Re: FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026 MUNICIPAL SPENDING CAP REPORT DUE BY JULY 1st OR 30 DAYS AFTER BUDGET ADOPTION

<u>Subsection (f) of Section 4-661</u> of the Connecticut General Statutes as amended by <u>Public Act 25-3</u> requires each municipality to annually certify whether such municipality has exceeded the cap set forth in the legislation.

Pursuant to <u>Public Act 25-3</u>, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, the amount of the municipal revenue sharing grant payable to a municipality shall not be reduced in the case of a municipality whose adopted budget expenditures exceed the cap of 3.31%.

Chief Financial Officers are to report spending cap data under the <u>Fiscal Health Monitoring System</u> (FHMS). The spending cap report may be submitted after completion of the municipality Fiscal Year 2025/2026 adopted budget submission. Both reports utilize the original adopted budget for July 1, 2025. Upon FHMS log in at <u>CT FHMS - Sign In</u>, you will first complete your budget reporting and then after acceptance, complete the spending cap report.

Primary contacts must log in and submit. If there is a new primary assigned by a municipality, complete <a href="mailto:fhms-new-primary-contact-form.pdf">fhms-new-primary-contact-form.pdf</a>.

The Submission of Municipal Spending Cap Budget Data job aid is attached. FHMS data will be prepopulated with Fiscal Year 2024/2025 data and Fiscal Year 2025/2026 adopted budget from your budget submission.


Please note that while the language in subsection (a) provides some very general guidance regarding what expenditures are considered outside of "municipal spending", it does not provide definitions or specific guidance. OPM believes that it is the intent of the law to exclude business-type activities from municipal spending (i.e. water pollution control authority). You will need to interpret the language in the statute and make those determinations for your municipality. Please be consistent across fiscal years when doing so.

The Municipal Spending Cap Budget page displays


#### \*Note:


### 3. Select the Entity (Town or City) on the left side



5. Enter data based upon your Municipality's Adopted Budget and underlying financial records for conformance with subsection (f) of CGS 4-66l.



**Line A** will self-populate from your budget submission. If the expenditure amount is incorrect, you will need to email to <a href="mailto:opm-fhms@ct.gov">opm-fhms@ct.gov</a> and request that the Adopted Budget Tile be re-opened to make changes.

#### 6. Entity Certification:

I am in agreement with the Adjusted Adopted Budget Expenditures results presented on Line Q of this form."


