Re: Forgiveness of Consultants' Invoices

Dear Mr. Gormany,

Congratulations to the City of West Haven for leaving Municipal Accountability Review Board (MARB) oversight.

In response to your letter dated June 17, 2025, the City of West Haven requested MARB forgiveness on the two consultants' invoices for Whittlesey and Protiviti that are due to the State of Connecticut or at the very least that the payments be spread over the next ten years. As you are aware, on May 15th the MARB released the City from Tier IV oversight, at which time the MARB no longer has jurisdiction and authority over the City of West Haven.

The attached Municipal Restructuring Fund Agreement (MRF) which was entered into between the State of Connecticut's Office of Policy and Management (OPM) and the City of West Haven signed June 22, 2022, in Section 4-d requires the City to restore the full amount of the Restructuring Funds by no later than June 30, 2028.

Please provide OPM staff with the City's repayment schedule for the \$617,270.77.
