Dear Mesdames and Messrs.:

Pursuant to Sections 3-37(b) and 3-21(f)(2)(A) of the General Statutes, please find attached the Report for March 2020, which provides information regarding the State's cash position and bonding activity.

Cash balances for March 2020 were strong, although cash receipts and disbursements have become more volatile and less predictable as a result of the current health crisis. The trend continued through April 25, 2020, with total available cash of \$4.9 billion, including the common cash pool of \$4.2 billion.

The increase in the authorized and unissued amounts for bonding reflects the passage of the bond bill last month. No temporary transfers from bond proceeds investment accounts have been made since December 2017.

As always, my office will keep you up to date on issues concerning cash flow and bonding programs. In the meantime, should you have any questions, please feel free to call.
