this is something that our housing subcommittee can work on to identify a model and scope for this funding. G. OPM provided an update on ASDAC appointments, we have 6 member slots that are still waiting on legislative appointments. Tara Viens will continue to follow up with legislators to get this completed.
