Pursuant to Sections 3-37(b) and 3-21(f)(2)(A) of the General Statutes, please find attached the Report for July 2021, which provides information regarding the State's cash position and bonding activity.

Cash balances for August continued to be strong, with total available cash near all-time highs at \$11.8 billion, including the common cash pool of \$10.3 billion as of August 28, 2021. Given the economic uncertainty associated with the ongoing pandemic and the potential impact on State cash receipts and disbursements, we continue to diligently monitor, assess, and revise our Cash projections. No temporary transfers from bond proceeds investment accounts have been made since December 2017.

As always, my office will keep you up to date on issues concerning cash flow and bonding programs. In the meantime, should you have any questions, please feel free to call.
