Re: Revised Draft Conservation and Development Policies: The Plan for Connecticut, 2018-2023

Dear Senators and Representatives:

The Office of Policy and Management (OPM) hereby re-submits the revised Draft *Conservation* and *Development Policies: The Plan for Connecticut, 2018-2023* (Draft C&D Plan), which was originally submitted to the Continuing Legislative Committee on State Planning and Development (Continuing Committee) on April 6, 2018, in accordance with Section <u>16a-29</u> of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS).

The Continuing Committee held a <u>public hearing</u> on April 23, 2018, and on May 7, 2018, voted unanimously to recommend approval of the Draft C&D Plan by the General Assembly. However, <u>House Joint Resolution No. 172</u> was not acted on by the General Assembly during the 2018 session.

The resubmitted Draft C&D Plan contains the same written content, but incorporates new graphics and formatting. In addition, the Draft 2018-2023 Locational Guide Map, which recommends the delineation of priority funding areas in accordance with CGS Section <a href="mailto:16a-35c(b)">16a-35c(b)</a>, remains identical to that submitted in 2018 and can be found online via OPM's website at <a href="https://portal.ct.gov/opm/cdplan">https://portal.ct.gov/opm/cdplan</a>.

Please note that Section 6 of <u>Senate Bill 1009</u> is intended to address the challenges summarized in OPM's <u>2018 Annual Report</u> on the Implementation of the Conservation and Development Policies: The Plan for Connecticut (2013-2018). This proposed legislation would also address concerns raised by the Connecticut Chapter of the American Planning Association (CCAPA) during the April 23, 2018 public hearing.

My staff and I look forward to working with the Continuing Committee to address any remaining issues that members might have.
