Dear Mesdames and Messrs.:

Pursuant to C.G.S. Section 3-37(b), please find attached the monthly report for January 2014, which provides certain information regarding the State's cash position and bonding.

The report for January 2014 shows strong overall cash balances, which reflect improvements that began a year ago as a result of revenues exceeding projections and effective expenditure management.

Thus far this fiscal year, total available cash has averaged a robust \$2.1 billion, and the common cash pool -- which covers operating expenses -- has averaged approximately \$790 million. No transfers between bond proceeds investment accounts and the common cash pool have been necessary since April 2013.
