6.	Workgroup Report Out	Tara Viens					

- 1. Education & Training (Lynn Ricci)
 - a. We are trying to identify what exists and look at how to leverage existing programs.
 - b. We had the discussion already, but RBT training may be something we look at and how to commit resources for that training.
 - c. Kari reported out on a program at SCSU in the Office of Workforce & Lifelong Learning that is looking at viable options for workforce development and is open to discussing opportunities in the human service field.
 - d. Lois expressed her concern with lack of providers and need for workforce development as it's a big concern for families. Yana agreed and expressed her frustration with finding support during the times she needs vs what is convenient for staff.
- 2. Housing (Stephen Beyers or Lois Rosenwald)
 - a. Waiting to hear on the housing pilot because we would like to focus on that this year. We are reaching crisis and this is a needed area. We could also use more natural supports or a mixed community. Camelot new apartment

 - a. The council discussed legislative priorities, Tara will send out a survey to collect responses, there is consensus that we should limit the number of priorities we focus on to increase the likelihood of getting something accomplished.
 - b. The council would like to create an adhoc workgroup to provide legislative updates to members on anything related to autism.
 - c. The council would like to present policy priorities to legislators. Tara will reach out to the Human Services Committee to see if they can attend our November meeting.
- 3. State Agency Report Out
 - a. OPM Membership Updates
 - i. Speaker Matt Ritter has appointed Melissa Paul-Perez to the council in the position of advocate and is looking for recommendations on someone to appoint in his district (Hartford) who is an adult with autism who may want to serve in this roll. If you know of someone you can have them reach out to me directly. They should provide a bio on themselves and let the speaker know why they are interested in serving.
 - b. CSDE
 - Autism Worksheet for special education eligibility is being revised by a stakeholder workgroup, Bryan will provide continued updates and let the council know when the final draft is completed.
 - c. BRS
- i. They did not receive the federal grant for vocational providers to help with workforce development, they are still working toward a solution with state resources by partnering with other agencies. This is a top priority for BRS.
